NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-III (MOP UP) COUNSELLING OF MANAGEMENT QUOTA SEATS (S1, S2 & S3) FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE POST GRADUATE DENTAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE PRIVATE NON-MINORITY DENTAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO Dr. NTR UHS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26.

In continuation to this Office notifications, dt.03-07-2025,15-07-2025 & 23-07-2025 Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-III (Mop Up) counselling for admissions into Management Quota seats of PG Dental Degree/Diploma courses in Private Un-aided Non-minority Colleges under Dr. NTR UHS for the academic year 2025-26:

(Candidates have to login to exercise web options)

Security Deposit:

To prevent seat blocking and ensure that valuable seats are effectively utilized during the Phase-III (Mop Up) Round, the Competent Authority has decided to collect a *refundable security deposit* of ₹3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs only) through online payment. This applies to candidates who are in the Merit List under the Management Quota and intend to participate in the Phase-III (Mop Up) round of counselling, subject to the following conditions:

- i. Refundable Security Deposit of candidates who do not join the seats allotted to them in Phase-III (Mop Up) Round or in subsequent stray rounds, if any, **will be forfeited** and such candidates **cannot participate** in further rounds of A.P. State Counselling for admission to PG (Medical) Courses under both Competent Authority Quota seats & Management Quota seats for the year 2025-26.
- ii. If the candidate joins the allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.
- iii. If the candidate is not allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.

Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason. e.g. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within stipulated time).

Note: Candidates who have paid the security deposit during the Phase-III (Mop Up) round and were not allotted any seat will be eligible to exercise web options in the Stray Vacancy Round without having to pay the security deposit again.

UNIVERSITY FEE:

1. Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).
2. Candidates who have already paid the University fee of ₹.49,600/- in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling are not required to pay the same.

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee structure for the current academic year 2025-26 will be as decided by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, subject to the outcome of W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

Distribution of seats is as detailed below:

- 1) As per G.O.Ms.No.57, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 28-04-2023 (Non-Minority Colleges):
 - a) Management Quota-Subcategory- 1(S1): 25% of the sanctioned intake of seats, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by the candidates in General Merit based on the NEET MDS-2024 ranking.
 - b) Management Quota-Subcategory-2(S2): 15% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by foreign students/ NRI/NRI sponsored candidates on the basis of inter-se-merit among the applicants qualified in NEET MDS-2024.
 - c) Management Quota-Subcategory-3(S3): 10% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each Institution shall be Institutional preference/In- service management quota seats filled on the basis of inter-se-merit among the applicants qualified in NEET MDS-2024.
- 2) As per G.O.Ms.No.102, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 15-07-2023:
 - a) 15% of Subcategory-1 seats only are open to the candidates from all over the Country – S1A
 - b) For the Remaining 85% of Subcategory-1 seats only Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh i.e., AU/SVU are only eligible – S1B

Eligibility for Management Quota seats in Non-Minority Dental Colleges:

Sub Category-1 - S1 (S1A & S1B):-

- **15% of Subcategory-1 seats (S1A)** are open to candidates from across the country. However, candidates are advised to note that **S1A seats are not available in MDS courses** due to the limited number of seats in each broad specialty.
- The **remaining 85% of Subcategory-1 seats (S1B)** are exclusively reserved for **local candidates of Andhra Pradesh**, specifically those under **Andhra University (AU)** and **Sri Venkateswara University (SVU)** areas.
- Candidates who have completed their **BDS outside the State or Country** are **eligible only for Subcategory-2 (S2) and Subcategory-3 (S3) seats**. Any **unfilled S1B seats** may be made available to candidates from all over the country **only during Phase-III (Mop Up) counselling**, and **only after all eligible S1B candidates have been considered**.

Instructions to Candidates:

1	Seat Matrix is displayed in the University Website https://drntr.uhsap.in for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Final Merit list displayed on 15-07-2025 and any Addendum to the Final Merit List issued thereafter are eligible to opt for Phase-III. Candidates who have updated their S2/S3 options for Phase-III can exercise options as per their updated status.
2	As per the year 2024-25 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2024-25 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
3	As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2022-23 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
4	<p>a) Candidates opting for Dental Degree/Diploma courses are informed that there is no limit on the number of choices for web options. They can select any number of specialties and colleges available, provided they meet the eligibility criteria and are interested in joining.</p> <p>b) <u>The candidates are advised to exercise options for all the seats in all the colleges as per their priority irrespective of vacancy position of the seats.</u></p> <p>c) <u>Candidates while giving options should note that the seats vacated by the candidates selected in Phase-I counselling and slid to other college/course during this Phase-III of counselling process (virtual vacancies) will be added & allotted simultaneously during this Phase of counselling itself.</u></p> <p>d) <u>Candidates are encouraged to select courses they are genuinely interested in joining, allowing the next meritorious candidates a fair opportunity.</u></p> <p>e) <u>The candidate is informed that any priority options listed below the currently joined seat will not be considered, as the candidate has already chosen the joined seat as a higher preference.</u></p> <p>f) <u>In respect of S1B seats, preference will be given to local candidates of Andhra Pradesh and if eligible candidates from Andhra Pradesh are not available, the same will be allotted to S1A candidates based on Merit list, options and subject to availability of seats.</u></p> <p>g) All remaining S1B category vacancies, after the applicable conversions in Phase-III, will be considered as S1A seats for the subsequent Stray Vacancy Rounds. These seats will be open to all eligible candidates based on merit.</p> <p>h) Candidates getting upgraded in MQ Phase 3 <u>Shall NOT</u> have any claim on MQ Phase 1/Phase 2 seat.</p> <p>i) If upgraded in Phase 3, the candidate must join Phase 3 seat by reporting at the allotted college.</p>
5	Candidates are advised to exercise caution when selecting options online and to print out the saved options for their records. Candidates are encouraged to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If candidates are not interested in joining a particular specialty or college, they are advised not to select options for those.
6	<p>The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.</p> <p>Candidates who have already paid the University fee of ₹.49,600/- do not need to pay again for downloading the Allotment Order.</p>
7	The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.

8	The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr. NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slided college by the concerned college where the amount is held.
9	<p>Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (MoP Up) Counselling:</p> <p>The following candidates are eligible:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> It is decided to collect a Refundable Security Deposit Amount of ₹.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakh only) through online mode from the candidates who wishes to participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) and subsequent Phases of Counselling to avoid seat blocking. All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I/Phase-II seat. All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling. All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II <ul style="list-style-type: none"> but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. Joined but resigned from the allotted seat as per University Notifications for free exit. <p>However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II or resigned from the joined seat of Phase-I/Phase-II, then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Phase-I /II joined/reported seat shall be the default last option. Candidates getting upgraded in Phase-III Shall NOT have any claim on the seat held in Phase-I/Phase-II either in CQ or MQ. The Joined candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II or Phase-III(Mop Up) Counselling are not eligible for Stray or any further rounds. Candidates allotted a seat in Phase III (Mop-Up) cannot participate in subsequent rounds of State Counselling including Management Quota Counselling, regardless of whether they report to the allotted college. Candidates allotted/upgraded in CQ Phase-III irrespective of their reporting status will be blocked from participating in MQ Phase-III counselling, even though if they have exercised web options. If a candidate is allotted a seat under CQ in Phase-III, they must compulsorily report. The previously held MQ seat (if any) from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated, regardless of whether the candidate reports to the new CQ seat in Phase-III. The vacated MQ seat will be made available for allocation during MQ Phase-III Counselling. If a candidate is allotted a seat in Phase-III, he/she has to compulsorily report & join the allotted seat/college else the Security Deposit amount of ₹.3,00,000/- will be forfeited and he/she cannot participate in further rounds of counselling. Candidates allotted/upgraded under CQ in Phase-III shall not have any claim on the seat held in Phase-I/Phase-II either in CQ or MQ. In respect of S1B seats, preference will be given to local candidates of Andhra Pradesh and if eligible candidates from Andhra Pradesh are not available, the same will be allotted to S1A candidates based on Merit list, options and subject to availability of seats. MCC of DGHS will share the data of joined candidates in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 counselling with all the participating States. Similarly, the participating States will also share the data of joined candidates. Candidates who have joined up to Round 3 of MCC counselling and also the allotted candidates of Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling will be filtered and weeded out before processing for Stray Vacancy round of counselling of AP State. As per MCC counselling Scheme 2025, the joined candidates up to Round 3 of MCC counselling cannot upgrade or resign after Round 3. If any candidate is allotted seat in Round 3 of AIQ/Deemed/Central Quota such candidates need not participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) or subsequent phases of State Counselling.

10	Candidates who participate in the Phase-III web options of both CQ and MQ, if allotted a seat in CQ will not be considered for allotments in MQ Phase-III even though they have exercised web options.
11	<p>Eligibility exercising web options for Stray counselling:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The candidates who have not been allotted in Phase 1, Phase 2, Phase 3 of counselling. The candidates who have been allotted, but not joined in Phase 1, Phase 2 of State Quota and All India Quota are eligible to participate in this counselling. A Candidate who has not registered and not choice locked in the Phase 1 or Phase 2 or Phase 3(Mop up) ONLINE COUNSELLING will be permitted to attend Stray Round of ONLINE COUNSELLING. <p>Not Eligible Candidates:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The candidates who are holding MDS seat in Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3 (Mop Up) of State Counselling are not eligible to participate in Stray round of counselling. The candidate who is holding a seat allotted in Round 1 & Round 2 and Round 3 in All India Quota/Deemed universities (conducted by MCC/DGHS). The candidates who have been allotted in stray round of All India Quota/Deemed universities (conducted by MCC/DGHS) are not eligible to participate in State Stray Round of counselling. The candidates who have been allotted in stray round of Competent Authority Quota of the AP State are not eligible to participate in State MQ Stray Round of counselling. A candidate allotted a seat in Phase 3 (Mop up) of State counselling and not joined the seat cannot participate in further rounds of State Counselling.
12	<p>If any candidate joins allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II of Management Quota (MQ) seat in AP State can slide to a seat allotted in Phase-III of Competent Authority Quota seat in AP State and in such case, the tuition fee already paid for the MQ will be returned to the candidate by the concerned college. The previously held MQ seat (if any) from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated, regardless of whether the candidate reports to the new CQ seat in Phase-III and Shall NOT have any claim on Phase-I/Phase-II seat of MQ.</p>
13	<p>As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, a candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat till the closure of admission for the year. However, they may choose to discontinue the course after the admissions process concludes, subject to payment of a discontinuance fee of ₹3 lakh plus 18% GST as per Rules and such the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years from the date of discontinuance for admission into Post Graduate Dental Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of ₹. 3,54,000/- (including 18% GST).</p>
14	The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
