NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-III (MOP UP) COUNSELING FOR ADMISSION INTO THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA SEATS OF POST-GRADUATE DENTAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE NON-MINORITY DENTAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO Dr. NTR UHS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26.

In continuation to this Office Notifications, dt.01-07-2025,14-07-2025 & 23-07-2025 Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-III/Mop Up of counselling for admissions into Competent Authority Quota (CQ) PG Dental Degree/Diploma courses available in the Government and Private Non-Minority Dental Colleges under Dr. NTR UHS for the academic year 2025-26.

Security Deposit:

To prevent seat blocking and ensure that valuable seats are effectively utilized during the Phase-III (Mop Up) Round, the Competent Authority has decided to collect a *refundable security deposit* of ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) through online payment. This applies to candidates who are in the Merit List under the Competent Authority Quota and intend to participate in the Phase-III (Mop Up) round of counselling, subject to the following conditions:

- Refundable Security Deposit of candidates who do not join the seats allotted to them in Phase-III (Mop Up) Round or in subsequent stray rounds, if any, **will be forfeited** and such candidates **cannot participate** in further rounds of A.P. State Counselling for admission to PG (Medical) Courses under both Competent Authority Quota seats & Management Quota seats for the year 2025-26.
- If the candidate joins the allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.
- If the candidate is not allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.
- Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason. e.g. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within stipulated time)

Note: Candidates who have paid the security deposit during the Phase-III (Mop Up) round and were not allotted any seat will be eligible to exercise web options in the Stray Vacancy Round without having to pay the security deposit again.

UNIVERSITY FEE:

- 1. Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).
- 2. Candidates who have already paid the University fee of ₹.23,600/- in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling are not required to pay the same.

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee structure for the current academic year 2025-26 will be as decided by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, subject to the outcome of W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

Instructions to Candidates:

1	Seat Matrix is displayed in the University Website https://drntr.uhsap.in for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Final Merit list displayed on 14-07-2025 are eligible to opt for Phase-III.
2	<p>Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus (placed in the University website on 01-07-2025) and the Government Orders on Rules of PG admissions available before exercising web options. Candidates are also advised to go through the details about “MRC” concept which is exemplified below:</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) In a particular college MDS (Conservative Dentistry) seat is under “Open Category” in the seat matrix and a SC candidate is allotted that Open Category MD (Conservative Dentistry) seat in Open Round Counselling of Phase-I as per his/her web options and NEET -MDS Rank merit order of the candidate. Now this candidate is shown as Meritorious Reserved Candidate (MRC).b) The same SC2 candidate has slide to MD (Prosthodontics) SC2 category seat in the same college or another college during the Category Round of Phase-I Counselling conducted on the same day, then that MD(Conservative Dentistry) seat vacated by this MRC candidate shall be filled with the SC2 candidates only by merit amongst them.c) This type of MRC concept is to be followed for all BC/SC/ST categories in order to maintain 50 : 50 ratio of Open : Category Reservationd) G.Os governing MRC and other regulations:<ul style="list-style-type: none">1. 4	As per the year 2024-25 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2024-25 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
5	As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2022-23 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2024-25(List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).

6	<p>a) Candidates opting for Dental Degree/Diploma courses are informed that there is no limit on the number of choices for web options. They can select any number of specialties and colleges available, provided they meet the eligibility criteria and are interested in joining.</p> <p>b) <u>The candidates are advised to exercise options for all the seats in all the colleges as per their priority irrespective of vacancy position of the seats.</u></p> <p>c) <u>Candidates while giving options should note that the seats vacated by the candidates selected in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling and slid to other college/course during this Phase-III of counseling process (virtual vacancies) will be added & allotted simultaneously during this Phase of counselling itself.</u></p> <p>d) <u>Candidates are encouraged to select courses they are genuinely interested in joining, allowing the next meritorious candidates a fair opportunity.</u></p> <p>e) <u>The candidate is informed that any priority options listed below the currently joined seat will not be considered, as the candidate has already chosen the joined seat as a higher preference.</u></p> <p>f) <u>Candidates getting upgraded in CQ Phase 3 Shall NOT have any claim on Phase-I/Phase-II seat of CQ & MQ.</u></p> <p>g) If upgraded in Phase 3, the candidate must join Phase 3 seat by reporting at the allotted college.</p>
7	<p>Candidates are advised to exercise caution when selecting options online and to print out the saved options for their records. Candidates are encouraged to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If candidates are not interested in joining a particular specialty or college, they are advised not to select options for those.</p>
8	<p>The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.</p> <p>Candidates who have already paid the University fee of ₹.23,600/- do not need to pay again for downloading the Allotment Order.</p>
9	<p>The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.</p>
10	<p>The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate upgrades to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr.NTR UHS) during this Phase of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the newly allotted college by the college concerned where the amount is held.</p>
11	<p>Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (Mop Up) Counselling</p> <p>The following candidates are eligible:</p> <p>a) The Competent Authority has decided to collect a Refundable Security Deposit Amount of ₹.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) through online mode from the candidates who wishes to participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) and subsequent Phases of Counselling to avoid seat blocking.</p> <p>b) All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I/Phase-II seat.</p> <p>c) All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling.</p> <p>d) All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. ➤ Joined but resigned from the allotted seat as per University Notifications for free exit. <p><u>However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II or resigned from the joined seat of Phase-I/Phase-II, then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling.</u></p> <p>e) Phase-I /II joined/reported seat shall be the default last option.</p> <p>f) Candidates getting upgraded in Phase-III Shall NOT have any claim on Phase-I/Phase-II seat of CQ & MQ</p> <p>g) The Joined candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II or Phase-III(Mop Up) Counselling are <u>not eligible</u> for Stray or any further rounds.</p> <p>h) <u>Candidates allotted a seat in Phase III (Mop-Up) cannot participate in subsequent rounds of State Counselling including Management Quota Counselling, regardless of whether they report to the allotted college.</u></p>

	<p>i) Candidates allotted/upgraded in CQ Phase-III irrespective of their reporting status will be blocked from participating in MQ Phase-III counselling, even though if they have exercised web options.</p> <p>j) A candidate holding a MQ seat is allotted a seat under CQ in Phase-III, they must compulsorily report. The previously held MQ seat (if any) from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated, regardless of whether the candidate reports to the new CQ seat in Phase-III. The vacated MQ seat will be made available for allocation during MQ Phase-III Counselling.</p> <p>k) If a candidate is allotted a seat in Phase-III, he/she has to compulsorily report & join the allotted seat/college else the Security Deposit amount of ₹.50,000/- will be forfeited and he/she cannot participate in further rounds of counselling.</p> <p>l) Candidates allotted/upgraded under CQ in Phase-III shall not have any claim on the seat held in Phase-I/Phase-II either in CQ or MQ.</p> <p>m) PwBD Conversions will be done as per rules in Phase-III Counselling (G.O.Ms.No.44 dated 25.02.2005).</p> <p>n) General Conversions will be done as per rules.</p> <p>o) All remaining special category/category vacancies, after the applicable conversions in Phase-III, will be considered as “Unreserved Open General seats” for the subsequent Stray Vacancy Rounds. These seats will be open to all eligible candidates based on merit.</p> <p>p) MCC of DGHS will share the data of joined candidates in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 counselling with all the participating States. Similarly, the participating States will also share the data of joined candidates. Candidates who have joined up to Round 3 of MCC counselling and also the allotted candidates of Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling will be filtered and weeded out before processing for Stray Vacancy round of counselling of AP State.</p> <p>q) As per MCC counselling Scheme 2025, the joined candidates up to Round 3 of MCC counselling cannot upgrade or resign after Round 3. If any candidate is allotted seat in Round 3 of AIQ/Deemed/Central Quota such candidates need not participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) or subsequent phases of State Counselling.</p>
12	<p>Eligibility exercising web options for Stray counselling:</p> <p>a) The candidates who are not holding a seat or got no seats in Phase-I, Phase-II, Phase-III of counselling (AIQ, State, Deemed) can participate in Stray Vacancy Round.</p> <p>b) The candidates who have been allotted, but not joined in Phase 1, Phase 2 of State Quota and All India Quota are eligible to participate in this counselling.</p> <p>c) A Candidate who has not registered and no choice locked in the Phase 1 or Phase 2 or Phase 3(Mop up) ONLINE COUNSELLING will be permitted to attend Stray Round of ONLINE COUNSELLING.</p> <p>Not Eligible Candidates:</p> <p>a) The candidates who are holding MDS seat in Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3 (Mop Up) of State Counselling are not eligible to participate in Stray round of counselling.</p> <p>b) The candidate who is holding a seat allotted in Round 1 & Round 2 and Round 3 in All India Quota/Deemed universities(conducted by MCC/DGHS).</p> <p>c) The candidates who have been allotted, but not joined in Phase 1, Phase 2 and Phase – III of State Quota and All India Quota are not eligible to participate in this counselling.</p> <p>d) The candidates who have been allotted in stray round of All India Quota/Deemed universities(conducted by MCC/DGHS) are not eligible to participate in State Stray Round of counselling.</p> <p>e) A candidate allotted a seat in Phase 3 (Mop up) of State counselling and not joined the seat cannot participate in further rounds of State Counselling.</p>

13	As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, a candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat till the closure of admission for the year. However, they may choose to discontinue the course after the admissions process concludes, subject to payment of a discontinuance fee of ₹3 lakh plus 18% GST as per Rules and such the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years from the date of discontinuance for admission into Post Graduate Dental Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,54,000/- (including 18% GST).
14	The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
