1. REGULATIONS:

The following are the regulations for admission of students into Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) 2-YD Course in affiliated colleges of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, A.P., for the Academic year 2025-26.

2. Student shall apply for the Government, Private Unaided Non-Minority Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences for admission under Competent Authority Quota seats.

- **3.** The Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD Course is 2 years duration.
- 4. The list of affiliated colleges and number of seats available will be displayed Before exercising options for web counseling.

5. Eligibility:

- 5.1. <u>Nationality:</u> The candidates should be of Indian Nationality or persons of Indian origin (P.I.O) / Overseas citizen of India (OCI) card holders and should satisfy the local or non-local status in Andhra Pradesh (Residence requirement) as laid down in Andhra Pradesh educational institutions (Regulations of admissions) order, 1974 and the selection will be done as per the procedure laid down in the G.O.P.No.646, dated 10-07-1979 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education (EC2) Dept., dated 18-05-2009.
- 5.2 Both Male and female Candidates are eligible for admission into Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) 2-Years Degree Course as per 228th EC resolution dated 05.05.2019.

5.3. Educational Qualifications (As per Indian Nursing Council Regulations):

A) Candidates seeking admission into Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) 2-Years Degree Course should have passed Two-year Intermediate Examination of Board of Intermediate Education of Andhra Pradesh

OR

Any other equivalent examination (10+2 pattern) or NIOS or APOSS recognized by the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh.

AND

B) Should have passed **General Nursing and Midwifery** from an institution recognized by the Govt., of A.P. or Nursing Council of India and shall be registered with the State Nursing Council.

NOTE: The Candidates who studied 1½ year MPHW are not eligible for admission into Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD Course.

(Eligibility Criteria is as per G.O.Ms.No.269, HM & FW (K2) Dept., Dt. 30-11-2009 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.194, HM & FW (K2) Dept., Dt. 07-07-2011, G.O.Ms.No.40, HM & FW (K2) Dept., Dt.18-02-2012 and G.O.Ms.No.33, HM & FW (K1) Dept., Dt.05-03-2013 and from time to time.

5.4. Government Service Candidates:

- > Should have completed 2 years of service as a staff nurse in Medical and Health Department and Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parishad as on 31.07.2025.
- > Must be a Regular employee.
- > Service Regularization/probation declaration orders as staff nurse and Service Certificate issued by the HOD concerned should be uploaded to consider under Service Quota.
- > Temporary / Contract employees in Government and employees working in private hospitals are NOT ELIGIBLE for service quota seats.

5.5 **Age:**

Note: 1. Candidates born on or after 01-01-2005 are not eligible as they do not complete 21 years of age.

2. Age shall be calculated on the basis of Date of Birth as indicated in the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination or its equivalent examination.

6. <u>ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS IN RESPECT OF CANDIDATES WHOSE</u> DOMICILE IS ANDHRA PRADESH

- 6.1. The candidate shall satisfy Local / Non-local status as per G.O.P.No.646, Education (W1) Department, dated 10-07-1979 and Presidential order. The procedure indicated in the above G.O. for Selection of candidates as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education (EC2) Dept., dated 18-05-2009, G.O.Ms.No. 80, HM & FW (C1) Dept., dt. 22.07.2025 & G.O.Ms.No. 81, HM & FW (C1) Dept., dt. 22.07.2025 shall be followed.
- 6.2 The Andhra Pradesh Non-local (APNL) candidates are eligible for 15% Unreserved seats only. The Local candidates are eligible for both 15% unreserved seats and 85% Local Area seats.
- 6.3. The verification fee and registration fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to a further date. Therefore, candidates are advised to check eligibility conditions thoroughly before applying for Competent Authority seats.

7. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:-

Admission to 85% of the available seats shall be reserved in favour of the Local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 as given in Annexure-III of G.O. (P) No. 646, Edu. (W1) Department, dt.10-7-1979.

8. LOCAL AREA:

A) Andhra University Area:

The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam (Andhra University Area) shall be regarded as the local area for the purposes of admission to the Andhra University, and to any other education institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

B) Sri Venkateswara University Area:

The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kadapa, Kurnool, Chittoor and Nellore (Sri Venkateswara University) shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission to Sri Venkateswara University and to any other educational institution (other than a Statewide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

9. LOCAL CANDIDATES:

9.1. The Local Candidate means -

- A) A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area
 - i) If he/she has studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

(or)

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in Educational Institution(s), if he/she had resided in that local area for a period of not less than 4 years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

- B) A candidate for admission to the course who is not regarded as local candidate under Clause (A) in relation to any local area
 - i) If he/she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than 7 consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local candidate in relation to
 - a) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.
 - b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has last studied in such equal periods.

(or)

- ii) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of 7 years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to
 - a) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.

(or)

- b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.
- 9.2 Local Status Certificate issued through online mode by MRO for claiming as AP local as per Circular Nos. 4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated 08.08.2016, 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dated 20.11.2017 & G.O.Ms.No.129, dated 28-10-2019 of General Administration Dept.
- 9.3. The following categories of candidates are eligible to apply for admission under 15% of the available seats, i.e., Unreserved, in terms of the Presidential order:
 - (i) All local candidates defined in the Presidential order (AU & SVU).

- (ii) Candidates who have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding the periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State of AP for a total period of ten years excluding the periods of employment outside the State. (Annexure–I) (Non-Local Candidates)
- (iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi-Public Institution within the State; and
- (iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other Quasi-Government institutions within the State.
 - N.B.: The Scanned copies of relevant certificates must be uploaded for verification along with online application. In respect of residence certificate, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities clearly specifying the years of residence.

10. RESERVATIONS:

(A) Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes :--

i. Out of the seats available for admission under Competent Authority Quota, the following percentage of seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Schedule Tribes in each local area:-

ii. Candidates of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to the State of Andhra Pradesh only which are specified by the Government of A.P. from time to time shall be considered against the reserved seats.

- iii. In the event that, if any seat reserved for the Scheduled Tribes is not filled-up, they will be open to the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Vice-Versa.
- iv. In the event of the candidates from Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes are not being available, these reserved seats shall be re-allotted to the candidates under open competition on the basis of merit.

(B) Reservation for Backward Classes Candidates:

i) 29% of the available seats for admission in each local area Under Dr. NTR UHS for Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD Course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes as follows:-

ii) As per the G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.09.1970 and G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare (C2) Dept., dated. 07-07-2007 and G.O.Ms.No.231, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Dept., dated 11-07-2007.,

- (iii) Only those Candidates who belongs to these castes of Andhra Pradesh which are listed in the Government orders shall be considered under the respective categories.
- (iv) If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes of a particular group are not available, the left-over seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left-over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.
- (v) While calculating the number of seats in the Sub-categories, if the total number of seats falls short of or exceeds 29%, it shall be limited to 29% by adding or eliminating the candidates on the basis of merit in the subgroups in which the fractions were rounded to nearest figure.

^{*}Reservation under BC-E is subject to further orders from Government of A.P./High Court.

(C) Reservation for Women Candidates:

In case of the colleges offering seats also for Male candidates, 331/3% of seats are reserved for women candidates which are horizontal reservation.

11. CERTIFICATION OF CASTE:

- 11.1 Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Class candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish latest **Integrated Caste Certificate with Barcode obtained from Government of A.P.** in the prescribed form issued by the Concerned Authority. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved guota.
- 11.2 Caste certificates of <u>other States will not be accepted</u> & in such cases, the applied candidate will be considered under General category only.
- 11.3 The social status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept., dated.12-5-1997.
- 11.4 In case of Minority candidates, the Minority certificate issued by Minorities Welfare Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh to be furnished in support of their claim.
- **Note:** 1. Keeping in view of exhaust of 10 years common admission process by 01-06-2024 as per State Re-organisation Act, 2014, the Caste certificates issued by Government of Andhra Pradesh will only be considered for admissions (Government Memo No. 2832690/C1/2025, dated 21.07.2025 of Govt. of Andhra Pradesh.
 - 2. The Social Reservation provided for BC's, SC's, ST's in the Ratio of 29%, 15% and 6% respectively shall be vertical reservation.

12. RESERVATION UNDER PwD (Person with Disability) CATEGORY:

12.1 5% Disability reservation to be considered for disabled candidates with a disability of loco-motor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to qualification will be same as prescribed for General category candidates.

[As per Indian Nursing Council {Revised Regulations and Curriculum for B.Sc. (Nursing) Program}, Regulations, 2020, dated 5th July, 2021].

12.2 Out of the available seats for admission by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, 5% shall be reserved for the Person with Disability (PwD) in each category of OC, SC, ST, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D and BC-E as per Government of India guidelines.

12.3 The candidate seeking the benefit of reservation should present himself/herself before a Medical Board constituted by the University. Such candidates have to appear before the Medical Board, constituted by the Competent Authority and notified by the University for Eligibility under PwD status alongwith UDID card and a valid disability certificate issued not later than three months prior to submitting his/her application. The report of the Medical Board is final for considering a candidate under PwD quota as per rules.

13. Categorization of seats & Fee Structure:

13.1 As per G.O.Ms.No.330, HM&FW (K1) Department, dt.11-11-2011, in respect of the Government colleges, 100% Nursing seats shall be Competent authority, will be filled by the University. In Unaided Non-minority and Minority institutions, 60% of the total number of seats shall be filled as competent authority seats by the University and the remaining 40% seats shall be management seats.

13.2 **FEE PARTICULARS:**

a) <u>Tuition Fee</u>:

For Government Nursing Colleges :	Fee as fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
In Private Unaided Non-minority and Minority institutions:	Fee as fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The counseling for admission will be made to the colleges affiliated for the year 2025-26. The fee as fixed by Govt. of AP shall be collected from the admitted candidates.

All the selected candidates shall pay the <u>non-refundable University Fee</u>

online. <u>University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any</u>

All the selected candidates have to pay the fee and other constituent fees and caution money deposits at the rates laid down for the purpose from time to time.

14. Procedure for submission of online application:

14.1 (a) The candidates are advised to download and read the prospectus of the course carefully and check their eligibility to apply for Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2c-YD Course.

- (b) The registration & Verification fee can be paid through debit card/credit card or Net banking.
- (c) The Registration & Verification fee paid by the applicant is not refundable under any circumstances or adjusted to any other course.

14.2 APPLICATIONS THROUGH ONLINE:-

- a. Only eligible candidates as per the regulations who desire to take admission into Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD course in affiliated colleges shall apply online and upload all original certificates for determining the merit position for Andhra Pradesh State Competent Authority Quota seats.
- b. The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required-for and upload the scanned Original Certificates/Documents in support of their claim through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet cafe/net center).
- c. The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates ready to enter the correct data and uploading of the scanned copies of certificates/documents, photo and signature after payment of fee through online.
- d. The candidate should furnish correct information in the online application form and upload scanned original certificates with application. The applications with incorrect information, invisible documents will not be considered and automatically rejected. If it is found that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or uploaded fake or forged documents, the University takes action that deems fit as per rules against the candidate including cancellation of seat / admission without any notice.
- 14.3 Payment of Registration fee by any Indian Credit card / Debit Card / Net Banking.



17. MERIT LIST:-

- 17.1 The Merit List will be prepared basing on GNM marks excluding Internship Marks & Computer Marks.
- 17.2 Merit Lists will be displayed on the website of the University https://drntr.uhsap.in after verification of uploaded scanned Original Certificates.
- 17.3 The eligibility of a candidate will be verified basing on the uploaded copies of scanned certificates/documents.

The candidates who are claiming reservation under Special Category, i.e., PH, have to watch the University website for further notifications, if any, for scrutiny of original certificates of respective special category.

Note: The candidature of the applicant will not be considered for the course, if incomplete online application submitted or mandatory certificates/ documents as per regulations are not uploaded.

17.4 <u>The criteria for preparation of Merit List for admission into Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) 2-YD course:-</u>

- a) Total Percentage of marks obtained in General Nursing and Midwifery upto two decimal places.
- b) The candidates who qualify under compartmental system shall be placed in the merit list after the candidates who passed in a single attempt.
- c) In case of equality of marks and aggregate percentage of marks, Age shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given higher place in the Merit List.
- d) In case of equality of marks, the aggregate percentage of marks in all subjects of the 10+2 qualifying examination upto two decimal places.

17.5 THE UNIVERSITY WILL RELEASE FINAL MERIT POSITION OF ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS.

18. AFFILIATION AND FEE G.Os.:-

NOTE: The admissions into the colleges are subject to grant of affiliation by the University for the academic year 2025-26

- i. Distribution of seats among various categories for admission in the above colleges will be displayed before exercising options for web counseling.
- ii. Counselling will be conducted for the colleges that are affiliated to the University before the <u>cut-off date</u> as decided by the Authorities for the Academic Year 2025-26.
- iii. Nursing Colleges that were issued Affiliation Orders by the University for the year 2025-26 and Fee Fixation G.O by the Government of A.P. prior to the cut-off date will only be permitted to participate in the University Counselling for the Academic Year 2025-26.

iv. Nursing College getting requisite Affiliation Orders and Fee Fixation G.O later to the cut-off date SHALL NOT be permitted to participate in the University Counselling for the Academic Year 2025-26 and will be permitted in next Academic Year only.

19. WEB COUNSELING:-

The notifications for exercising web options, procedure and applicable guidelines for admission into Post Basic. B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD course will be issued separately and placed on the website https://drntr.uhsap.in from time to time.

20. SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- 20.1 The whole process of admission of candidates into Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD course shall be under the general supervision and guidance of the Selection Committee, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.
- **20.2** The Selection Committee shall select candidates in accordance with the provisions of these regulations.
- 20.3 The Selection Committee shall have power to review its decision and can either admit or cancel the admission before the closure of admissions.

21. PROCEDURE OF SELECTIONS:

As per the G.O.Rt.No. 550, G.O.Rt.No. 111, G.O.Rt.No. 159 issued by Higher Education Department dt: 30.7.2001, 13.8.2019 & 13.11.2020 respectively. G.O.P No.646 dt:10.7.1979 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42 dt:18.5.2009 of Higher Education Dept.

22. ADMISSION RULES:

- 19.1. The Selected candidates have to download the allotment order from the website after payment of University fee by payment gateway.
- 19.2. The candidate should submit the printout of the filled in online application form, provisional allotment order and original certificates along with one set of attested copies to the Principal of the allotted college at the time of joining for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled.

23. JOINING TIME:

The selected candidates shall join the institution concerned within the specified date. No request shall be entertained for extension of time under any circumstances. Failure to join the course in time shall automatically result in the cancellation of the seat.

24. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:

- 24.1 The Head of concerned institution to which the candidate is allotted for admission shall verify the authenticity of the documents, if satisfied shall direct the candidate to pay the fees, etc., immediately.
- 24.2 All the candidates selected should undergo Medical Examination as directed by the Head of the institution concerned. The admission of the candidates shall be subject to their fitness in the medical examination.

25. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

The admissions shall be closed after 30 days from the date of commencement of classes. Any vacancy on the date of closure of admissions or that arises after the closure of admissions shall not be filled.

26. VACANCIES:

Vacancies if any, caused due to failure to join or cancellation of admissions or demise of the candidates, etc., before the closure of admissions, shall be filled by the Selection Committee in accordance with the Regulations.

27. VACATION:

The vacation for the students is 30days per academic year. The vacation shall be declared by the Principal in phased manner at the discretion of the Principal taking into consideration two weeks of summer vacation and remaining period for religious festivals.

NOTE: All original documents and declarations shall be preserved in the safe custody of the concerned Head of the institution in order to facilitate any enquiry in future.

28. POWERS OF THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION:

- 28.1. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Regulations, the Head of the Institution may at any time, either Suo-moto or an application made by any person after due and proper enquiry, if satisfied that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or enclosed false certificates or fraudulently obtained admission may for the reasons to be recorded in writing, by order cancel his/her admission with University approval, provided that no such admission shall be cancelled without giving a reasonable opportunity for showing cause as to why his/her admission should not be cancelled.
- 28.2. Against any such order of the Head of the Institution, an appeal shall lie with the Registrar, Dr. NTR University Health Sciences.

29. POWERS OF THE UNIVERSITY:

The University may either Suo-moto or on an application made to them, call for and examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof made by the concerned authority for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness, legality or proprietary of such selection or admission or cancellation and pass such order in relation there to as they deem fit, including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made, provided that the University may, before canceling such selection or admission, given an opportunity to the authority and to the person affected to show cause against such cancellation.

30. <u>UNIVERSITY IS THE FINAL AUTHORITY OF SELECTION PROCEDURE</u>:

All selections made under these regulations shall be subject to such directions or orders as may be made by the University from time to time.

31. THE REGULATIONS FOR RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF STUDY FOR ALL THE UNDER GRADUATE AND POST GRADUATE DEGREE / DIPLOMA COURSES IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES OFFERED BY Dr. NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, VIJAYAWADA.

The regulation is subject to modification from time to time. As given at Annexure-II

32. HOSTEL FACILITY:

Residence in hostel is not compulsory and at the discretion of the Principal of the colleges. Hostel accommodation will be provided as and when required. All candidates should adhere to the institutional rules and violation of Regulations will be viewed seriously. The candidates have to pay the fees towards their food if they reside in the hostel along with other fees as prescribed from time to time.

33. UNIFORM:

Student nurses shall wear white uniform while on duty.

34. COURSE OF STUDY:

- a) The candidate admitted into Post Basic. B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD course shall pursue the course in accordance with syllabus prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council/Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences.
- a) The Duration of the course is 2 years. The candidate has to complete the course in twice the number of years of study i.e., 4 years.

35. EXAMINATION:

The candidate will have to appear for the examinations as prescribed by the University from time to time.

36. TERMINATION OF TRAINING AND DISMISSAL:

- A stipendiary or Non-stipendiary candidate admitted to any of the institutions shall be liable for dismissal there from at any time before completion of the course on account of negligence, failure to attend to the prescribed studies, and duties, in subordination misconduct or any other offences amounting to moral turpitude on the part of the candidate which in the opinion of the Head of the institution makes it undesirable to continue the candidate in the college.
- a) The Head of the institutions concerned shall be competent authority to issue orders under this Regulation who before taking such action shall give an opportunity to the candidate to show cause against the proposed action.
 - b) An appeal against the dismissal order, shall be made to the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada 520 008 within three months of the receipt of the Dismissal order.

37. MIGRATION/TRANSFER:

No Transfers during the course period are permitted from one college to another college.

38. RAGGING:-

The candidates who join Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-Years Degree Course should not indulge in any kind of agitation / strike / ragging activity inside / outside the college campus during the course of study. The candidates if found to take part in any such activities mentioned above will be expelled from the course / college at any part of the course of study and legal proceedings / criminal action will be initiated against them. A copy of the Indian Nursing Council Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Nursing Colleges, 2016 dated 24.10.2017 is also available in the INC website for information. All candidates and parent/guardian should sign an Affidavit to this effect at the time of admission at the college.

Hence, candidates and parents should not trust any of such persons. Any information regarding counselling will be placed in the University official website only.

ALL SCANNED COPIES OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES TO BE UPLOADED

- 1) SSC or any equivalent examination showing date of birth and other particulars of the candidate.
- 2) Memorandum of Marks of the qualifying examination making eligible for admission i.e. Intermediate or Equivalent Examination and GNM.
- 3) Transfer Certificate from the Institution in which the candidate last studied.
- 4) Candidates claiming eligibility about local/non-local should furnish relevant certificates in support of their claim.
- 5) Candidates who have studied in the state of Andhra Pradesh -
 - (a) If the candidate has studied in any educational institution, study / bonafide certificate from VI to Intermediate (Govt. / ZPH / Private School or College) shall be submitted.
 - (b) A candidate who has studied in 2 or more institutions in various places in Andhra Pradesh, study / bonafide certificate from VI to Intermediate (Govt. / ZPH / Private School or College) in those places shall be submitted.
 - (c) A candidate who has not studied a class in any school / institution, a residence certificate for that period only shall be submitted.
 - (d) Candidates who have not studied in any school / college in the state of A.P., but resided in Andhra Pradesh with private study in Andhra Pradesh & seven years residence certificate mentioning the period of residence preceding the qualifying examination (6th to Inter) by the candidate claiming eligibility as a local by virtue of residence shall be submitted.
- 6) Candidates who have studied in the institutions outside the state of Andhra Pradesh have to submit 10 years residence certificate of the either of the parents issued by MRO to claim Unreserved seats.
- 7) Certificate of social status in case of one who belongs to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribes or Backward Classes issued by an Officer prescribed.

ANNEXURE-II

(Rules for Re-admission after break of study)

THE REGULATIONS FOR RE-ADMISSION AFTER BREAK OF STUDY FOR ALL THE UNDER GRADUATE AND POST GRADUATE DEGREE / DIPLOMA COURSES IN MEDICAL, DENTAL, INDIAN MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES OFFERED BY DR. NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, VIJAYAWADA.

The regulation is subject to modification from time to time.

DEFINITIONS:

- i. Break of study means any absence more than 3 months during the course of study.
- ii. 3 months for this purpose is a period of 90 days (ninety days) to be recorded from the date of absence irrespective of the number of days in one calendar month.
- iii. For all practical purpose only two types of break of study is allowed.
 - a. Less than 3 months of break (as per definition)
 - b. More than 3 months of break but less than the twice the number of years of study of a particular course.

Example:

- For MBBS/BDS, twice the number of years of study is 9 years.,
- For B.Sc.(Nursing) 4-YDC / Physiotherapy Course, twice the number of years of study is 8 years &
- For Post Basic B.Sc.(Nursing) 2-YD Course, twice the number of years of study is 4 years
- iv. If the candidate is on Break of study for two spells in an academic year of a particular course the candidate is deemed to have been discharged from the course of study.

 One cannot apply for condonation of the break.
- v. Only two spells of break of study for the entire duration of the course is permitted. During second spell of break of study even if the break of study is less than 90 days, permission must be obtained from the university and that spell of Break shall also be counted as second spell of break.
- vi. For less than three months of break, the Principal/ Dean of the college can permit to rejoin into the course under intimation to the university.
- vii. If the break of study is more than three months, the candidate has to apply to the university through the Principal/Dean of the college. The University can give permission to the candidate to complete the course within **twice the years of the study** of the particular course.
 - Example 1: B.Sc. (Nursing) 4-YDC student discontinues after 2 years of study and wants to join the course after 2 years of absence from study may be permitted to rejoin into the course since the candidate has 2 years of study to complete. If the candidate discontinues the course after 2 years of the study and wants to continue after 5 years of absence, the candidate will not be permitted to continue the course since the student will be finishing only after twice the number of years of the course (2 years of study + 5 years of absence + remaining 2 years of the study) makes the student study for 9 years, whereas, according to the Regulation, students should not exceed twice the number of years of study i.e., in 8 years.

Example 2: MBBS Student discontinues after 3 years of study and wants to join the course after 3 years of absence from study may be permitted to join into the course since the candidate has 1½ year of study to complete. If the candidate discontinues the course after 3 years of the study and wants to continue after 5 years of absence, the candidate will not be permitted to continue the course since the student will be finishing only after twice the number of years of the course.

PROCEDURE FOR REJOINING:

(i) The candidate having a break of study for more than three months but less than twice the years of the course shall apply for re-admission into the course in the prescribed form as in **Annexure-II** by remitting the stipulated fee for condonation of Break of Study to the University.

Request to readmission: -

The Principal shall be forwarded the application with specific remarks about the absence period and with an undertaking from the student that he/she is not involved in criminal cases during the absence period.

If any candidate is permitted by the Dean / Principal of the college concerned without the prior permission from this university, the re-admission to the course after **the break of study**, the period of such study shall not be considered as a recognized study and the candidate shall not be permitted to write the university examination based on such study Period.

When the candidate is readmitted into the course and after fulfilment of the Regulations of this university to the course concerned shall be admitted to the examinations.

- ii) The period of break of study of the candidate for rejoining into the course shall be calculated from the date of first discontinuance of the course.
- iii) All they have to execute <u>a declaration at the time of registration with this</u>
 <u>University</u> in this regard in the prescribed form as in **Annexure-I.**
- iv) Only two spells of break of study will be allowed for the entire duration of the course.
- v) If the name of the candidate has been registered in this University on the particular course of study but the candidate has not appeared for the university examination and subsequently if the candidate has entered on Break of Study for more than two years, the candidate shall start the course afresh as Dr. NTR UHS regulations.
- vi) If the candidate has not completed the course beyond twice the year of duration of course of study shall be discharged from the course immediately. This is applicable for all the years of study of Under graduate degree courses
