Regulations for admission to

Pharm. D. and Master of Pharmacy (M. Pharm.) courses

2024

1. Jurisdiction of the University:

Admission to the seats in Pharm. D. and Master of Pharmacy (M. Pharm.) courses to be conducted by the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS) shall be made on the basis of inter-se merit list of different categories/caste of candidates.

2. Eligibility criteria:

- a. Citizens of India who have obtained any of the following qualifications shall be eligible to apply for the courses:

i. Pharm. D.: A pass in 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the following subjects: Mathematics or Biology (separately in Theory and Practical portions if applicable). They must have obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category, i.e. SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, PWD) in the above three subjects, taken together and have passed English in the '10+2' examination with at least 30% marks. The Board of the said Qualifying Examination must be recognized by the Central Government or State Government concerned. Or

A pass in D. Pharm. course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India.

All applicants must complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2024. However, there is no upper age limit for appearing in the examination.

Only those candidates who are treated as domicile of West Bengal will be eligible for the course and a certificate to that effect will have to be submitted as appended as proforma 'A1' or 'A2' or 'B' at the end of this bulletin.

ii. M. Pharm.: A Pass in B. Pharm. Degree examination of an Indian university established by law in India from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India and has scored not less than 55 % of the maximum marks (aggregate of 4 years of B. Pharm.)

Every student, selected for admission to post graduate pharmacy program in any PCI approved institution should have obtained registration with the State Pharmacy Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of his/her admission,

- b. Candidates who are already pursuing any other course are not eligible for admission. However, candidates completing the course or resigning from the course before the date of counseling will be eligible to get admission.

- c. The course will consider PWD candidates as eligible if they certify their disability to be less than 40% of the various benchmark disabilities as detailed in RPWD Act, 2016.

3. Filling up of forms:

The candidates are instructed to fill in the proforma of application appended at the end of this Information Booklet and attach the photocopies of the documents as instructed therein. One candidate is allowed to appear in any one of the courses depending upon the eligibility degree obtained by him. The applications should be accompanied with a demand draft of Rs. 3,000/- (Rs. Three thousand only) for Pharm. D. and 5,000/- (Rs. Five thousand only) for M. Pharm. drawn in favour of “The West Bengal University of Health Sciences”, payable at Kolkata. The filled in proforma for the courses will have to be deposited at the office of the Controller of Examinations (CoE), WBUHS, within 4.00 pm on 11th November, 2024 either personally or by post. But in any case, the draft has to be purchased on or before 11th November, 2024. The candidates are instructed to keep a photocopy of the filled on proforma duly signed by the person receiving it at the office of CoE or the receipt of posting the proforma to the postal department with them as the proof of submission of the proforma. It will be required at the time of counselling.

4. Institution and Available Seats: Both Pharm. D. and M. Pharm. courses are taught at Haldia Institute of Pharmacy, Hatiberia, Haldia, Purba Medinipur 721631. The available seats are:

a) Pharm. D.: 30 unreserved seats

b) M. Pharm. (Pharmaceutical Chemistry): 15 unreserved seats

c) M. Pharm. (Pharmaceutical Analysis): 15 unreserved seats

d) M. Pharm. (Pharmacology): 15 unreserved seats

e) M. Pharm. (Pharmaceutics): 15 unreserved seats

5. Admission Test :

a) The written test will be held at the University premises or anywhere else as detailed in the admit card at time and date enumerated later in this document and as instructed in the admit card. The candidates are required to attend to the examination hall half an hour prior to the beginning of the examination and no candidate will be allowed to enter the hall after examination commences.

b) The examination will be of one hour and twenty minutes in duration during which no candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall under any circumstances even if the candidate has finished the examination. They will leave the examination hall only after all the OMRs are collected and duly matched with the attendance sheet.

c) The candidate will have to carry a valid photo ID (such as Passport / AADHAR Card / Voter ID / Driving License) which will have to be produced to the invigilator at the examination hall.

d) The candidate can only carry the admit card for the test and the photo ID in the examination hall. The OMR sheet, question paper and the ball point pen – all will be supplied from the University.

e) The candidates are instructed to write their roll nos. and series and serial no. of the question booklet very carefully on the OMR sheet and blacken the corresponding circles. They will put their Name, Name of the Test the candidate has appeared in, centre of examination and full signature over the OMR sheet. Candidates must remember that the OMR sheets are not replaced under any circumstances. So they should be handling it cautiously so that it does not get damaged or soiled in any respect and blotted with ink on anywhere of it. This can hamper the scanning of the OMR sheets.

f) The examinations will be of single best response type MCQs set in English language. Correct response to each of the questions will carry one mark. There will be negative marking for wrong answers. Multiple responses to any question will be regarded as wrong even if any of the options selected was the correct option. One mark will be given for the correct answer to the questions and one-fourth will be deducted for wrong answers. No marks will be deducted for questions not answered.

g) There will be one hundred MCQs in the question paper; set on the standard syllabus prescribed for the qualifying examinations. For Pharm. D. the standard of questions will be of class XII and will be on Physics and Chemistry. For M. Pharm; the standard of questions will be of B. Pharm and will be on all the different subjects covered under the syllabus of it.

h) The candidates are advised to be careful enough to blacken the circles on the OMR sheet as their chosen response. The entire circle will have to be blackened, though the candidate need not be artistic in doing so. There is no possibility to change the response on the OMR sheet as blackening of more than one circle will mean double response and will automatically be processed as wrong response.

6. Admit Cards:

Admit Card will be sent to the individual candidate through the mail address provided by them. No application for non-receipt of the admit will be entertained by the University. The admit card would contain information about the time and venue of the admission test along with the detailed instruction about the conduct of examination.

7. Merit List:

Merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained in the admission test.

If two candidates are seen to be tied on the same score, the one with lesser wrong response will be placed higher in the merit list. If the tie cannot be broken in this principle; the one with earlier date of birth will be placed higher in the merit list.

8. Admission:

- a. The provisional merit list as well as the date and time of counseling will be available in the University website.
- b. Offer letter for admission to the courses will be given at the time of counseling after

successful verification of the testimonials.

c. The candidates appearing for counseling will have to bring the following documents in original along with self-attested copies at the University premises:

- i) Admit card of the admission test.
- ii) Rank letter of the admission test.
- iii) Class X admit card/Class X pass certificate as proof of age
- iv) EPIC/Passport/Aadhar/Driving license as photo identity card.
- v) Relevant Mark sheets of the qualifying examinations
- vi) Any other relevant documents

8. It is expected that the candidates have ensured that they are eligible to appear in the examination based on the laid down criteria for appearing at the test. There would be no validation of the applications and credentials submitted by the candidates before the test. So if it is found at any stage after the test that there is any discrepancy anywhere in the process of admission, the candidature will be summarily rejected.

9. It is hereby mentioned that all information regarding fees payable or stipends available for the students should always be obtained and confirmed from the individual colleges. WBUHS will not be answerable to any query arising of these issues.




