PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO MD/MS (AYURVEDA) COURSES

REGULATIONS:

The following are the Regulations for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses for the academic year 2025-26.

1. NUMBER OF SEATS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA:

- a. The total number of seats in the affiliated colleges for the academic year 2025-26 are Annexed – X.
- b. 15% of seats from each specialty and each college are surrendered to All India Quota from the intake as per NCISM guidelines.
- c. The details of the seats available and Seat matrix under Competent Authority quota for the year 2025-26 will be displayed in the University website before the date of exercising web options.
- d. The admission procedure as per G.O.Ms. No.13, HM & FW (F2) Dept., dt.05.02.2021 & as per G.O.Ms.no.136, HM &FW (C1) Dept., dt.12.10.2021 adopted for PG AYUSH courses and any other orders of Govt./NCISM from time to time.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

THE CANDIDATES WHO FULFILL THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE ELIGIBLE

- 2.1 As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, the students who secured the below noted minimum marks or above in All India AYUSH Post Graduates Test (AIAPGET) 2025 and applied to the University are only eligible for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses 2025-26.

- 2.2 **Eligibility criteria for admission in to Postgraduate programme shall be the following, namely:-**

- (a) A graduate of Ayurvedacharya - Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery from a recognized Institution;
 - (b) Registered medical practitioner, registered in State or Union territory or Central register;
 - (c) Qualified in Postgraduate National Entrance Test-2025. (AIAPGET-2025)
- 2.3 The candidates should have completed internship by **31.07.2025** and they shall submit a Certificate to that effect. (for the academic year 2025-26 only).
- 2.4. Candidates who are already admitted and studying MD/MS batch(Ayurveda) Courses are not eligible for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) course unless they discontinue the course by remitting the bond amount and the stipend taken upto

that date before submitting application form and such candidates shall submit the discontinuance certificate issued by the Head of the Institution along with the application.

- 2.5 Candidates who are already holding a Post Graduate Degree in Ayurveda in a subject shall not be eligible for admission into another PG Ayurveda Courses.
- 2.6 No upper age limit is specified for admission to ASU & H – PG Courses.
- 2.7 No Authority of Institution shall admit any candidate to the Postgraduate courses in contravention of the criteria of procedure in respect of admission, and any admissions made in contravention shall be cancelled by the NCISM/NCH.
- 2.8 There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling (central/state/UT), and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.
- 2.9 Any admissions made beyond/over and above the intake capacity sanctioned/permitted by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH/GoI for the said academic session shall not be approved.
- 2.10 Admissions shall not be approved by any means after the cut-off date and time for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.
- 2.11 No authority has the power to extend or modify the cut-off date of admission specified by NCISM/NCH and such admission shall not be approved.
- 2.12 No authority has the power to increase the intake capacity for admission into PG courses in ASU&H colleges sanctioned by MARBISM/MARBH/NCISM/NCH.
- 2.11 NCISM shall not approve admissions made without the relevant original documents of the candidates.
- 2.12 Candidates are advised to download and read the Prospectus, User Manual Displayed on the University website to verify the eligibility/rules before submitting the online application
- 2.13 Candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly for all further notifications/latest updates/circulars/allotments on MD/MS (Ayurveda) Admissions till the closure of admissions. **No individual communications will be sent**

3. RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates in relation to the local area as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) order, 1974 and definitions of local area and local candidate as notified by the Govt. of A.P. for PG Medical and Dental Courses vide G.O.Ms.No.83, dt. 23-07-2025 of HM & FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of A.P have been adopted for the purpose of Local Area and Local candidate for admission into PG (Ayush) Courses. The contents of G.O. Ms.No.83 are reproduced here under:

4. LOCAL AREA:

- 4.1 **Andhra University Area:** The part of the State comprising the erstwhile Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as the local area for the purposes of admission to the Andhra Pradesh Professional Institutions i.e. Post graduate Medical and Dental Professional courses and to any other educational institutions (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- 4.2 **Sri Venkateswara University Area:** The part of the State comprising the erstwhile Districts of Anantapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, Cuddapah and Nellore shall be regarded as the local area for the purposes of admission to the Andhra Pradesh Professional Institutions i.e. Post graduate Medical and Dental Professional courses and to any other educational institutions (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

5. LOCAL CANDIDATES:

- 5.1 A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.
- i) If he/she has studied in an educational institution(s) in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic year ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination
- or
- ii) where, during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared in relevant qualifying examination, he/she has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared.
- 5.2 A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub regulation 3 above in relation to any local area shall:
- i) If he / she has studied in an educational institution in the state for a period of not less than seven (7) consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:
- a) Such local area where he/she studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years;

- b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he /she studied last in such equal periods;

(or)

- ii) If during the whole or any part of the 7 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, if he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of not less than four years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

- a) Such local area where he/she resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years;

(or)

- b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she resided last in such equal periods;

- Local status certificate issued by MRO through online for claiming as AP local as per Circular Nos.4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated.08.08.2016, 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dt. 20.11.2017 & G.O.Ms.No.129, dated 28-10-2019 of General Administration Dept.

5.3. EXPLANATIONS: For the Purpose of this regulation.

- i) "Educational Institution" means a University or any educational institution recognized by the State Government, a University or other competent authority.
- ii) "Relevant qualifying examination" in relation to admission to any course of study, means the examination, a pass in which the minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study.

NOTE: The relevant qualifying examination for admission to PG (Ayurveda) is Bachelor of Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery examination, the question whether a candidate is a local candidate or not shall be determined with reference to his/her first appearance in the Bachelor of Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery examination.

- iii) a) In reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied any period of interruption of his/her study by a reason of his/her failure to pass any examination shall be disregarded.
- b) Any period of his/her study in a State-wide University or a State-wide educational institution shall be disregarded

- iv) The question whether any candidate for admission into any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or guardian.

5.4. If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill up any seat reserved or allotted in favour of local candidate in respect of that local area, such seat shall be filled as if it had not been reserved.

5.5. The following categories of candidates are eligible to apply for admission to the remaining 15% of AP Unreserved seats.

- i)** All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of two local areas of State of Andhra Pradesh.
- ii)** Candidates, who have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State, or either of whose parents have resided in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the state.
- iii)** Candidates who are children of parents who are in employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions other similar quasi Public Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- iv)** Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State of Andhra Pradesh or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University or other Competent Authority and similar quasi Government Institutions within the State of Andhra Pradesh.”
- v)** Candidates, who are employed in the State Government undertakings, Public Sector, Corporations, local bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-public institutions with in the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- vi)** Candidates who are spouses of the local candidates as per rule-4(C).

Note: Relevant scanned original certificates must be uploaded along with application in respect of their claim for 15% Unreserved seats. In respect of proof of 10 years residence, the certificate should be obtained from the Revenue Authorities and the issuing Officer shall not be below the rank of Andhra Pradesh Mandal Revenue Officer / Tahsildar.

6. Service Weightage:

- 6.1 The service candidate shall be awarded extra weightage of marks on length and type of service as follows as on **30.09.2025**.
Rural service - 8% per each year upto maximum of 3 years.
Tribal service - 10% per each year upto maximum of 3 years.
- 6.2 An in-service candidate is one who has put in a minimum of three years of regular Service in Rural & Tribal areas of Andhra Pradesh.
- 6.3 Those in-service candidates who are having the remaining service of a minimum of eight (8) years as on the date of admission are only eligible to apply for the said seats.

7. RESERVATION:

- 7.1 a) Seats of Post Graduate MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses are reserved for SC, ST and BC sub groups as detailed below, which are called vertical reservations.

- b) As per Memo No.2825083/C1/2025, dt.23-05-2025 of HM&FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of AP the reservations provided to the three groups of Scheduled Castes shall be within fifteen (15%) of reservation prescribed to Scheduled Castes as follows:-

- 7.2** As per Memo No.2832690/C1/2025, dt.15-07-2025 of HM&FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of AP the implementation of SC sub-classification when availability of seats are less, has been examined in consultation with Social welfare Department and Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby clarify that:

- 1) When particular seat is not available, the rules with regard to sub-classification specify that if Group-I eligible candidate for admission is not available it shall be filled in by the candidate belonging to Group-II and so on and so forth.
- 2) In cases where the availability of seats is limited/less, the Competent authority for admissions may take appropriate administrative decisions regarding net group adjustments among the sub-groups of Scheduled Castes (SCs). This should be done by duly following the established procedure for net group adjustments as is practiced among the Backward Classes (BC) sub-groups. Such decisions must be placed before the selection committee for admissions, by justified reasons taking the spirit of sub-classification of Scheduled Castes.

7.3 CERTIFICATION OF CASTE:

- 7.3.1 As per Memo No.2832690/C1/2025, dt.21-07-2025 of HM&FW (C1) Dept., Govt. of A.P., **the Caste certificates issued by the Government of A.P will only be considered for admissions.**
- 7.3.2 Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Class candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish latest Integrated Caste Certificate with Barcode obtained from Government of A.P. in the prescribed form issued by the Concerned Authority. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 7.3.3 Latest Permanent caste certificate (issued by Competent Authority of Govt. of Andhra Pradesh only). **Caste certificates of other States will not be accepted** & in such cases the applied candidate will be considered under General category only.
- 7.3.4 Candidates claiming reservations under SC/ST/BC categories shall submit a permanent social status certificate mentioning the sub-caste in case of Scheduled Castes/ Backward Castes and sub-tribe or sub-group (in case of Scheduled Tribes) issued by the Competent Authority of Government of Andhra Pradesh only. The social status of SC/ST/BC candidates shall be subject to the scrutiny as per G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept. Dt 12-5-97 & as per G.O.Ms.No.7, Social Welfare (CV), dt.18-04-2025.
- 7.3.5 In case of Minority candidates, the Minority certificate issued by Minorities Welfare Department, Government of AP to be furnished in support of their claim

7.4. RESERVATION FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS (EWS):

The reservation of 10% in favour of Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates who are not covered under existing scheme of reservation for SC/ST & BCs will be made as per the procedure/ guidelines issued by the Government of AP in the Government Medical Colleges where additional seats are permitted by Govt. of India for the purpose. The persons seeking the benefit of reservation under EWS category

shall obtain the Income & Asset Certificate for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) **valid for the academic year 2025-26** issued by the Tahsildar on or after **01.04.2025**, who is the competent authority in state.

8. Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD):

- 1 5% of seats in each category (Horizontal Reservation) shall be reserved for Person with Benchmark Disability.
- 2 The candidates who applied and qualified under PwBD category in AIAPGET – 2025 are only eligible to participate under PwBD category in State Quota seats.
- 3 The Guidelines issued by Central Government and notified by the NCISM/NCH, (available on counselling website namely www.aaccc.gov.in under) shall be observed in making admissions of Persons with Disabilities (PwBD) candidates. The Medical Board constituted by the Competent Authority will examine and assess the percentage of disability of differently abled candidates, who have applied for admission under PwBD Quota. Such candidates have to appear before the Medical Board, to be constituted by the Competent Authority and notified by the University for Eligibility under PwBD status along with a valid disability certificate issued **not later than three months prior to** submitting his/her application. The report of the Medical Board is final for considering a candidate under PwBD Quota as per rules

9. APPLICATIONS THROUGH ONLINE:

9.1 The on-line application forms will be available on the Website

from 6.00 P.M. on 07-10-2025 to 6.00 P.M on 11-10-2025

9.2 The candidates are advised to take a print out of the Prospectus from the website <http://drntr.uhsap.in> before proceeding to fill in the correct application form.

- The candidate should fill the online application form available on the Website with the required data from a desktop/laptop only with internet connection.
- Candidates are advised to carefully go through the prospectus in detail and, upon confirming their eligibility, proceed to fill in the correct CQ Online Application Form. All required certificates should be kept readily available to ensure accurate and complete submission of information. It may be noted that no request for refund or transfer of fee will be considered in cases where an incorrect application is submitted.
- **No new applications shall be entertained beyond the notified cut-off date, and candidates will not be permitted to apply until the completion of Phase-III (Mop-Up) Counselling.**

9.3 Procedure of filling online application form and payment of fee through online:

The fee can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.


- a. Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully regarding eligibility under local and non-local.
- b. The Registration number which will be sent to the registered mobile after entering the basic details, should be noted for further use. The Registration number should be kept confidential and should not be disclosed to others.
- c. The candidates should fill - in all the correct details in the online application form and shall upload all the requisite documents.

12. VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES:

12.1 The eligibility of a candidate will be verified basing on the uploaded copies of scanned certificates/ documents.

The candidates who are claiming reservation under Special Categories i.e., PwBD, have to watch the university website for further notifications, if any, for scrutiny of original certificates of respective special category.

Note: The candidature of the applicant will not be considered for admission into MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses if not submitted the online application by uploading the scanned copies of required certificates/documents as per regulations.

The eligibility and community verification will be done basing on the uploaded scanned original certificates.

13. MERIT LIST:

- 13.1 The merit position of the candidates applied shall be determined basing on AIAPGET- 2025 Ranks and as per the eligibility
- 13.2 The University will release final merit position of the candidates eligible for exercising Web options, after completion of the verification of data and certificates uploaded by the candidates
- 13.3 Candidates who are included in the final merit list will only be eligible for exercising web options and the counseling for admissions will be held through online (web) mode only.

14. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

The procedure for Admissions/Selection/Seat Matrix is as per the Government Orders given below and subsequent amendments and any other orders that may be issued by the NCISM/Govt. of A.P/Dr. NTR UHS from time to time for Non-service/In-service candidates wherever applicable:

As per G.O.Ms.No.603, HM &FW(R2) Dept. dt.23.12.2004 as amended in

G.O.Ms.No.13, HM&FW(F2) Dept., dt.05.02.2021 & as per G.O.Ms.no.136, HM & FW

(C1) Dept., dt.12.10.2021 adopted for PG AYUSH courses

- 14.1. The Vice-Chancellor shall constitute a Selection Committee.
- 14.2. Provisional Selection shall be made by the Selection Committee constituted by the University.
- 14.3. The Selection Committee shall provisionally select the candidates as per these regulations from among the candidates as per merit list from the candidates who exercised web options.
- 14.4. Candidates have to exercise the options in response to this University notification.
- 14.5. The Selection Committee shall have power to review the provisional selection in case of any errors, misrepresentation, fraud or glaring injustice. In all matters relating to selections and admissions, the decision of the selection committee shall be final and binding on the candidates and selections cannot be questioned after admissions are closed.
- 14.6. If a candidate after choosing the subject fails to pay fees or after paying the fees fails to submit the bond, his/her selection stands cancelled automatically.
- Further, the Orders, if any, as amended from time to time by the Government of Andhra Pradesh /National Commission for Ayurveda/Government of India are applicable.

15. ADMISSION RULES:

- 15.1** The last date for reporting by the selected candidates at the allotted college will be given in the allotment order.
- 15.2** Candidates joining courses shall execute a bond on non judicial stamp paper of value of Rs.100/- in the form specified in Annexure-III to complete the prescribed period of training or in default to pay Rs.59,000/- (Rupees Fifty Nine thousand only) Rs.50,000+Rs.9,000 including GST@18% to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences and service candidates shall refund the stipend received up to that date to Government as notified by the University from time to time.

AS PER NCISM Regulations 2024

16. DURATION OF THE COURSE AND ATTENDANCE:

- 16.1** The duration of MD/MS (Ayurveda) Course is 3 years after the admission.
- 16.2** The candidate is required to put in a minimum of 80% attendance and total academic activities to become eligible for appearing in the University Examinations.

16.3 Candidates selected for the various courses shall be the whole-time students. Service candidates will have to apply for leave to prosecute their studies and are required to produce the leave sanction order not later than three months after reporting at the allotted college.

16.4 Acquiring requisite attendance shall be the responsibility of the Postgraduate students: Provided that, in case of deficiency of attendance, the duration of the course shall be extended proportionately.

16.5 There shall be no provision for vacation or preparatory holidays in Postgraduate Degree programme.

17. LEAVE: The below provided Leave policy shall be applicable for Postgraduate scholars:

17.1 Casual leaves up to 12 per academic year;

17.2 Academic activities such as attending seminar, workshops, training programme, orientation programme, symposium including days of travelling shall be considered as 'on duty';

17.3 Maternity, Paternity and other leaves as per respective State Government or contract rules as applicable.

18 MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

English shall be the medium of instruction and examination.

19. MATERNITY LEAVE:

Post Graduate students are eligible for maternity leave for the period as specified by the respective Councils/ Government of Andhra Pradesh from time to time. The study period will be extended to the extent of absence to the course.

19.1 SANCTION OF LEAVE OF ABSENCE BEYOND 3 MONTHS AND TERMINATION OF STUDENTSHIP:

20. BREAK OF STUDY AND RE-ADMISSION: If a student is absent continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course, his / her application in prescribed format vide Annexures IV & V by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, Dr NTR University of Health Sciences payable at Vijayawada shall be forwarded to the Registrar, Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences with the recommendation of the Dean/Principal. The candidates are advised to refer the regulations before submitting the application and paying the fee. If they fulfill the conditions, they may submit applications through the Dean/Principal of the College by paying the fee. A maximum of two spells of break of study is allowed during the entire period of course.

20.1. Maximum Duration to complete the Course: The Post-Graduate Degree Course- Doctor of Medicine in Ayurveda regulations 2024 issued by NCISM/Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi on 1st October, 2024 shall apply to students admitted into MD/MS(Ayurveda) Courses. As per NCISM/Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi regulations of 2024 under clause 20 (4) point is as follows:

- The maximum duration for completion of the course shall not exceed six years from the date of commencement of the academic course as per the academic calendar issued by the commission for that particular batch.

21. PRIVATE PRACTICE:

No Post Graduate is allowed to do any private practice or consultation and should not accept any part time employment in any State or Central or Quasi Government or Private organizations during the period of Post Graduation study. The Principal has to take appropriate action after giving opportunity for explanation, if any student violates this rule.

22. COLLEGE REGULATIONS:

Candidates are required to follow the rules and regulations of the college and should also abide by the regulations of the University. Under any circumstances candidates should not make any correspondence with the higher authorities of Government/Dr. NTR UHS directly without routing through proper channel.

23. STIPENDS:

23.1 Students who are regular in attendance and show good progress every month in their academic pursuits, The total period during which the stipends may be paid to the students shall not exceed thirty-six months for the course. No candidate will be eligible to draw the stipend for more than 36 months during the entire PG study period.

23.2 Service candidates shall not be paid stipend if they draw leave salary or salary.

24. COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:

The course shall normally commence as per the date mentioned in the provisional allotment order. The duration of the course shall be calculated from this date of commencement of the course and shall be uniform for all the candidates irrespective of their individual dates of admission.

25. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

24.1. Admissions shall be closed on the date as notified by the University as per the Regulations of NCISM/Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi.

24.2. Any vacancy as on the day of closure of admissions or that arises after closure of admissions shall not be filled up.

26. POWERS OF THE PRINCIPAL:

Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Principals of the Ayurvedic Colleges having PG Courses, may at any time before completion of the PG

course either on their own motion or on the application of any person after due and proper enquiry and after giving the person two weeks time from the date of the receipt of the show cause notice to submit written application and or on a personal hearing, order the cancellation of admission to the PG course if in their opinion such candidates had furnished false or incorrect information in the application form or in the documents attached, certificates enclosed thereto or in the statements made either before the authority in charge of admissions or the Principal or in any other fraudulent manner, obtained admission into such course. Against any such order of the Principal an appeal shall lie to the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Andhra Pradesh. Vijayawada.

27. POWER OF DR.NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

- 27.1 The Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences shall have the power to add or to delete or amend or alter these regulations from time to time
- 27.2 The University may either suo moto or on an application made to them, call for and examine records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof made by the authority in charge of selection or admission for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the legality or regularity of such selection or admission orders in relation thereto, as they deem fit including cancellation of the selections already published or admissions already made provided that the University may before cancelling such selection or admission give an opportunity to the authority in charge of selection or admission and to the person effected to show cause against such cancellation

28. FINALITY OF SELECTION:

All selections under these Regulations shall be subject to any general regulations or order that may be made by University from time to time.

29. ANTI RAGGING ACT:

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the state of AP vide Act.No.26 of 1997, dt.21-08-1997. The Anti Ragging Act is placed on the Website of the University for information.
