- After the receipt of the joining report from the Principal of the Government Unani Medical College, Chennai the advance tuition fees amount will be transferred to the College to get adjusted with the Tuition Fees to be paid by the candidates.
- If the candidate fails to join the course after getting allotment order within the stipulated date and time, he/she will forfeit the advance tuition fee amount as well as the seat allotted.
- 8. The candidates allotted to M.D. (Unani) course through Selection Committee, Commissionerate of Indian Medicine, and Homoeopathy, Arumbakkam, Chennai, will alone be registered for M.D. (Unani) Course in The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.

1.	All the candidate should ensure their eligibility criteria before submitting the online

2.	The application form other than the one filled in online mode will not be accepted, under			
	any circumstances.			
3.	a. Candidates should fill up all mandatory columns, upload all required documents and			
	submit the duly filled in online application. The candidates may download their filled in			
	online application form and secure a copy of the same for their future reference.			
	Subsequent submission of supporting document(s), is not accepted either on courier /			
	post / or in person.			
	b. Scanned PDF copies of all original certificates must be uploaded during filling the			
	online application form. The original certificates should be submitted in person only at			
	the time of admission in the respective college.			
4.	Service candidates should upload their service particulars as per Annexure – II (Service			
	Proforma) duly certified by the forwarding authority with date and seal along with the			
	filled in online application form. They should submit their hard copy of duly filled online			
	Application only through the proper channel with the remarks of the forwarding			
	authorities in the format prescribed in the application form to the Secretary, Selection			
	Committee, Commissionerate of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy. It should			
	compulsorily reach on or before the last date as mentioned above. If not, applications will			
	be summarily rejected irrespective of the date of submission by the applicant and date

5.	Same passport-size photograph used in AIAPGET 2025 (Unani) should be uploaded			
	in the space provided.			
6.	A list of eligible candidates will be uploaded in the official websites

7	Application Register Number (A.R. No.).			
7.	All information pertaining to M.D. (Unani) admission will be notified in the official			
	websites www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in, www.tnayushselection.org from time to time for			
	updates regarding PG provisional rank list, the Online Counselling Schedule and other			

information / intimations, etc. The Selection Committee will not be held responsible if any candidate fails to register or fails to lock the seat during online counselling due to ignorance of updates published on the website. No individual correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

8. **UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE:**

In case of unauthorized absence of candidate for one month or more after getting admitted to the Course, the candidate will be treated as having discontinued without notice and the vacancy will be filled up from the waiting list depending on the availability of time before the prescribed cut-off date. Candidates will have to give a declaration to this effect at the time of admission as in Annexure – V. If the period of absence is beyond the stipulated date as specified by Selection Committee, the candidate must pay the discontinuation fee as per clause 41 (ii) of this prospectus.

9. Note for Special Category: Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD)

- a. The candidates applying under PwBD is instructed to submit their required document as per Annexure-III through online and hard copy should be sent to Selection Committee along with the details of their application registration number after final submission.
- b. At the time of filling the online application, it is mandatory to upload the necessary supportive documents as mentioned in Annexure-III (with Full Size Photograph exhibiting the deformity).
- c. Special Category rank differs completely from that of the General Category rank.
- d. Special Category candidates cannot claim the same rank in the General Category and vice versa.
- e. Candidates are requested to produce a Certificate from the District Medical Board of the district concerned constituted for this purpose assessing the nature and the extent of physical disability in the format prescribed in the Annexure-III. The candidate must have obtained the certificate within 3 months prior to submission of the registration for seeking admission under this category. If the certificate has been obtained earlier, the application will be rejected. The candidates seeking admission under this category should produce the full-size photograph exhibiting the deformity.
- f. The candidates applied for M.D. (Unani) course will have to be required to undergo medical examination in person by a Medical Board constituted for the purpose by the Directorate of Medical Education to ascertain and confirm the nature and extent of

- physical disability.
- g. The Counselling for the Special Categories will be done in **offline mode** before the General Category Online Counselling at **Selection Committee**, **Commissionerate of Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy**, **Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine Campus**, Arumbakkam, Chennai 106.
- h. Counselling date for Special Category will be intimated in the website.
- i. The claim under Special Category will not be considered, under any circumstances without the required documents and the application of such candidate shall be considered under General Category only, if candidate fulfils the norms for the General Category.
- j. If adequate number of eligible candidates is not available under Special Category, then the earmarked seats will be reverted back to general category and filled up with candidates on the basis of merit and communal rotation.

II. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- a. A person possessing the degree of Unani (Tabeeb Kamil) (Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery) from the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University or from any other recognized University or Board or Medical Institution specified in erstwhile Indian Medicine Central Council Act 1970 or National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, and enrolled in Central Council of Indian System of Medicine or Tamil Nadu Board of Indian Medicine, with successful completion of CRRI before 31.07.2025 by the NCISM / AIAPGET-2025.
 - b. The candidates should fulfil the eligibility criteria for applying AIAPGET 2025; should have qualified in AIAPGET-2025 and should have obtained minimum of marks at 50th percentile. Provided that in respect of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Community, Backward Classes (Muslim) and Backward Classes; the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile; for candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of persons with disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for the General Category and 40th percentile for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Community, Backward Classes (Muslim) and Backward classes.

Note: Provided further that when sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in the All India AYUSH Post graduate Entrance Test (AIAPGET), as specified above, held for any academic year for admission to Post –

- Graduate courses, the Central Government in consultation with the Council may at its discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to Post Graduate Course for candidates belonging to respective categories and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for that academic year only.
- 11. The candidate should produce the Degree Certificate or the Provisional Certificate-II issued by the Affiliating University and Medical Registration Certificate issued by Central Council of Indian System of Medicine or Tamil Nadu Board of Indian Medicine, Chennai, in Original, at the time of joining in College.
- The Candidate should be a Citizen of India and a native of Tamil Nadu and should have undergone B.U.M.S. Course in the State of Tamil Nadu.
 - Candidates of Tamil Nadu nativity who have completed B.U.M.S. Course in other States shall furnish a Certificate of Nativity in Tamil Nadu issued by a competent authority only in the specified format prescribed in the ANNEXURE-I and should upload the Eligibility Certificate from the Tamil Nadu Dr. M. G. R. Medical University, Chennai and submit the same to the College at the time of joining.
 - Candidates from other States who have studied B.U.M.S. Course continuously in Tamil Nadu will be considered under the Open Category.
 - Submission of a false Nativity Certificate, if detected at any stage during the course of study, will result in expulsion of the candidate and initiation of criminal proceedings against the candidate and their parents, as per the law.
 - Nativity Certificates Previously obtained or e-Nativity Certificates in the latest updated format issued by an authority not below the rank of Zonal Deputy Tahsildar of the concerned Revenue Jurisdiction will be accepted.
 - Community Certificates issued by other States will not be considered for reservation.

 Such candidates will be treated under the Open Category.
 - Candidates who are claiming community reservation of Tamil Nadu should upload both following certificates,
 - i. Community Certificate issued by competent authority from Revenue Department of Tamil Nadu Government with official seal; and
 - ii. Community Certificate of either of their Parents issued by competent authority from Revenue Department of Tamil Nadu Government with official seal.

13. Candidates must fill their AIAPGET - 2025 (Unani) Hall Ticket Roll Number, Marks scored and All India Rank in the relevant fields of the registration form. The original Hall Ticket and Marks Statement must be produced at the time of joining.

14. NOT ELIGIBLE

- Candidates who join a Post Graduate Degree [MD (Unani)] in any branch and discontinue the Course on any grounds after the cutoff date fixed by NCISM are not eligible to apply for two subsequent academic years.
- Candidates who have completed a Post Graduate Degree [MD (Unani)] or the Candidates who possess a Post Graduate Degree [MD (Unani)] in one Specialty / Branch of study are not eligible to apply for admission to any other Post Graduate Degree i.e., in any other branches.
- List of Candidates notified / intimated as NOT Eligible by AYUSH Admissions Central Counselling Committee (AACCC) from time to time.

III. DEFINITION OF SERVICE CANDIDATES & NON-SERVICE CANDIDATES

15. **SERVICE CANDIDATES:**

The following categories of Unani Medical Graduates only will be treated as Service candidates and considered for selection against 50% of seats reserved exclusively for Service Candidates

- (i) Unani Medical Graduates who were selected by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission / Medical Services Recruitment Board and other regularized service candidates and appointed in the Tamil Nadu Medical Service on regular basis, who have put in minimum of TWO years satisfactory and continuous service excluding leave period such as Earned Leave, Unearned Leave on Medical Certificate, Unearned Leave on Private Affairs, Maternity Leave and any other unauthorized absence, as on 31.07.2025 either in Tamil Nadu Medical Service or local bodies and State Organizations.
- (ii) Candidates above 50 years as on 31.07.2025 are not eligible to apply.
- (iii) Unani Medical Graduates who are approved Probationers and who are working
 - a. As Medical Officers working (continuously for two years) in Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu. A Doctor absorbed from the Panchayat Union into Government Service as per G.O.Ms. No 435 / H&FW / IMI-2 Dept. dated: 23-11-2000 will be considered as Service Candidates provided that they should have completed 2 years of service.

- b. In Government of India Institutions in the State of Tamil Nādu.
- c. In Public Sector Undertaking and Organizations under the Control of Government of India in Tamil Nadu.
- d. In undertaking or organization of Government of Tamil Nadu.

Note:

The candidates under Clause 15, sub clause (ii) item (a) to (d) above should give an undertaking to the concerned authorities that they will serve for 5 years in their respective institutions after the completion of course. They should produce a certificate from the concerned authority to show that they have given such an undertaking as per Tamil Nadu Government rules.

16. NON-SERVICE CANDIDATES

The following category of Unani Medical Graduates will be treated as Non- Service Candidates.

- a. Private Unani Practitioners Registered under Tamil Nadu Board of Indian Medicine.
- b. Those service candidates selected by TNPSC / MSRB who have put in less than two years of continuous regular service as on 31.07.2025 will be treated as non-Service candidates.
- c. All others who have put in less than two years of State Government Service or who are working in Central Government, Public Sector Undertaking, Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS), Local bodies, National Rural Health Mission and Municipalities in Tamil Nadu and Tamil Nadu Government Undertakings and Organizations will be treated as non-Service candidates.

17. PROCEDURE FOR FILLING AND SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

- Candidates are advised to download the Prospectus from the official website and read it thoroughly before filling the online registration form for the academic year 2025–2026.
- The candidate should login to the official website: www.tnayushselection.org
- Registration forms will be available online from 18-10-2025 to 22-10-2025 up to 5:00 P.M.
- Candidates should pay a non-refundable registration fee of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) towards application form through the online payment

portal.

I. General Instructions

- All mandatory fields in application must be completed.
- Relevant documents should be uploaded in PDF format except photo and signature.
- The completed registration must be submitted online after verifying all details.
- No request for changes in any particulars will be entertained after the application has been submitted.

II. Documents to be Uploaded

- Signature in running handwriting. Initials or full name in capital letters are not accepted.
- Any other supporting document (if applicable)

Note:

- Ensure the photograph and signature are uploaded in the correct fields.
- After submission, candidates are advised to download and keep a copy of the filled-in online registration for future reference.
- The Original certificates must be produced at the time of Admission in college.

III. Declaration and Verification

- All entries in the online registration form must be filled carefully by the candidate.
- The candidate must ensure that all information, including academic marks and uploaded documents, are true and accurate.
- If any discrepancy is found during scrutiny:
 - a. The candidate will forfeit their admission, regardless of the stage of the course.
 - b. The candidate will be debarred from pursuing any other course for a period of three years
 - c. Legal/criminal action will be initiated against the candidate for submitting false documents (e.g., Mark Sheet, Degree Certificate, Community Certificate, Nativity Certificate, etc.).

IV. Instructions for Filling the Online Application Form

- a. The candidate must verify eligibility before submitting the application form.
- b. Only Application submitted trough online will be accepted. Application submitted through any other mode will be rejected.

VI. Important Points

- Only one application should be submitted by a candidate.
- Ensure all information and documents are accurate at the time of submission.
- Incomplete application or application without mandatory enclosures will be rejected.
- Registration fee towards application form once paid is non-refundable.
- Application once submitted cannot be withdrawn.

18. **METHOD OF FEE PAYMENT:**

i. Mode of Payment:

The application and course fees should be paid through Debit Cards (except Visa / Master Card), Credit Card, Net Banking, UPI, or Digital Wallets (such as Google Pay, Paytm, etc.). Necessary facilities for payment have been integrated into the online payment portal.

ii. **Important Note:**

Mere deduction of the amount from the bank account will not be considered as proof of successful fee payment. Candidates must ensure that the payment confirmation is received and that the registration status reflects the successful transaction.

iii. **Preparation Before Payment:**

Before proceeding with payment, candidates are advised to:

- a. Check the validity of their Debit/Credit Card.
- b. Keep necessary banking or payment information readily available.

c. Enter all requisite details while making the payment on the portal carefully.

iv. Refund of Advance Tuition Fees:

The candidates withdrawing on or before the stipulated date and time of joining in Round 1 and Round 2, the advance tuition fee will be refunded only to the bank account for which details are provided at the time of application. Candidates are advised to ensure that the account details entered in the online application form are accurate and belong to them.

19. **DURATION OF M.D. (Unani) COURSE:**

The duration of the MD (Unani) course will be for three years.

IV. MODE OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION

20. A Provisional Rank List of eligible candidates will be prepared based on the marks and rank obtained in AIAPGET– 2025 (Unani). Admission to the M.D. (Unani) Course will be made strictly from this rank list only.

The Secretary, Selection Committee will publish the provisional rank list on the official website: www.tnayushselection.org

Tie-Breaking Criteria (Inter-se Merit):

If two or more candidates have secured the same number of marks, the tie shall be resolved and inter-se merit shall be determined based on the higher rank in AIAPGET-2025(Unani).

21. i. Non-Service candidates:

Admission to the Course will be made purely on merit, based on the marks obtained in the AIAPGET-2025(Unani).

ii. Service Candidates:

Admission to the Course will be made, based on the marks obtained in the AIAPGET-2025(Unani) and additional weightage marks awarded to eligible in-service candidates. One mark will be awarded for each completed year of Government Service. Two marks will be awarded for each completed year of Government Service in Hill areas and it will be limited to maximum of 10 marks, as per G.O.(Ms)No.320 Health and Family Welfare [IM 1-2] Department, dated: 26.09.2023.

22. **ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:**

ii. Advance Tuition Fee:

At the time of choice locking, candidates must pay a refundable advance tuition fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) for Government quota seats.

Note: This amount will not be refunded if a seat is allotted from the third round of counselling.

iii. Counselling Schedule:

The counselling schedule will be published on the official website www.tnayushselection.org.

Candidates must login and lock their choices for each round of counselling within the stipulated dates and time as per the schedule.

iv. Choice Filling:

- Candidates are advised to exercise caution during choice filling and to select preferred colleges and specialties according to their individual preferences.
- Choices can be edited until they are locked.
- Once choices are locked, they cannot be modified under any circumstances.

v. Seat Allotment:

Admission to M.D.(Unani) Courses will be through online counselling, based on candidate rank and as per reservation norms, considering the preferences entered by the candidate.

vi. Security Guidelines:

Candidates should not share their login credentials (Login ID, Password, OTP) with anyone to ensure data security and prevent misuse.

vii. Provisional Allotment:

Provisionally selected candidates for Government seats must download the provisional allotment order and join the college in which they are allotted within the stipulated date and time.

viii. Eligibility for Further Rounds:

Candidates who have joined a seat up to Round 3 and who have been allotted seat in Round 3 of All India Quota or State Quota counselling will **not be eligible** to participate in subsequent rounds for either quota for the academic year 2025–2026, as per the NCISM Information Bulletin.

ix. Centralized Data Upload:

The Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of NCISM, MoHFW, has developed a

centralized software platform for all participating States/Counselling Authorities under AACCC. This platform will be used to upload the names and roll numbers of candidates who have joined up to Round 3 (and further rounds) under the State Quota or Round 3 of the All India Quota on a common portal.

I. ROUND 1 OF ONLINE COUNSELLING

- a. Candidates should pay the following fees through the online bank payment portal:
 - A non-refundable online processing fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) at the time of Choice filling.
 - A refundable advance tuition fee of Rs. 5,000 (Rupees Five Thousand only) at the time of Choice locking.
- b. Candidates are advised to be careful during choice filling and are encouraged to select only preferred specialties.
- c. Choices can be edited before locking. However, once the choices are locked, they cannot be modified under any circumstances.
- d. Candidates who are allotted a seat in Round 1 of the online counselling should download their Provisional allotment order and join the course in the respective college on or before the stipulated date and time.

II. ROUND 2 OF ONLINE COUNSELLING

- a. Candidates who wish to retain their allotted seats and do not want a change are not required to participate in Round 2.
- b. Candidates who are allotted a seat in Round 1 and joined / not joined or discontinued from the course within the stipulated date and time will remain eligible to participate in the round 2 of the online counselling.
- c. Re-allotment of seats will be permitted during Round 2 and Round 3 of counselling, based on the candidate's rank and in accordance with the reservation norms.
- d. Re-choice filling is not required for candidates who have locked their choice for Round 1 but were not allotted a seat in the same round.
- e. Fresh choice filling is permitted in Round 2 only for candidates who did not lock their choice in Round 1 and such candidates should pay a non-refundable online processing fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) at the time of choice filling and a refundable advance tuition fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) at time of choice locking.

- f. If a candidate is upgraded/re-allotted in Round 2, he/she will have no claim over the seat allotted to them in Round-1, and have to join the seat allotted in Round 2. In addition, the seat allotted in Round 1 will be made available to other candidates based on descending order of provisional rank list and not ascending order.
- g. Choice filling for Round 2 will follow the payment of online processing fee is not mandatory for:
 - Candidates seeking upgradation
 - Not-joined candidates
 - Unallotted candidates
- h. A candidate who has not joined or discontinued the Course before the stipulated time will remain eligible for subsequent rounds of the counselling for the academic year 2025–2026 without forfeiting any fee.
- i. A candidate who has joined and discontinued the course after the stipulated time should forfeit the advance tuition fee already paid by the candidate. Virtual Vacancies

- If a candidate allotted a seat in Round 1 opts for upgradation in Round 2, that Round 1 seat will be displayed as a virtual vacancy.
- All candidates will be allowed to fill choices for virtual vacancies during Round 2 choice filling.
- However, such seats will be converted to real vacancies and allotted in Round 2 only if the candidate from Round 1 vacates or upgrades the seat.

Fee Payment

Eligibility for Round 3

- f. Candidates who fail to join the seat allotted in Round 3 will:
 - Forfeit both the online processing fee and advance tuition fee paid
 - Become ineligible for any further rounds of counselling.

Hence, the Candidates are advised to exercise due diligence in their options and do not fill unwanted options in which they do not wish to pursue studies.

IV. STRAY ROUND OF COUNSELLING

- a. Stray vacancies, if any, arising after the completion of Round 3 counselling will be filled through a Stray Round, conducted by the Selection Committee under the direction of the Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, by following the guidelines of NCISM.
- b. Only candidates who are not holding any seat in the M.D. (Unani) Course (have not been allotted seats in Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3) are eligible to participate in this round.
- c. Candidates who have already joined any seat under the All India or State Quota for M.D. (UNANI) are not eligible for this round.
- d. Candidates who want to participate a fresh in the Stray Round (or any subsequent special rounds), they must pay a non-refundable online Registration fee of Rs.3,000 /- (Rupees Three Thousand only) towards application, Online Processing fee of Rs.1,000 /- (Rupees One Thousand only) and advance tuition fee of Rs.5,000 /- (Rupees Five Thousand only) via the online bank payment portal.
- e. If a seat is allotted in the Stray Round, the candidate should download the

provisional allotment order and join the allotted College within the stipulated date and time mentioned in the allotment order. If a candidate either fails to download the allotment order, or downloaded but fails to join the allotted College within the stipulated deadline, then the registration fee and advance tuition fee paid by the candidates will be forfeited and the candidate will be debarred from participating in M.D. (Unani) Counselling for the next academic year.

f. If a candidate joined the College through the Stray Round and then discontinued the Course after the stipulated date and time as prescribed by NCISM/AACCC or the State Selection Committee, the registration fee and advance tuition fee paid by the candidates will be forfeited. In addition, he/she must pay a discontinuation fee of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only).

i.Malpractice / Misconduct / Legal Violations

- a. If any candidate is found to have engaged in impersonation, suppressed or misrepresented facts, or submitted falsified/bogus Certificates, the provisional allotment order will be cancelled and legal/criminal proceedings will be initiated.
- b. If, during AIAPGET (Unani) PG 2025 or at any stage of the allotment/admission process for M.D. (Unani) 2025–2026 in Tamil Nadu, a candidate is found guilty of impersonation (e.g., mismatched photograph/signature/documents), they will be handed over to the police by the principal or by the Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, and the case will be pursued under the Indian Penal Code. Such candidates will be permanently debarred from future M.D. (Unani) admissions in Tamil Nadu.

ii. Disclaimer

The Selection Committee shall not be responsible for:

- Rules and regulations of the NCISM or any other authority
- Candidates are advised to review the official websites of respective Colleges and NCISM before exercising their choices.

iii. Seat Matrix Notification

The seat matrix for Government Quota seats in Government Unani Medical College will be published on the official website prior to counselling.

- 29. Candidates allotted seat in Special Category are not eligible for General Counselling.
- 30. Branch and college once opted and allotted to the candidate at the time of Counselling cannot be changed subsequently under any circumstances.

- 31. The Post Graduate Degree Course M.D. (Unani) admissions for 2025 2026 session will be closed on the cut-off date of admission as prescribed by the Ministry of AYUSH/ National Commission for Indian System of Medicine / Government of India /Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University for the academic year 2025 2026.
 - 32. Candidates who have joined a Post-Graduate Degree M.D. (Unani) Course in any discipline and have discontinued the course on any grounds after the cut-off date, are not eligible to apply for subsequent two academic years of any discipline in Post Graduate Degree Course M.D. (Unani). Further the candidate shall be considered as discontinued and should pay the Discontinuation Fee as per this prospectus.
 - 33. The candidates who join Post Graduate Degree Course M.D. (Unani) should not indulge in any kind of agitation / strike / ragging activity inside / outside the College campus during the course of study. Candidates will have to give a Discipline Declaration to this effect at the time of admission as in Annexure IV. Candidates found to take part in any such activities mentioned above will be expelled from the course/college at any point during the course of study and criminal action will be taken against them.

34. No re-allotment for Special Category.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NATIVITY CERTIFICATE

- 1. This Certificate should be issued by an officer of the Revenue Department not below the rank of Tahsildar in the Taluk concerned.
- 2. This Certificate should not be issued by the Special Tahsildars, Deputy Tahsildars such as Loans, Land Acquisition, Election, Excise and HQs, Deputy Tahsildars, Special Deputy Collectors, Assistant Commissioner of Agricultural Income, Excise, and Elections etc.
- 3. This Certificate should be signed also by the Village Administrative Officer.
- 4. The Certificate should bear the stamp of the office of the Officer signing the Certificate.

- (i) The parents/guardians of the applicants/students or the applicants themselves shouldhave permanently resided continuously for a period of five years in Tamil Nadu.
- (ii) Permanently residing for a period of five years should be supported by Documentary evidence.
- (iii) The family ration card, Electoral Roll, Census List if taken recently, documents like sale deed, tax receipt etc. relating to the property owned by either of the parents or by the applicant may be verified.
- (iv) The Transfer Certificate issued by the School authorities where the applicant had studied last may be verified to know whether he was in the state for five years.
- (v) Enquiry in the village / place of residence of the neighbour / Village Administrative Officers regarding continuous residing.
- (vi) To ensure that wrong or incorrect address had not been furnished to obtain the certificate.
- (vii) The birth place, the present place of residence of the parent / father, Permanent assets, mother tongue, place of education, place of marriage of the applicant / parents, the period of stay in and outside Tamil Nadu can also be considered before issuing certificate.
