#### **NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-III/MoP UP COUNSELLING FOR NON-SERVICE CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA (CQ) SEATS OF POST-GRADUATE MEDICAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE NON-MINORITY AND MINORITY MEDICAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO DR. NTRUHS AND SVIMS, TIRUPATI FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26.**

In continuation to this Office Notifications, dt.18-09-2025, 25-09-2025, 29-10-2025, 29-11-2025 & 23-12-2025 Dr.NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-III/MoP UP of counselling for **Non-service candidates** for admissions into Competent Authority Quota (CQ) PG Medical Degree/Diploma courses available in the Government and Private Non-Minority and Minority Medical Colleges under Dr.NTR UHS and SVIMS, Tirupati for the academic year 2025-26.

- a) Seats available after Phase-II of Non-Service Vacant, Not Reported, Free Exit will be filled in this Phase of counselling.
- b) Vacant/Not Reported service seats after Phase-III reverted to Non-service will be filled in this phase of counselling.

All the eligible candidates (Non-service including (PwBD) whose names are in the Consolidated final Merit Position notified on 06-02-2026 in the University Website are only eligible to exercise web options as per the above dates according to the Seat Matrix displayed on 29-11-2025, and Seat Matrix for enhanced seats on 23-12-2025 (Phase-2) & 02-02-2026 (Phase-3) in the website <http://drntr.uhsap.in>

#### **1. Security Deposit:**

To prevent seat blocking and ensure that valuable seats are effectively utilized during the Phase-III (Mop Up) round, the Competent Authority has decided to collect a *refundable security deposit* of ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) through online payment. This applies to candidates in the Merit List under the Competent Authority Quota and intend to participate in the Phase-III (Mop Up) round of counselling, subject to the following conditions:

- i. Refundable Security Deposit of candidates who do not join the seats allotted to them in Phase-III (Mop Up) round or in subsequent stray rounds, if any, **will be forfeited** and not eligible for further rounds of counselling for both CQ & MQ.
- ii. If the candidate joins the allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.
- iii. If the candidate is not allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.

iv. Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason. e.g. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within stipulated time)

**Note:** Candidates who have paid the security deposit during the Phase-III (Mop Up) round and not allotted any seat will be eligible to exercise web options in the Stray Vacancy Round without having to pay the security deposit again.

2. **UNIVERSITY FEE:** Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I/Phase-II need not pay again.
3. **TUITION FEE:** The following is the Tuition fee structure for the academic year 2025-26 to be payable for the Competent Authority Quota seats in Private Unaided Medical Colleges as per G.O.RT.No.777, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 09-11-2025 of Government of Andhra Pradesh subject to the outcome of the W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

1	Seat Matrix is displayed in the University Website <a href="https://drntr.uhsap.in">https://drntr.uhsap.in</a> for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Consolidated Final Merit list displayed on 06-02-2026 are eligible to opt for Phase-III/MoP UP.
2	Seat Matrix displayed on 02-02-2026 is only for the newly sanctioned/enhanced seats after Phase-2 counselling.
3	<p>Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus (placed in the University website on 27-09-2024) and the Government Orders on Rules of PG admissions available before exercising web options. Candidates are also advised to go through the details about “MRC” concept which is exemplified below:</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) In a particular college MD(RD) seat is under “Open Category” in the seat matrix and a SC candidate is allotted that Open Category MD(RD) seat in Open Round Counselling of Phase-I as per his/her web options and NEET Rank merit order of the candidate. Now this candidate is shown as <b>Meritorious Reserved Candidate (MRC)</b>.</li> <li>b) The same SC candidate has slid to MD (General Medicine) SC category seat in the same college or another college during the Category Round of Phase-I Counselling <b>conducted on the same day</b>, then that MD(RD) seat vacated by this MRC candidate shall be filled with the SC candidates only by merit amongst them.</li> <li>c) This type of MRC concept is to be followed for all BC/SC/ST categories in order to maintain 50 : 50 ratio of Open : Category Reservation</li> <li>d) G.Os governing MRC and other regulations:           <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 4	<p>Filling up of PG (Medical) Seats in Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada for the academic year 2025-26:</p> <p>The Government of Andhra Pradesh vide G.O.Rt.No.475, HM&amp;FW (C1) Dept., dt.22-07-2025 ordered “to continue Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada as a State wide Educational Institution and admissions to 85% of the available seats (after deducting All India Quota seats) shall be divided between local candidates of Andhra University and Sri Venkateswara University regions in the ratio of 65.62% and 34.38%, with the remaining 15% treated as unreserved.</p> <p>The definition of local candidates and eligibility in respect of 85% local seats and 15% unreserved seats shall be as per respective admission rules of Undergraduate Medical and Postgraduate Medical courses applicable to Government Professional Institutions.”</p>
5	<p>As per the year 2024-25 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2024-25 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).</p>
6	<p>As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2022-23 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).</p>
7	<p>Candidates opting for Medical Degree/Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web options. Candidates can exercise any number of options for any number of specialties and colleges available. <b>Mere exercising of web options does not confer any right for allotment of seat, it is subject to availability of seat as per the Seat Matrix.</b></p>
8	<p>Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options. Candidates are advised to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. <b>If they are not interested to join any specialty or college then they are advised not exercise options for the same and avoid seat blocking.</b></p>
9	<p><b>The Eligible PwBD candidates can exercise web options only for the specialties recommended by the Medical Board, as notified in the PwBD candidates Eligible &amp; Not Eligible list, displayed on University website on 02-02-2026.</b></p>
10	<p>a) The candidate can login at any point of time after submission of web options for rearranging the priority list before the cutoff date.</p> <p>b) Options which are not saved will be saved automatically and will be considered for allotments.</p> <p>C) Options once submitted cannot be altered/changed at any later stage.</p>
11	<p>The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.</p>
12	<p>The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.</p>
13	<p>The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr.NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slided college by the concerned college where the amount is held.</p>

16	<p>Eligibility for Exercising web options for Stray Counselling:</p> <p>a) The candidates who are not holding a seat or got no seats in Phase-I, Phase-II, Phase-III of counselling (AIQ, State, Deemed) can participate in Stray Vacancy Round.</p> <p>b) The candidates who have been allotted, but not joined in Phase 1, Phase 2 of State Quota and All India Quota are eligible to participate in this counselling.</p> <p>c) A Candidate who has registered but no choice locked in the Phase 1 or Phase 2 or Phase 3(Mop up) ONLINE COUNSELLING will be permitted to attend Stray Round of ONLINE COUNSELLING.</p> <p><b>Not Eligible Candidates:</b></p> <p>a) The candidates who are holding PG (Medical) seat in Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3 (Mop Up) of State Counselling are not eligible to participate in Stray round of counselling.</p> <p>b) The candidate who is holding a seat allotted in Round 1 &amp; Round 2 and Round 3 in All India Quota/Deemed universities(conducted by MCC/DGHS).</p> <p>c) All the candidates who have been allotted a seat in stray round of All India Quota/Deemed universities(conducted by MCC/DGHS) are not eligible to participate in State Stray Round of counselling.</p> <p>d) A candidate allotted a seat in Phase 3 (Mop up) of State counselling and not joined the seat cannot participate in further rounds of State Counselling both CQ &amp; MQ.</p> <p>e) A candidate allotted a seat in Phase 3 (Mop up) of State counselling and not joined the seat cannot participate in further rounds of State Counselling.</p>
17	<p>As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, A candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat. In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,54,000/- (including 18% GST).</p>
18	<p>All the allotments will be subject to the final orders of pending writ petitions if any.</p>
19	<p>The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.</p>
