NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-III/MoP UP COUNSELLING OF MANAGEMENT QUOTA SEATS (S1, S2 & S3) FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE POST GRADUATE MEDICAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE PRIVATE NON-MINORITY AND MINORITY MEDICAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO Dr. NTR UHS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

In continuation to this Office Notifications, dt.18-11-2025, 05-12-2025 & 23-12-2025, Dr. NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-III/MoP UP counselling for admissions into Management Quota seats of PG Medical Degree/Diploma courses in Private Un-aided Non-minority and Minority Colleges for the academic year 2025-26:

- Seats available after Phase-II Vacant, Not Reported & Free Exit will be filled in this phase of counselling.

All the eligible candidates whose names are in the Consolidated final Merit Position notified in the University Website on 06-02-2026 are only eligible to exercise web options as per the above dates and according to the Seat Matrix displayed on 05-12-2025, and Seat Matrix for enhanced seats on 23-12-2025 (Phase-2) & 06-02-2026 (Phase-3) in the website <http://drntr.uhsap.in>

1. Security Deposit:

To prevent seat blocking and ensure that valuable seats are effectively utilized during the Phase-III (Mop Up) Round, the Competent Authority has decided to collect a *refundable security deposit* of ₹3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs only) through online payment. This applies to candidates who are in the Merit List under the Management Quota and intend to participate in the Phase-III (Mop Up) round of counselling, subject to the following conditions:

- Refundable Security Deposit of candidates who do not join the seats allotted to them in Phase-III (Mop Up) Round or in subsequent stray rounds, if any, **will be forfeited** and not eligible for further rounds of counselling for both CQ & MQ.
- If the candidate joins the allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.
- If the candidate is not allotted seat, the Security Deposit amount will be refunded to the candidate **after closure of admissions**.

- iv. Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason. e.g. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within stipulated time)

Note: Candidates who have paid the security deposit during the Phase-III (Mop Up) round and were not allotted any seat will be eligible to exercise web options in the Stray Vacancy Round without having to pay the security deposit again.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I/Phase-II need not pay again.

TUITION FEE: The following is the Tuition fee structure for the academic year 2025-26 to be payable for the Management Quota seats in Private Un-aided Medical Colleges as per G.O.RT.No.777, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 09-11-2025 of Government of Andhra Pradesh subject to the outcome of the W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

Note: For the year 2025-26 there are no CA-NRI PG seats in respect of the newly permitted Government Medical Colleges from the academic year 2023-24.

Distribution of seats is as detailed below:

- 1) As per G.O.Ms.No.57, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 28-04-2023 (Non-Minority Colleges):
 - a) Management Quota-Subcategory- 1(S1): 25% of the sanctioned intake of seats, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by the candidates in General Merit based on the NEET PG-2025 ranking.
 - b) Management Quota-Subcategory-2(S2): 15% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each institution shall be filled by foreign students/ NRI/NRI sponsored candidates on the basis of inter-se-merit among the applicants qualified in NEET PG-2025.
 - c) Management Quota-Subcategory-3(S3): 10% seats out of total intake capacity, course wise, in each Institution shall be Institutional preference/In- service management quota seats filled on the basis of inter-se-merit among the

applicants qualified in NEET PG-2025.

2) As per G.O.Ms.No.102, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated 15-07-2023:

a) 15% of Subcategory-1 seats only are open to the candidates from all over the Country – S1A

b) For the Remaining 85% of Subcategory-1 seats only Local Candidates of Andhra Pradesh i.e., AU/SVU are only eligible – S1B.

3) As G.O.Ms.No.163, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 05.12.2025 (Newly permitted Govt. Medical College from the academic year 2023-24 onwards):

a) **Competent Authority (Self-financing):** 35% of the seats shall be Competent Authority (self-financing) category and the same shall be filled with local candidates of two local areas of Andhra Pradesh.

b) **Competent Authority (NRI Category):** 15% of the seats shall be Competent Authority (NRI Category).

Instructions to Candidates:

1	Seat Matrix is displayed in the University Website https://drntr.uhsap.in for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Consolidated Final Merit list displayed on 06-02-2026 are eligible to opt for Phase-III/MoP UP.
2	As per the year 2024-25 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2024-25 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
3	As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2022-23 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2025-26 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
4	Candidates opting for Medical Degree/Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web options. Candidates can exercise any number of options for any number of specialities and colleges available. Mere exercising of web options does not confer any right for allotment of seat, it is subject to availability of seat as per the Seat Matrix.
5	Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options. Candidates are advised to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If they are not interested to join any speciality or college then they are advised not exercise options for the same.
6	Candidates reported/allotted a particular specialty in a college during CQ Phase-I/Phase-II will not be considered for the same specialty in the same college under MQ , irrespective of their web options. This rule is implemented to maintain fairness in the admission process and to avoid seat blocking.
7	In respect of S1B seats, preference will be given to local candidates of Andhra Pradesh and if eligible candidates from Andhra Pradesh are not available, the same will be allotted to S1A candidates based on Merit list, options and subject to availability of seats.
8	<p>a) The candidate can login at any point of time after submission of web options for rearranging the priority list before the cutoff date.</p> <p>b) Options which are not saved will be saved automatically and will be considered for allotments.</p> <p>c) Options once submitted cannot be altered at any later stage.</p>
9	The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.49,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.
10	The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.
11	The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr. NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slided college by the concerned college where the amount is held.

12	<p>Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (MoP Up) Counselling</p> <p>The following candidates are eligible:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> It is decided to collect a Refundable Security Deposit Amount of ₹.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakh only) through online mode from the candidates who wishes to participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) and subsequent Phases of Counselling to avoid seat blocking. Other details will be notified in the Web Option notification of that Phase. All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I/Phase-II seat. All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling. All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II <ol style="list-style-type: none"> but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges. Joined but resigned from the allotted seat as per University Notifications for free exit. <p>However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II or resigned from the joined seat of Phase-I/Phase-II, then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling.</p> Phase-I /II joined/reported seat shall be the default last option. Candidates allotted/upgraded under CQ in Phase-III shall not have any claim on the seat held in Phase-I/Phase-II either in CQ or MQ. If a candidate is allotted a seat under MQ in Phase-III, they must compulsorily report. The previously held MQ seat from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated. The Phase-I or Phase-II seat vacated because of the up-gradation during the course of Phase-III counselling will be added and allotted simultaneously to the next candidates as per the merit and rules. The allotted candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II or Phase-III(Mop Up) Counselling are not eligible for Stray or any further rounds. Candidates allotted a seat in CQ & MQ Phase III (Mop-Up) cannot participate in subsequent rounds of State Counselling of both CQ & MQ Counselling, regardless of whether they report to the allotted college. All the AIQ joined candidates up to Round 3 counselling will be blocked for State Phase-III/Mop UP and Stray counselling of both CQ & MQ even if they have exercised web options Candidates allotted/upgraded in CQ Phase-III irrespective of their reporting status will be blocked from participating in MQ Phase-III counselling, even though if they have exercised web options. The data of AIQ joined candidates up to Round - 3 as shared by MCC will be weeded out during Phase-III seat processing of State Counselling for both CQ & MQ. If a candidate is allotted a seat under CQ in Phase-III, they must compulsorily report. The previously held MQ seat (if any) from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated, regardless of whether the candidate reports to the new CQ seat in Phase-III. The vacated MQ seat will be made available for allocation during MQ Phase-III Counselling. If a candidate is allotted a seat in Phase-III, he/she has to compulsorily report & join the allotted seat/college else the Security Deposit amount of ₹.3,00,000/- will be forfeited and he/she cannot participate in further rounds of counselling. In respect of S1B seats, preference will be given to local candidates of Andhra Pradesh and if eligible candidates from Andhra Pradesh are not available, the same will be allotted to S1A candidates based on Merit list, options and subject to availability of seats. MCC of DGHS will share the data of joined candidates in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 counselling with all the participating States. Similarly, the participating States will also share the data of joined candidates. Candidates who have joined up to Round 3 of MCC counselling and also the allotted candidates of Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling will be filtered and weeded out before processing for Stray Vacancy round of counselling of AP State. As per MCC counselling Scheme 2025, the joined candidates up to Round 3 of MCC counselling cannot upgrade or resign after Round 3. If any candidate is allotted seat in Round 3 of AIQ/Deemed/Central Quota such candidates cannot participate in Phase-III (Mop Up) or subsequent phases of State Counselling.
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13	<p>a) Candidates who are allotted a seat in this Phase-III (Mop Up) counselling must compulsorily report.</p> <p>b) Candidates upgraded in Phase-III (Mop Up) shall not have any claim on the seat held/joined in Phase-I/Phase-II.</p> <p>c) Candidates while giving options should note that the seats vacated by the candidates admitted in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling and slid to other college/course during this Phase-III (Mop Up) of counselling process (virtual vacancies) will be added & allotted simultaneously during this Phase of counselling itself.</p>
14	<p>Eligibility for Exercising web options for Stray Counselling:</p> <p>a) The candidates who have not been allotted in Phase 1, Phase 2, Phase 3 of counselling.</p> <p>b) The candidates who have been allotted, but not joined in Phase 1, Phase 2 of State Quota and All India Quota are eligible to participate in this counselling.</p> <p>c) A Candidate who has registered and not choice locked in the Phase 1 or Phase 2 or Phase 3(Mop up) ONLINE COUNSELLING will be permitted to attend Stray Round of ONLINE COUNSELLING.</p> <p><u>Not Eligible Candidates:</u></p> <p>a) The candidates who are holding PG (Medical) seat in Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3 (Mop Up) of State Counselling are not eligible to participate in Stray round of counselling.</p> <p>b) The candidate who is holding a seat allotted in Round 1 & Round 2 and Round 3 in All India Quota/Deemed universities (conducted by MCC/DGHS).</p> <p>c) The candidates who have been allotted in stray round of All India Quota/Deemed universities (conducted by MCC/DGHS) are not eligible to participate in State Stray Round of counselling.</p> <p>d) The candidates who have been allotted in stray round of Competent Authority Quota of the AP State are not eligible to participate in State MQ Stray Round of counselling.</p> <p>e) A candidate allotted a seat in Phase 3 (Mop up) of State counselling and not joined the seat cannot participate in further rounds of State Counselling.</p>
15	As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, A candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat. In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,00,000/-.
16	All the allotments will be subject to the final orders of pending writ petitions if any.
17	The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
