IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Any subsequent notification, amendment, corrigendum, clarification or instruction issued by the Government of Punjab, the National Medical Commission (NMC), the National Dental Commission (NDC), the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), or Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, shall be applicable and binding on all candidates and shall be implemented in letter and spirit. Candidates are advised to visit the University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in) regularly for the latest updates.
2. Candidates applying under the Sports Category must submit two printed copies of the online application form, along with the Sports Gradation Certificate issued by the Director, Sports, Punjab, and self-attested copies of all relevant supporting documents, in person (by hand) at the Admission Branch, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, within the prescribed schedule. The University shall forward these documents to the Director, Sports, Punjab, for the preparation of the Sports Merit List in accordance with the applicable Government policy/instructions, as provided under Clause 15(v) of the notification.
3. Every candidate must fulfil the eligibility conditions prescribed in the Punjab Government Notification governing admissions to the MBBS/BDS Courses, as amended from time to time.
4. Every candidate shall mandatorily upload all requisite documents, including the Birth Certificate, Class 10 Certificate (Date of Birth proof), Class 10+1 and Class 10+2 mark sheets/certificates (Medical Stream), Permanent Resident Certificate (where applicable), category certificate(s), and other prescribed documents by logging into his/her account on the University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in) within the stipulated schedule.
5. The provisional allotment of a seat through online counselling shall be subject to verification of original documents and determination of eligibility by the Principal of the respective allotted college. The Principal shall be solely responsible for ensuring that the candidate fulfills all eligibility conditions prescribed under the Punjab Government Notification, the Admission Prospectus, NMC/NDC Regulations, MCC Guidelines (where applicable), and other statutory instructions before confirming admission.
6. A candidate must have completed 17 years of age on or before 31 December 2026. Accordingly, only candidates born on or before 31 December 2009 shall be eligible for admission.
7. Candidates who are not eligible for admission against the Punjab State Quota seats in the MBBS course, as per the Punjab Government Notification, shall be considered for admission to the BDS course in the 3rd rounds of counselling only after exhausting all eligible Punjab State candidates, subject to the applicable admission policy.
8. Candidates claiming admission under any Reserved or Micro Reserved Category (except the Migrants from Jammu & Kashmir Category, wherever applicable) shall produce the relevant category certificate issued only by the competent authority of the Government of Punjab in the prescribed format.
9. Candidates claiming eligibility as Punjab Residents shall produce a Permanent Resident Certificate strictly in accordance with Clause 11 of the Punjab Government Notification, issued by the competent authority of Government of Punjab in the prescribed format.
10. All admissions to the MBBS and BDS courses shall be made strictly in accordance with the notifications, policies, guidelines and instructions issued by the Government of Punjab, the National Medical Commission (NMC), the National Dental Commission (NDC), the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), where applicable, and Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

11. Candidates are advised to visit the University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in) regularly for updates regarding the admission schedule, merit lists, counselling notices, seat matrix, provisional allotment, corrigenda and other important announcements. No individual communication shall be sent to any candidate.
12. Online counselling shall be conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot. Candidates shall be required to submit their online preferences (choices) of colleges, courses, quotas and categories, as applicable, within the prescribed schedule.
13. Candidates who are provisionally allotted seats shall report physically to the respective allotted colleges within the stipulated period for verification of original documents, determination of eligibility, completion of admission formalities and payment of the prescribed fee through the University Online Payment Gateway, failing which the allotted seat shall be cancelled in accordance with the applicable rules.
14. The schedule of counselling, admission process and all related dates are subject to revision by the Competent Authority. Any amendment, corrigendum or change shall be notified only through the University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in), which shall be binding on all candidates.



Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) / Persons with Disabilities (PwD) Category

Candidates seeking admission under the PwD/PwBD category shall be required to possess a valid UDID Card/Disability Certificate issued in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and the norms prescribed by the National Medical Commission (NMC), National Testing Agency (NTA) and Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), as applicable.

The candidate shall be required to undergo disability assessment/verification at the designated Disability Centres notified/authorized by the MCC/NMC, as applicable, for determination of eligibility under the PwD/PwBD category. The PwD/PwBD status shall be considered only on the basis of a valid disability certificate/UDID Card and the assessment/verification conducted in accordance with the applicable guidelines.

Candidates are advised to keep their UDID Card and disability-related documents updated and valid and shall produce the original documents at the time of counselling/admission for verification. No candidate shall be entitled to claim reservation or other benefits under the PwD/PwBD category unless the disability is duly certified and verified in accordance with the applicable rules/guidelines.

The detailed procedure, designated centres, schedule and other requirements for PwD/PwBD assessment/verification shall be as notified by the MCC/NMC/NTA or the competent authority from time to time.



PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION TO MBBS/BDS COURSES UNDER NRI QUOTA

(Government Medical/Dental Colleges, Private Medical/Dental Colleges, Private Universities and Minority Institutions affiliated to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot)

The admission of candidates under the Non-Resident Indian (NRI) Quota shall be governed by the provisions of the Punjab Government Notification No. MER-HTH305C/9/2024-5HB3/1/1443408/2026 dated 10.07.2026, as amended from time to time, and the regulations/instructions issued by the National Medical Commission (NMC), National Dental Commission (where applicable), National Testing Agency (NTA), and Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

1. ADMISSION POLICY

Admission to all Government Quota, Management Quota, NRI Quota, Minority Quota and any other seats in Government Medical/Dental Colleges, Private Medical/Dental Colleges, Private Universities and Minority Institutions shall be made strictly on the basis of merit in NEET (UG)-2026, in accordance with the Punjab Government Notification.

Seats earmarked for the NRI Quota shall be filled in the order of preference prescribed by the Punjab Government.

Category-I	NRIs/Children of NRIs who originally belong to the State of Punjab
Category-II	NRIs/Children of NRIs who originally belong to any State of India other than Punjab.

2. DEFINITION OF NON-RESIDENT INDIAN (NRI)

For the purpose of admission under the NRI Quota, an NRI means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or a Foreign Passport, who is permanently or temporarily settled outside India—

- ▶▶ for employment;
- ▶▶ for carrying on business or vocation; or
- ▶▶ for any other purpose indicating an intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period.

The NRI status shall be determined on the basis of documents such as:

- ▶▶ Passport
- ▶▶ Permanent Resident Card (PR Card)
- ▶▶ Green Card
- ▶▶ Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residence of Foreign Country issued by the Competent Authority or OCI/PIO Card Issued by The Government of India.
- ▶▶ OCI Card
- ▶▶ PIO Card
- ▶▶ Any other document recognized by the Government of India.

3. ELIGIBILITY

A candidate seeking admission under the NRI Quota must:

1. qualify NEET (UG)-2026;
2. fulfil the eligibility conditions prescribed by the National Medical Commission (NMC), the Punjab Government, and the University;
3. possess the prescribed educational qualifications for admission to MBBS/BDS courses;
4. obtain an Eligibility Certificate from Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot before participating in counselling wherever applicable.

4. PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from a foreign Board/University or who are otherwise required to obtain an Eligibility Certificate shall apply to the University in the prescribed application form available on the University website.

The completed application form, along with the prescribed fee and supporting documents, shall be submitted within the schedule notified by the University.

After verification of the documents, the University shall issue an Eligibility Certificate to eligible candidates only.

The original documents submitted for verification shall be returned after completion of verification.

5. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

The following self-attested documents shall be submitted along with the application form. Original documents shall be produced for verification.

A. Academic Documents

1. NEET (UG)-2026 Admit Card.
2. NEET (UG)-2026 Score Card.
3. Matriculation Certificate (Date of Birth proof).
4. Detailed Marks Certificate of Class XI (10+1), wherever applicable.
5. Detailed Marks Certificate of Class XII (10+2) or equivalent examination.
6. Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination.
7. Explanation of grading system, wherever applicable.
8. Character Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last attended.
9. Three recent passport-size colour photographs.

B. NRI Documents

1. Passport of the candidate/parent.
2. Proof of NRI Status, such as:
 - I. Passport
 - II. OCI Card
 - III. PIO Card
 - IV. Permanent Resident Card
 - V. Green Card
 - VI. NRI Certificate issued by the Indian Embassy
 - VII. Any other valid proof.
3. Proof of original domicile/ancestral background of Punjab or any other Indian State, as applicable.
4. Copy of Passbook/Statement of NRE Account.

C. Additional Documents (where applicable)

1. Accreditation Certificate of the School, if the candidate has passed the qualifying examination from an institution situated in the USA.
2. Equivalence Certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), if the qualifying examination has been passed from a foreign Board/University other than an Indian Board.
3. Provisional Student Visa issued by the Indian Mission abroad before admission.
4. Clearance Certificate from the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, wherever applicable.

6. PROCESSING FEE

The candidate shall deposit the prescribed fee as notified by the University for:

- Application Form for Admission (USD 1,000/- Plus Rs. 2,000/- i.e. Cost of Application Form) and
- Eligibility Certificate (USD 1,000/- Plus Rs. 1,000/- i.e. Cost of application form),

within the schedule specified in the Admission Prospectus. The fee once deposited shall be non-refundable and non-adjustable.

7. PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, the candidate shall:

1. submit the online Admission Application Form through the University website within the prescribed schedule;
2. participate in online counselling conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences;
3. exercise college and course preferences during counselling;
4. report to the allotted college with original documents and deposit the prescribed tuition fee within the stipulated period.

Admission shall be made **strictly on the basis of inter-se merit, category, availability of seats and the preferences exercised by the candidate**, subject to fulfilment of all eligibility conditions.

8. TUITION FEE

The tuition fee for candidates admitted under the NRI Quota shall be as notified by the Punjab Government from time to time.

Candidates opting to pay the tuition fee in instalments, wherever permitted by the Government, shall furnish the prescribed Bank Guarantee/Surety Bond for the balance amount.

The first instalment/full fee shall be deposited at the time of admission in the manner prescribed by the University.

9. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. The University shall issue the Eligibility Certificate only after verification of all required documents.
2. Statements of Result issued by schools/colleges or unauthenticated result notifications/result slips shall not be accepted.
3. Candidates passing the qualifying examination from foreign Boards/Universities shall submit an Equivalence Certificate issued by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), wherever applicable.
4. Candidates shall obtain the necessary Student Visa and any other statutory approvals required under the laws of India before joining the course.
5. All admissions shall remain provisional until verification of original documents and approval by the competent authority.
6. The University reserves the right to cancel the candidature/admission at any stage if any information or document submitted by the candidate is found to be false, fabricated or suppressed.

Candidates are advised to regularly visit the University website for updates regarding counselling schedules, seat matrix, notices and other admission-related information.

About Baba Farid University of Health Sciences

BRIEF HISTORY

The University was established at Faridkot under an Act of Punjab State Legislature (Punjab Act No. 18 of 1998) in the name of great Sufi Saint Sheikh Farid Ganj-E-Shakar, (1173 1265 A.D.) in 1998 for purposes of affiliating, teaching and ensuring proper and systematic instruction, training and research in Modern Systems of Medicine and Indian Systems of Medicine. It is not only affiliating and examining body but also a teaching and research centre in health sciences. It is expected to play a vital role in improving the standards of medical and health education in the state and in conducting relevant research in all aspects of health sciences, basic as well as applied, which ultimately will ameliorate the health standards of the people of Punjab. It is believed that the university will be a trend setter in developing appropriate modes and models of health care to ensure quality health care to the people.

The University has been recognized by MCI vide letter no. V/11015/3/2000-ME (UG) dated 9th June, 2000. The UGC has also included the University in the list of recognized universities maintained by the University Grants Commission, under section 2(1) of the UGC Act. 1956 vide letter no. F.9-3/97 (CPP-I) dated 4 July. 2002. The Regional Director. World Health Organization, Regional Office for South-East Asia, World Health House, New Delhi has also forwarded the name of the University for inclusion in the World Directory of Medical Schools vide letter No. M12/6212 dated 6 May 2002. The University is also included in the list of Commonwealth Universities and their yearbook 2001 at page No. 692 (Vol. I).

Established with a mission to create an intellectual, academic and physical environment conducive to free flow of ideas and exchange of information between various faculties of the university, between this university and other universities of health sciences in the country and abroad, thereby opening a window to the world for the health professionals, health planners, health managers, biomedical and social scientists and educationalists in health sciences of the country. Efforts are on to establish contact with various institutions towards achieving this goal.

UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:

New buildings of the University and its constituent college, GGS Medical College & Hospital were completed in the year 2011. The university was shifted to its new building situated at Sadiq Road, Faridkot in July 2011. Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab inaugurated two new University buildings (Senate Block and Academic Block) on 22-09-2011. Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister inaugurated the Radiotherapy Unit, and other buildings of GGS Medical College & Hospital, on 23-09-2011. The GGS Medical College & Hospital, a constituent college of the University is also shifted to its new building. The University Campus comprises of GGS Medical College along with Auditorium of 800 capacities, Senate Block, Academic Block, University College of Nursing, University College of Physiotherapy, University Institute of Para-Medical Sciences, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dept. of Nuclear Medicine, Telemedicine, Edusat and a well-equipped state-of-the-art 500 bedded hospitals, Drug De-addiction & Treatment Centre at Faridkot. The State Institute of Nursing and Para-Medical Sciences, Village – Badal (Muktsar), Institute of Nursing (University Regional Centre) at Shri Goindwal Sahib and Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Treatment & Research Centre and Drug De-Addiction & Treatment Centre at Bathinda, Mata Gujri State college of Nursing, Dhuri, Sangrur are also run by University. Coveted projects to set up Trauma Centre, Regional Cancer Centre are in process. The University has added to its academic convoy University Library & Informatics Division, Department of Health Sciences Library & Information System, University Centre of Excellence in Research, Rose Garden and Herbal Garden. The university has started number of employment-oriented diploma courses and certificate programs in health sciences and allied services.

At present the University is having 167 affiliated colleges (09 Medical, 14 Dental, 125 Nursing, 09 Physiotherapy, 1 Pharmacy, 1 Sports Medicine and 08 Allied and Healthcare Sciences) comprising 155 affiliated and 12 constituent Colleges.

University will soon endeavour to achieve excellence in health care delivery and medical education and research in the State. Admissions to various undergraduate and post graduate courses in the affiliated institutions of this University in the State of Punjab are made on merit basis through the conduct of Entrance Tests.

The university is now primarily focusing on strengthening postgraduate medical education and research and evolving as a centre of excellence in a rural backdrop.

Selection of the candidates to any institution shall be made on merit and in transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification/s.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION SYSTEM

The University had introduced Onscreen Marking Solution and w.e.f. session 2016 and e-transfer system of question papers of various courses to the examination centers to maintain the sanctity of examinations. This process and implementation strategies will help us to deliver, efficiency, reliability in high stakes examination and their certifications

1.1 Selection of the candidates to any institution shall be made on merit and in transparent manner as per Punjab Government Notification/s. NMC and MCC.

1.2 The admission to all the Institutions in the State of Punjab shall be done as per the notifications/ instructions/ guidelines/ rules/ executive orders passed by the State Government as per provisions of The Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Making of Reservation) Act 2006, from time to time.

2. Candidates shall carefully read this Prospectus and comply with all instructions contained herein. Failure to comply with the prescribed instructions or submission of incomplete/incorrect information may result in rejection of the candidature.
3. Candidates must ensure that mobile numbers and e-mail ID filled in the online Application Form are their own and/or of their Parents/Guardian only, as University will communicate through SMS or e-mail on the given mobile number and e-mail ID only.
4. Candidates shall ensure that the information entered by them in their online Application Form is correct. Request for change in any particulars in the online Application shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
5. Admissions to the MBBS/BDS Courses shall be governed by the Punjab Government Notification(s), applicable regulations of the National Medical Commission (NMC), the National Dental Commission (NDC), the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), where applicable, and the instructions issued by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, from time to time.
6. This Prospectus is subject to amendments, modifications, corrigenda or clarifications issued by the Government of Punjab, Government of India, NMC, NDC, MCC or the University. Such amendments shall be binding on all candidates and shall take effect immediately upon publication on the University website.

13. Admissions shall be made only against those colleges and courses which possess valid recognition/permission from the competent statutory authorities for the Academic Session 2026–27.
14. Provisional allotment of a seat shall be subject to the verification of original documents and confirmation of the candidate's eligibility by the Principal of the allotted Medical/Dental College. The Principal shall be solely responsible for ensuring that the candidate fulfils all prescribed eligibility conditions before confirming admission, in accordance with the Punjab Government Notification and this Prospectus.
15. The fee structure for Government, University Constituent and Private Medical/Dental Colleges shall be as notified by the Government of Punjab. Any subsequent revision notified by the Government shall automatically become applicable.

Merit and eligibility shall be determined strictly in accordance with the Punjab Government Notification(s), this Prospectus and the applicable statutory regulations.
3. Counselling and admissions shall be conducted by the Admission Committee constituted by the Government of Punjab or by such authority as may be notified from time to time.
4. The minimum age requirement/Eligibility criteria/qualifications/qualifying criteria for admission shall be as prescribed in the NEET-UG 2026 Information Bulletin issued by NTA (National Testing Agency), the applicable NMC Regulations and the Punjab Government Notification(s).

ONLINE REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION OF ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM

1. Before applying online, candidates shall carefully read the Punjab Government Notification, this Prospectus and all instructions available on the University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in).
2. Only candidates who have qualified NEET-UG-2026 shall be eligible to apply for admission to the MBBS/BDS Courses.
3. Candidates shall register online and submit the Admission Application Form through the University website within the prescribed schedule.
4. Candidates are advised to complete the online application well before the last date to avoid network congestion or technical issues. The University shall not be responsible for any delay due to internet or server-related problems. No application shall be accepted after the prescribed closing date and time.
5. The following documents shall be uploaded during online registration:
 - i. Recent passport-size colour photograph.
 - ii. Candidate's signature.
 - iii. Birth Certificate/Class X Certificate (Date of Birth proof).

1. CATEGORY SELECTION

Candidates shall carefully select and fill the appropriate Category Code(s) in the Online Admission Application Form. The category claimed by a candidate shall be based on his/her eligibility and the supporting documents prescribed under the applicable Government of Punjab notifications. The category selected at the time of filing cannot be changed under any circumstances.

A candidate may claim one or more category codes, wherever applicable, in accordance with the provisions of this Prospectus. The Category Code(s) are intended solely to facilitate the preparation of category-wise merit lists and counselling.

The mere selection or claim of a reserved category in the Online Admission Application Form shall not confer any automatic right or entitlement to reservation or admission against a reserved seat. The claim for reservation shall be considered only if the candidate satisfies the prescribed eligibility conditions and produces valid supporting documents issued by the competent authority, in accordance with the applicable Government of Punjab notifications, University regulations, and the decisions of the Selection/Admission Committee constituted for this purpose.

shall be considered under the Open (General) Merit Category, provided they are otherwise eligible.

1. Only registered candidates who have successfully submitted the application and deposited the prescribed fee shall be eligible to participate in online counselling.
2. Candidates shall submit their preferences of Course, College, Quota and Category through the online counselling portal.
3. Candidates are advised to exercise maximum possible preferences in the order of their actual choice.
4. Candidates belonging to reserved categories who secure merit equivalent to Open Merit shall be considered first against Open Merit seats, in accordance with the applicable reservation policy and as per Clause 7 of the Notification

STEP - VII

PROVISIONAL SEAT ALLOTMENT

1. Seats shall be allotted provisionally strictly on the basis of:
 - i. NEET-UG-2026 Merit;
 - ii. Eligibility;
 - iii. Applicable Reservation Policy;

- iv. Availability of Seats; and
- v. Preferences exercised by the candidate.
- 2. The provisional allotment shall be subject to verification of original documents and confirmation of eligibility by the Principal of the allotted Medical/Dental College.
- 3. After provisional allotment, candidates shall download the Provisional Allotment Letter from their login and report to the allotted college within the prescribed schedule.
- 4. Failure to report, verify documents or complete admission formalities within the prescribed period shall result in automatic cancellation of the allotted seat.
- 5. Candidates whose seats are upgraded in subsequent rounds shall not be required to deposit tuition fee again, except the difference in fee, if any.
- 6. Candidates desirous of participating in subsequent rounds for upgradation shall comply with the instructions and deposit the prescribed Security/Willingness Fee, wherever applicable.
- 7. Candidates wishing to surrender the allotted seat shall do so within the period prescribed by the Punjab Government/University/NMC/MCC Regulations. Refund/forfeiture of fee shall be governed by the applicable Punjab Government/NMC/MCC Regulations.
- 8. During subsequent rounds of counselling, candidates are advised to fill maximum preferences, irrespective of the displayed vacancy position, since vacancies may arise due to upgradation, resignation or conversion of seats during the counselling process.

STEP - VIII

REPORTING AT THE ALLOTTED COLLEGE

- 1. Provisionally allotted candidates shall report personally to the allotted Medical/Dental College along with all original documents within the prescribed schedule.
- 2. The Principal of the concerned college shall verify the original documents and determine the eligibility of the candidate strictly in accordance with the Punjab Government Notification, NMC Regulations, MCC Guidelines and this Prospectus.
- 3. Only after successful verification of eligibility shall the candidate be permitted to complete admission formalities, undergo medical examination (where applicable) and submit the joining report.
- 4. Admission shall be treated as confirmed only after completion of all admission formalities and approval by the concerned college.

Candidates are advised to visit the University website (www.bfuhs.ac.in) regularly for notifications, corrigenda, counselling schedules, merit lists, seat matrix and other admission-related updates.

1. The Government of Punjab is pleased to notify the admission criteria to Undergraduate Degree courses of MBBS and BDS for the year 2026 onwards in the Government & Private Medical/Dental Institutes, including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions in the State of Punjab.
2. All admissions of Govt. Quota seats/Management Quota Seats, including NRI and any Minority Quota seats, and any other Seats, whatsoever, in the Government & Private Medical/Dental Institutes, including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions shall be based on the merit of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET).
3. The Government of Punjab is pleased to authorize Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot (BFUHS) to conduct centralized counselling for admissions, for seats as spelled out at Sr. No. 2, on the basis of marks obtained in NEET.
4. Eligibility criteria for admission in Government & Private Medical/Dental Institutes, including Institutes under Private Universities and Minority Institutions for MBBS and BDS seats, as spelled out at Sr. No. 2 shall be in accordance with eligibility criteria/ qualifications/qualifying criteria as prescribed in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility-cum- Entrance Test (NEET) issued by NTA (National Testing Agency) for the corresponding year.
5. After the declaration of the NEET result, the candidates shall apply on the specific proforma for all seats, except All India quota seats, to Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, (BFUHS), Faridkot. Admission shall be made by the Admission Committee through a Centralized Counselling by BFUHS, Faridkot on the basis of inter-se merit of NEET.
6. Admissions to Private institutions/Universities shall also be governed by the provisions of Para 2 above and also as per the provisions of the "Punjab Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee & Making of Reservations) Act, 2006."and its Amendment Act 2020.
7. A candidate from reserved Category shall have the right to compete for admission in General/Unreserved category seats as per his/her merit on the day of

counselling and candidate so selected shall not be counted towards admission in the reserve category.

8. The schedule of counselling, admission and start of classes shall be in conformity with the schedule laid down by National Medical Commission/Dental Council of India/ Hon'ble Supreme Court of India / State Government. Fee and other charges for submission of the application and counselling shall be notified by BFUHS as per Government approval.

9. Out of the total seats in Government Institutes, 15% seats (All India Quota) in MBBS/BDS courses shall be filled by the Government of India through centralized Counselling by Medical Counselling Committee of DGHS, MOHFW, Govt. of India on the basis of marks obtained in NEET. Rest 85% seats shall be filled as per merit of NEET by the Admission Committee constituted by the Government of Punjab.

10. The details of the institutions and category wise seats shall be available on the official website of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot i.e. www.bfuhs.ac.in.

11. The eligibility of the candidate for state quota is as under :

- a) The candidate should be Citizen of India.
- b) The candidate must have passed 10+1 & 10+2 from the state of Punjab or
- c) The candidate should have born in the state of Punjab or
- d) The candidate must be permanent resident of the state of Punjab

Note :-Permanent resident of State of Punjab means: -

- i) Candidates who have studied for a period of 5 years in Punjab or have studied in Punjab for 2 years just preceding the qualifying examination for the admission.
or

ii) Children wards of

- a) The employees of Punjab Govt. posted in or outside Punjab State or working on deputation having atleast 3 years of service.or
- b) The employee of Govt. of India posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. or
- c) The employees of State Govt. institutions/undertakings who are posted in Chandigarh or in Punjab in connection with the affairs of the Punjab Govt. for a period of 3 years. or
- d) The employees having atleast 3 years of service in autonomous bodies/companies in which Punjab Govt. has 20% or more shares. or
- e) The residents who are residing outside Punjab on account of the service of their parents/guardians either with the Government of India or with the Government of Punjab shall be eligible for issuance of a Residence Certificate, provided that the permanent address of such employees falls within the reorganized State of Punjab as on or after 01.11.1966, as recorded in their service books. However, this

provision shall apply only to employees holding regular posts under the Government of India or the Government of Punjab and shall not extend to employees of Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs), statutory corporations, autonomous bodies, public sector banks, insurance corporations, including the Life Insurance Corporation of India, or other Government-owned companies.or

f) The employees borne on the establishment of Punjab and the Haryana High Court discharging duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Punjab having atleast three years of service who have not availed this facility from their parent State and State of Haryana and U.T; Chandigarh. or

iii) Children/wards of the pensioners of Punjab Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Punjab or he has settled after retirement in or outside Punjab.or

iv) Children/wards of persons who have settled in Punjab or had resided in Punjab for a period of atleast 5 years at any time prior to the date of submission of the application either in pursuit of a profession or holding of a job.

In addition the following categories of candidates are also eligible for admission in MBBS and BDS courses in medical and dental institutes in Punjab:-

- a) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.
- b) Candidates seeking admissions under NRI category.
- c) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
- d) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/ Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding year of passing 10+2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependents have passed class XI and/or XII or equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.

Not eligible under Defence Category as wards/children will get benefit of Defence category from their respective states of origin as per point no 3 of letter no 11(8)1W/2018/2305 dated 01.08.2018 issued by Directorate of Defence Services Welfare Punjab, Chandigarh

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Provided however, that in case adequate number of candidates is not available for BDS course, then candidates who are not eligible for state quota may be considered.

(ii) Christian Medical College (CMC), Ludhiana and Christian Dental College (CDC), Ludhiana are also minority institutions and the Hon'ble Supreme Court has. Vide its Orders dated 09-08-2004 and 02.12.2010 in Writ Petition(Civil) No. 357 of 2004, allowed the CMC and CDC, Ludhiana to follow their own admission policy as was being followed by them for the last 25 years. Accordingly, "Christian Medical College (CMC), Ludhiana and Christian Dental College (CDC), Ludhiana are allowed to charge Rs.6.60 lakh per annum for admission to MBBS course and Rs. 2.20 lakh per annum for admission to BDS course from both the 'Open Quota' and 'Minority Quota' Students with 10% increase in fees every year.

NOTE:

- i) Tuition fee for the six months shall be paid to Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- ii) If candidate is shifted from one College to another in the subsequent Counselling, the fee shall be refunded / adjusted after completion of the admission process. The University shall refund / adjust the fee within 30 days.
- iii) The fee shall be payable on six monthly basis and the institutes shall not insist the candidate to deposit fee of the entire course in advance.
- iv) Hostel fee and security advance (Annual and provisional) for private institutes. (As per Notification No. 7/107*2012-5HB3/209 dated 11.02.2015) with 5% increase for each subsequent year.
 - a. Non Air Conditioned Independent Room: Rs.16,500/- per year for the First year (Maximum) for single bedroom. This fee may be hiked by maximum up to 5% for each subsequent year.

Credit and admission under the Sports Category shall be made on the basis of inter-se merit of the candidates determined on the basis of Sports Gradation (Category A/B/C) in accordance with the Punjab Sports Policy notified by the Department of Sports & Youth Services, Government of Punjab vide policy dated 31.07.2023, as well as the Punjab State Policy on Reservation for Sportspersons notified vide Government of Punjab, Department of Sports & Youth Services Notification No. 03/18/2018-3SS/25 dated 09.03.2026.

Further, in terms of Rule 4.2 of the aforesaid policy, sports achievements at both Junior and Senior levels shall be considered/evaluated for the purpose of admission under the Sports Category. (x) EWS:- As per corrigendum No.5/2/2019-5HB-III-4321 dated 10-07-2019 issued by Govt. of Punjab, Department of Medical Education & Research, Punjab. In continuation Notification no. 3577 dated 06.06.2019 is reproduced as under :-

"The medical Council of India(MCI), New Delhi vide letter dated 21-06-2019 and U.O. dated 30-06-2019 has now increased the number of seats from 200 to 225 in Government Medical College, Patiala, GMC Amritsar from 200 to 250 and GGSMC, Faridkot 100 to 125 and accordingly, 10% seats are to be earmarked for "Economically Weaker Section(EWS)" category.

In pursuance to aforesaid decision of MCI, New Delhi, the following guidelines are issued in continuation to the notification dated 6th June 2019 under reference :-

1. The total number of seats would be 250 seats in Government

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Medical College, Amritsar, 225 seats in Government Medical College, Patiala and 125 seats in GGSMC, Faridkot from the session 2019-20 onwards and 10% of the original seats each would be reserved for EWS category in these three Medical Colleges.

2. Remaining seats in these three Medical colleges would be filled up as provided in the notification dated 6th June 2019 under reference.
3. The issuance of the certificate of EWS category shall be as per letter No.1/16/2019-RC1/116 dated 14-05-2019 followed by letter no. 1/3/2019-RC1/120 dated 28-05-2019 issued by the department of Social justice Empowerment and Minorities (Reservation Cell) Government of Punjab.

The Vice Chancellor, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences (BFHUS), Faridkot and the other members of the Admission committee may admit students belonging to EWS category based on the certificate issued as per instructions dated 14-05-2019 and 28-05-2019 of the Department of Social Justice, Empowerment and Minorities (reservation cell), Government of Punjab.

- (x-b) The Dental Council of India(DCI), New Delhi vide letter dated 30-04-2019 & 19-07-2021 has now increased the number of seats from 40 to 50 in Government Dental Colleges, Amritsar & Patiala. Accordingly 10% seats are to be earmarked for "Economically Weaker Section (EWS)" category. From the session 2021-22 onwards and 10% of the original seats each would be reserved for EWS category in Government Dental Colleges, Amritsar & Patiala.

The issuance of the certificate of EWS category shall be as per letter No.1/16/2019-RC1/116 dated 14-05-2019 followed by letter no. 1/3/2019-RC1/120 dated 28-05-2019 issued by the department of Social justice Empowerment and Minorities (Reservation Cell) Government of Punjab.

The Vice Chancellor, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences (BFHUS), Faridkot and the other members of the Admission committee may admit students belonging to EWS category based on the certificate issued as per instructions dated 14-05-2019 and 28-05-2019 of the Department of Social Justice, Empowerment and Minorities (reservation cell), Government of Punjab.

16. Admission to Private Institutes/Universities

- a. A candidate seeking admission under this category shall submit a valid certificate issued by the Relief and Rehabilitation Commissioner (Migrants), Jammu, certifying that the candidate belongs to a family of Jammu & Kashmir Migrants displaced due to terrorist violence.
- b. In terms of the instructions issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, vide letter no. 3-4/2017-NER dated 15.10.2019, the concession of waiver of domicile requirement shall be available to eligible Jammu & Kashmir Migrants. The provisions relating to relaxation in minimum eligibility criteria/cut-off percentile, enhancement of reservation quota, or reservation of additional seats shall not be applicable unless specifically provided under the applicable regulations, Government policy, or admission notification.

17. Non-Resident Indian (NRI) Seats:

- 15% of seats in all Private Institutes, Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot, and Dr. B.R. Ambedkar State Institute of Medical Sciences (AIMS), Mohali.
- 13 seats each in Government Medical College, Patiala and Amritsar.
- 3 seats in Government Dental College, Amritsar.
- 4 seats in Government Dental College, Patiala.
- These seats shall be earmarked for the Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) in following order:
 - Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the State of Punjab.
 - Category II: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

(i) Under this policy Non Resident Indian means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

- a. For or on taking up employment outside India; or
- b. For carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
- c. For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside india for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India shall be taken into consideration.

- (ii) The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.
- (iii) The fee notified for NRI category shall be applicable to NRI candidates getting admission to Govt. Medical/Dental Colleges also.
- (iv) The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments as provided.
- (v) The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before

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the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, during / after 2nd Centralized Counselling of NRI quota in State Colleges, it shall go to General category and in the Private Colleges/Minority colleges shall go to General Category of the Management/ Minority quota. The NRI left over seats shall be filled by the same Admission Committee from amongst the eligible candidates of NEET.

- (vi) OCI/PIO candidates shall be considered only for 15% NRI Quota seats.

18. Declaration submitted by the candidate

The Candidate and his/her Parent/Guardian shall submit a duly sworn affidavit/declaration affirming that:

- I. The candidate has claimed eligibility and sought consideration for admission under the State Quota of Punjab only and has not claimed, sought, or availed the benefit of State Quota eligibility in any other State/Union Territory for admission to MBBS/BDS courses for the same academic session.
- II. The candidate has not submitted any application, affidavit, undertaking, declaration, or any other document claiming domicile, residence, bonafide resident status, or any similar eligibility for the purpose of seeking admission under the State Quota seats of any other State/Union Territory.
- III. In the event it is found at any stage that the candidate has sought, claimed, or availed the benefit of State Quota admission in any other State/Union Territory, or that any information furnished in the declaration is false, incorrect, or misleading, the candidature/admission of the candidate shall be liable to be cancelled forthwith, in addition to any other action permissible under law, rules, regulations, or the admission prospectus.
- IV. The candidate and the Parent/Guardian further undertake to indemnify the Government of Punjab, the Department of Medical Education and Research, Punjab, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, and the concerned institution against any consequences arising from any false declaration or suppression of material facts.

19. Candidates already admitted:-

A candidate who has already been admitted to an MBBS/BDS course in any Medical/Dental Institution in India during a previous academic session shall be eligible to participate in the admission process afresh for the same course on the basis of the NEET score obtained in the year of admission under consideration, subject to the following conditions:

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- a) The candidate shall obtain and submit a valid No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Chairman, Admission Committee (as notified herein) and Relieving Certificate from the institution concerned, wherever applicable, and such other documents as may be prescribed by the Admission Committee/University.
- b) The candidate shall be required to comply with all provisions of the applicable regulations, counselling guidelines, bond conditions, fee regulations, and instructions issued by the Government of Punjab, the Admission Committee, the University, the National Medical Commission, the Dental Council of India, or any other competent authority.
- c) Where a candidate resigns, withdraws, or leaves the MBBS/BDS course after joining and before completion of two years of the course, such candidate shall be liable to pay the entire course fee and any other dues, penalties, bond amount, or financial liabilities as prescribed under the applicable Government notifications, prospectus, regulations, or institutional rules in force at the relevant time.
- d) Admission granted to such candidate shall remain subject to verification of eligibility and fulfillment of all conditions prescribed under the applicable admission notification, prospectus, and statutory regulations.

20. Service Bond

- a) A Service Bond of Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Only) shall be applicable only to candidates admitted to the MBBS course in Government Medical Colleges/Institutions of Punjab, whether under the State Quota or the All India Quota.
- b) Every such candidate shall execute a Service Bond in the prescribed format and furnish such sureties/guarantees as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time, undertaking to comply with all terms and conditions of the bond.
- c) The mandatory service obligation under the bond shall be:
 - a. Two (02) years for candidates admitted under the State Quota; and
 - b. One (01) year for candidates admitted under the All India Quota.
- d) The bonded service shall be rendered in such Government Medical Colleges, Government Hospitals, Health Institutions, or other healthcare establishments under the Government of Punjab as may be specified by the Government from time to time.
- e) The Government shall have the authority to determine the place of posting, nature of duties, and other conditions governing the bonded service in accordance with applicable policies and administrative requirements.
- f) The Government may, in public interest, including but not limited to public health emergencies, epidemics, disasters, shortage of medical

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manpower, or other administrative exigencies, extend the period of bonded service for such duration and on such terms as may be notified by the Government in accordance with law and applicable policy.

- g) Any candidate who fails to join, complete, or otherwise comply with the terms and conditions of the Service Bond shall be liable to pay the bond amount of Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakhs Only), in addition to any other consequences, recoveries, penalties, or actions permissible under the bond, the admission prospectus, Government policy, or applicable law.
- h) The Service Bond shall be governed by the terms of the bond deed executed by the candidate and the policies, instructions, and notifications issued by the Government of Punjab from time to time. The candidate shall be bound by any amendments thereto that are made in accordance with law.

21. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a) The University shall display combined merit list of all candidates including reserve category and also a separate merit list of different categories which should be displayed on the University website at least 7 days before the counseling.
- b) The admission shall be made to only those institutes which are approved from all the concerned authorities on or before the first counselling. Institute(s) which has applied for affiliation and/or for approval of competent authority(ies) but are unable to get affiliation and such approval from all the concerned authorities before this day shall not be considered for counselling.
- c) In order to ensure completion of the prescribed courses(s) and period of study as well as commencement of examination(s) in time, no admission(s) adjustment(s) shall be made after date as notified by the National Medical Commission, New Delhi of the corresponding year regardless of any vacancy(ies) that might exist or might arise thereafter for any reason.
- d) The seats of All India quota remaining unfilled, if surrendered by the Director General of Health Services (Medical Counselling Committee, New Delhi), to the Punjab Government, shall be filled as per NEET merit and existing reservation rules.
- e) In case of candidates whose parents are not alive, the dependency certificate shall have to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner / District Collector of the District or any other Government official duly authorized by the State Government or Deputy Commissioner / District Collector where the candidate resides.
- f) The reservation for SC shall be calculated on total seats of an

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institution after deduction of All India Quota seats.

- g) Students claiming benefits of reservation under SC/BC category shall be required to produce a certificate from the competent authority as per latest instructions of Govt. of Punjab. Further, a valid Backward Class Certificate must be produced as per the latest instructions of Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab in which the annual income of the family is clearly mentioned.
- h) Scheduled Caste/ Backward Classes category candidates shall be eligible to apply for Post- Matric Scholarship and reimbursement of fee if they fulfill the terms and conditions laid down by Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab.
- i) The Reservation of Physically Challenged persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act 2016.
Aspirants for the UG in State of Punjab are required to approach any of the designated centre (as per list available on Medical Counseling Committee website mcc.nic.in) approved by the Govt. of India for issuing of disability certificate for the 21 benchmark described under RPWD Act 2016. Candidates shall bring the valid certificate in the prescribed format from any of the designated centre on the day of counselling. No separate medical board will be constituted for the admission under this category and no other disability certificate in this regard shall be entertained.
- j) Guidelines of MCC shall be followed and referred to, from time to time in the process of counseling.
- k) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve / minority category shall be transferred to the General Category as per instructions of Information Bulletin / Corrigendum / Guidelines / Notice issued by MCC, New Delhi from time to time.
- l) For students admitted through online counselling, fee shall be deposited as prescribed by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot after verification of documents at College level. For students admitted through physical counselling, fee shall be deposited through Bank Demand Draft only.
- m) The candidate will upload 10+1 and 10+2 certificate in the BFUHS Portal

22. The State Government reserves the right to amend any clause and procedure for admission

23. In case of any doubt, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education & Research, Government of Punjab may issue clarification which will have force of the policy.

24. For any dispute arising out of this notification or of the admissions under this

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notification, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education & Research, Government of Punjab shall be competent to resolve whose decisions shall be final.

25. This notification supersedes all the notifications for admission to MBBS/BDS courses in the State, issued earlier.

"It is, however, clarified that the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe person on migration from the State of his origin to another State will not lose his status as Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe but he will be entitled to the concessions/benefits admissible to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes from the state of his origin and not from the State where he has migrated."
