Consequent upon the declaration of the NEET UG- 2026 by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on 16th of July, 2026 and subsequently notified by the Board vide Notification No. 127-BOPEE of 2026 dated: 30-07-2026 read with Notification No. 132-BOPEE of 2026 dated 04-08-2026 and Notification No. 135-BOPEE of 2026 Dated: 05-08-2026, the candidates belonging to the UT of J&K / Ladakh who have qualified the NEET-UG 2026 having scored the cut-off marks prescribed by the NTA and whose names figure in **Annexure-A** of the above referred notifications and also the candidates whose names were not available in the said annexure but are the domiciles of J&K/ Ladakh and have submitted their documents in response to the aforementioned notification under reference forming **Annexure-A** to this Notification are hereby informed through the medium of this Notification to register themselves and upload the following documents online w.e.f **07-08-2026 (02:00 p.m. onwards) to 10-08-2026 (mid-night)** so that Provisional UT Merit List (PUTML) of such eligible candidates belonging to UT of J&K/ Ladakh is prepared.

1. NEET-UG score card - 2026.
 2. 10+2 Marks Card.
 3. Domicile Certificate of UT of J&K / Ladakh (ST Category certificate in respect of candidates belonging to the UT of Ladakh).
 4. *Category Certificate, wherever required.
 5. Date of Birth Certificate (Matriculation).
 6. The candidates belonging to the UT of Ladakh are required to upload Compulsory Service Bond (which is available in the e-Information Brochure of NEET UG-2026 on the official website (www.jkbopee.gov.in)).
- * OBC, EWS & Poor and Backward (P&B) category certificates shall be as per the performa prescribed for UT of J&K.

For Candidates opting for Hindu Minority (HM) and NRI seats in ASCOMS, the following documents need to be uploaded:

i) For Hindu Minority (HM):

Candidates opting for Hindu Minority Seats have to upload the Hindu Minority Certificate issued by Competent Authority along with all the relevant documents mentioned above.

ii) For Non-Resident Indians (NRI):

Candidates opting for NRI seats in ASCOMS shall upload the documents as per their eligibility conditions mentioned in **Annexure-B** to this Notification as prescribed by MCC alongwith the relevant documents mentioned above.

The cut off score for different categories is as under:

a. Open Merit (including JKPM/CDP/Sports/EWS):	213
b. Open Merit/PwD and EWS/PwD:	194
c.SC/ST-i/ST-ii/OBC/ALC/IB/RBA:	177
d. SC/ST-i/ST-ii/OBC/RBA/ALC/IB & PwD/ JKPM/Sports/CDP:	177

NOTE:

1. The candidates are advised not to use Mobile Phones for Registration purposes / uploading of documents.
2. The candidates are advised to go through the e-Information Brochure for NEET UG-2026 before registration which is available on official website of the Board (www.jk.gov.in).
3. **No under process certificates shall be entertained.**
4. **The cut-off date for validity of the category certificates shall be the last date for Registration fixed by the BOPEE, viz, 10-08-2026;.**
5. The candidate must fulfill all other criteria as laid down in the NEET-UG 2026 Information Brochure of NTA and Information Brochure of J&K BOPEE in respect of NEET UG- 2026 courses.
6. Any candidate found ineligible at any point of time shall not be allowed to participate in the counseling process notwithstanding the registration/NEET qualifying score.
7. The candidates should enter their valid e-mail address/mobile numbers as all important communications shall be made with them on such e-mails/mobile numbers provided by them, whenever required by the Board.
8. **Candidates, in their own interest, are advised not to share their e-mail password with other candidates/persons.**
9. Board shall not be responsible for any mistake committed by the candidates, while making the registration.
10. After completion of the registration process, Board shall notify the Provisional UT Merit List (PUTML) of all the candidates, which shall be used for online counseling by the candidates (filling up of the preferences) based on which allotment of seat shall be made.
11. Any candidate, who falls within the qualifying merit but does not register himself/herself or does not upload the documents or the documents uploaded are deficient shall not be considered for allotment of any seat.
12. The candidates, in their own interest, are advised to go through the e-Information Brochure uploaded by the Board on its website viz. www.jkbopee.gov.in and go through the technical and other instructions before registering themselves.
13. Since the admission in the Professional Colleges is time bound, the candidates should not wait for last date of registration as it may be detrimental to the interest of the candidates(s).
14. The candidates, who intend to participate against NRI/HM Quota seats in ASCOMS, Jammu shall also have to register themselves online and upload all the

relevant documents in pursuance to this notification otherwise they are not eligible for counselling under NRI/HM quota.

15. Candidates are advised to remain in touch with the BOPEE website www.jkbopee.gov.in and should not wait for publication of Notices/Notifications in the News Papers, which may get delayed for the reason beyond the control of the BOPEE.
16. Mere Registration of candidates shall not confer any right on all such candidates for admission, but shall be subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria and the qualification prescribed for the said course(s) after verification of their documents at the time of admission in the College/ Institution of provisionally selected candidates.

ANNEXURE - B

CHAPTER 3: NRI Candidates

In 2017, Hon'ble Supreme court in Dar-Us Salam case directed DGHS, MoHFW, Govt of India to conduct 100 % seats Counselling for All Deemed Universities under UGC as per their existing reservation policy including NRI candidates, Muslim minority and Jain Minority.

MCC is successfully conducting the counselling for Deemed Universities till date for 100% seats of Deemed Universities, out of which 15% seats are allocated to NRI candidates as per directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P.(C) No.689 of 2017 in the matter of Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka & Anr. v/s Union of India & Ors.

Further, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **W.P No. 13393 of 2007 and others (2008) (Anshul Tomar vs. State of M.P)** has set forth certain eligibility criteria for seats reserved under NRI quota.

The principles laid down in Anshul Tomar vs. State of M.P. and others (2008) are as follows:

- 1) *"If the mother or father of student is NRI and residing abroad ordinarily, then, either of the situations so held will be considered to be proper.*
- 2) *If the first-degree relation of the student is NRI and residing abroad ordinarily, then in such circumstances also, qua this year, should be considered eligible. It is natural that such definition would include the real brother and sister over and above the mother-father of the first-degree relation.*
- 3) *As per the definition revised by the Hon'ble Apex Court, interpretation of clause 3 thereof as not made limited but if made in a broad perspective, then, it is clear that the person who wanted to consider such student as ward (Palya), then, he be considered to be proper subject to compliance of the following conditions:*
 - a) *He should be the nearest relation.*
 - b) *In the definition of the nearest relation, committee has considered following relative having blood relations.*
 - *Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.*
 - *Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.*
 - *Father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother.*
 - *Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.*

- *First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.*
- *Such person should be NRI.*
- b) *Such persons should ordinarily be residing abroad.*
- c) *Such person should have looked after such student as the guardian of the student and evidence to that effect must have been produced before the committee by such person.*
- d) *There should be affidavit with aforesaid fact."*

MCC will seek evidential proof; a legal document from the candidates/guardian as in point 3 (d) & (e) of the order, during counselling, demonstrating that the sponsor is actually Bonafide legal guardian of the candidate. Hence, the candidates applying for NRI Quota seats have to comply with the above-mentioned eligibility criteria for change of their category from Indian to NRI

The updated list of mandatory documents for different categories of NRI candidates/ Foreign National

Category I: NRI Candidate/ Parents/ Real Brother/ Real Sister

1. Date of Birth Certificate
2. 10th mark sheets and passing certificate
3. 12th mark sheets and passing certificates
4. NEET- UG Score Card issued by NTA
5. Valid Passport of candidate
6. NRI Certificate issued by the Competent Authority (Embassy / Indian Consulate)
7. Affidavit (Notarized) by the NRI parent/ Real Brother/ Real Sister stating that they will sponsor the entire course fee and living expenses of the candidate (son/daughter) during the period of study supported by NRE Bank Account Passbook.
8. Relationship to be verified by competent revenue authority officer (Tehsildar/ Government Officer). In cases of first degree relative as per point 1 and 2 laid in the principles laid in Anshul Tomar vs. State of M.P W.P No. 13393 of 2007.

Category II: Indian to NRI (Candidates who filled their category as Indian category in NEET UG form and now want to get converted to NRI category for counselling.

1. Date of Birth Certificate
2. 10th mark sheets and passing certificate
3. 12th mark sheets and passing certificates
4. NEET- UG Score Card issued by NTA
5. Valid Passport of candidate
6. Valid Passport of legal guardian
7. NRI Certificate of the guardian issued by the Competent Authority (Embassy / Indian Consulate)
8. In case of sponsorship by a legal guardian:

Evidence of Bonafide Guardianship stating relationship between the NRI legal guardian and the candidate. The legal guardian (sponsor) must have acted as the guardian of the candidate and must submit valid legal documentary proof establishing that he/she is the legally recognized guardian of the candidate in accordance with the provisions of the Guardian and Wards Act 1890.

9. An affidavit (notarized) by the legal guardian that he/she will sponsor the entire course fee and living expenses of the candidate during the period of study duly supported by NRE (Non-Resident External) Bank Account Pass Book.
