NOTIFICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION INTO MBBS AND BDS COURSES UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA (B & C/NRI CATEGORIES) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27 INTO PRIVATE UN-AIDED NON-MINORITY & MINORITY MEDICAL AND DENTAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO KNRUHS, TELANGANA AND NEELIMA INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES (AFFILIATED TO ANURAG UNIVERSITY).

Online applications are invited from Indian Citizens, NRIs and others (PIO, OCI card holders) who have qualified by securing the cutoff scores or above in UG National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) 2026 for admission into the Under Graduate Medical and Dental Courses for the academic year 2026-27 under Management Quota i.e. B Category & C Category (NRI Quota) into Private Un-aided Non-Minority & Minority Medical Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS, Telangana, Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences (affiliated to Anurag University), Private Un-aided Dental Colleges and Army College of Dental Sciences, affiliated to KNRUHS, Warangal in the State of Telangana.

This notification is issued for online registration for web-based counselling to determine State Merit position for admission into Management Quota seats only. Total number of seats available under Management Quota for the academic year 2026-27 will be notified on KNRUHS website before exercising web options for counselling.

The tuition fee for the academic year 2026–27 is as per G.O.Ms.No. 98, Health, Medical & Family Welfare (C1) Dept., Dated: 07.08.2026.

CUT-OFF SCORE IN NEET UG 2026

Candidates should have secured the following cut-off score or above in NEET UG 2026 Examination.

NOTE: LOWER PERCENTILE OF MARKS FOR SC/ST/BC Categories/PWD IS ONLY FOR ELIGIBILITY

Schedule for registration through online and uploading of all relevant certificates:

Candidates can register online and upload scanned original certificates on the website <https://tspvtmedadm.tsche.in> from **06.00 AM** on **13.08.2026** up to **06.00 PM** on **20.08.2026**.

Provisional Merit position of the registered candidates will be prepared based on the NEET UG 2026 rank and other eligibility criteria notified here under after verification of scanned original certificates. Final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission at allotted college by the admission committee of the college.

ELIGIBILITY:

The candidates, who have qualified in NEET UG 2026 by securing cut-off marks or above have to apply for determining the State Merit position for Management Quota seats subject to the conditions specified in admission Regulations/Prospectus for the AY 2026-27.

A candidate for admission into Under graduate courses under Competent Authority Quota in Telangana should be Indian Nationals, Person of Indian Origin (PIO) or Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card holders (PIO/OCI status issued before 04-03-2021) and shall fulfil the following provisions in G.O.Ms.No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Date: 19.07.2024 and G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Date: 08.09.2025. **(G.O. 33 & 150 is applicable to 85% of seats under Management Quota – B category)**

- (i) If the candidate has studied in an Educational Institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

- (ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he has not studied in Educational Institutions, if he has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination which he appeared or as the case may be first appeared.
- (iii) Local area herein means the State of Telangana. Further, in case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution and has resided in the local area as stated at (ii) above, to be eligible for admission into Under graduate courses under Competent Authority Quota, the candidate should have appeared for the relevant qualifying examination in the State of Telangana.

- I. Provided that a candidate who studies outside Telangana for any period during the requisite four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination, will be eligible to be considered if they fall under any of the below categories:
 1. Children of employees of the Telangana State Government who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 2. Children of serving or retired officers belonging to the Telangana cadre of All India Services (IAS/IFS/IPS) who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 3. Children of defence personnel/ex-servicemen/Central Armed Police Force service who, at the time of joining service, have declared their hometown to be in the State of Telangana and who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
 4. Children of employees of a Corporation/Agency/Instrumentality under Government of Telangana, liable to be transferred anywhere in India as per the terms and conditions of his/her employment, who have served or are serving outside Telangana corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.
- II. Subject to the candidate submitting certificate of employment from the competent authority for the candidate's father/mother's service outside the State for the period corresponding to the candidate's year/s of study outside Telangana.

85% of seats under Management Quota – B category in MBBS & BDS courses in to Medical and Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS are reserved for Local candidates from the State of Telangana in accordance with G.O.Ms.No. 130, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 27.09.2022. The remaining 15% of seats are open to the candidates from all over the country including local candidates by merit.

25% of seats under Management Quota – B category at Neelima Institute of Medical Sciences is reserved for local candidates from the State of Telangana in accordance with G.O.Ms.No. 40, Higher Education (UE) Department, Dated: 20.06.2023.

Candidates from all over the country are eligible for admission into Management Quota – C/NRI quota seats in to MBBS & BDS courses.

Foreign Students/NRI candidates are eligible for admission into MBBS and BDS courses under Management Quota – C/NRI quota seats. **Candidates should specifically put the option for NRI category in the online application to be considered for Cat C/NRI quota seats failing which such candidates shall not be considered for admission into MBBS and BDS courses under C/NRI category.**

There is separate registration for Competent Authority Quota and Management Quota. Candidates who have already applied for Competent Authority Quota Seats in response to this University earlier notification are also eligible to apply for the Management Quota seats.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

In accordance with NMC Regulations,

the candidate should have passed Intermediate (10+2 pattern) or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology) / Biotechnology and English.

- OC/EWS candidates should obtain not less than 50% marks in science subjects.
 - BC/SC/ST candidates should obtain not less than 40% marks in science subjects.
 - OC/EWS PWD candidates should obtain not less than 45% marks in science subjects.
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- The Candidate should have qualified in NEET UG 2026 as per cut-off scores notified above.
 - **Community and Special Category reservations are not applicable in Management Quota.**

AGE:

The candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2026. The candidates who do not complete 17 years as on 31-12-2026 need not apply for the counselling. The above age criteria are applicable to all candidates of all categories.

REGISTRATION AND PROCESSING FEE:

- Candidates are advised to carefully read the Prospectus, University Regulations, relevant Government Orders (G.Os.), and the eligibility conditions prescribed in this notification before proceeding with the payment of the Registration and Processing Fee. **The Registration and Processing Fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.** Therefore, candidates should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility criteria before making the payment, uploading relevant documents and submitting the online application.
- The Registration and Processing fee of **Rs. 12,000/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand only)** (Bank transaction charges extra) shall be paid online.

*Fee shall be paid online through Debit Card/Credit Card or Net Banking.

NOTE: Registration & Processing fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to a further date.

- In case of payment failure resulting in a subsequent successful payment (double payment), candidates shall submit their representation for refund of the failed/duplicate payment only through e-mail to **knruhs.doublepayments@gmail.com**. Upon verification, the amount received through the failed/duplicate transaction, if any, shall be refunded to the candidate's bank account by following due procedure only after the closure of admissions.

NOTE:

- **Candidates claiming NRI quota should submit a declaration from a Blood relative such as Father/Mother/Brother/Sister/Uncle/Aunt only.**
- **For OCI/PIO candidates, citizenship card shall be uploaded as proof.**

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

- ❖ Online application forms without uploading the mandatory Certificates, Passport size photo, signature at declaration area and incomplete applications will be automatically rejected and will not be considered for determining the Merit position in respective categories using NEET UG 2026 Rank.
- ❖ The mere fact that merit position issued to a candidate does not imply that the candidature is accepted by the University and it does not mean that the entries made by the candidate in the online application are accepted as true and correct.
- ❖ Candidates' eligibility for admission into UG courses for the academic year 2026-27 will be examined by the University only after scrutiny of application along with all uploaded copies of required certificates and provisional final merit list will be notified.
- ❖ **Registration along with uploading of Scanned Original certificates will be done only once irrespective of the number of counsellings. No separate notification will be issued for verification of original certificates. Therefore, the candidates should register and upload all the mandatory Certificates without fail.**
- ❖ This notification is for online registration for determining the State Merit position in respective categories using NEET UG 2026 Rank only for eligible candidates. The schedule for exercising web options for admission to MBBS/BDS courses will be notified separately on University website. Candidates are advised to check the University website for notifications, counselling schedule, seat matrix and other details from time to time.
- ❖ An in-eligible candidate obtaining Merit position does not make the candidate eligible for admission. Admission will be considered only for candidates, who have secured marks above cutoff score in NEET UG 2026 examination and based on the state merit order as the case may be.
- ❖ Scrutiny of uploaded Original Certificates shall be conducted by the University and concerned departmental officials. After scrutiny of application and certificates, provisional merit list will be released. Candidates are advised to refer to University website for further details regarding schedule of exercising web options. **No individual communication will be sent.**
- ❖ Admissions will be in accordance with the orders issued from time to time by State Government with regard to process of admissions to Under Graduate courses for Management Quota and relevant Hon'ble Supreme Court and High Court orders.
- ❖ The procedure for preparation of seat matrix and selection into MBBS/BDS courses in the Management Quota and seat allocation will be done as per the procedure given in G.O.Ms.No. 115 & 116, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 05.07.2017, G.O.Ms.No. 117 & 118, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1)

Department, Dated: 20.07.2017, subsequent amendments, G.O.Ms.No. 125, 126 & 127, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 22.09.2022, G.O.Ms.No. 130, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 27.09.2022, G.O.Ms.No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 17.08.2024, G.O.Ms.No. 150, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department, Dated: 08.09.2025, University regulations and relevant Supreme Court and High Court orders.

- ❖ **Seats in Un-aided Minority Medical Colleges are reserved for Muslim Minority Candidates only. In case, Muslim Minority Candidates are not available the seats may be filled up with Non-Minority students up to maximum of 30% during final Phase of counselling.**
- ❖ **BDS seats in Army College of Dental Sciences are reserved for the wards of Army Personnel only.**
- ❖ Candidates have to exercise web options for seats in the colleges in which they are interested to join for MBBS course and BDS course separately. Candidates and parents are informed to exercise web options very carefully in the order of their preference for colleges and also to take a print out of exercised web options which are uploaded for reference.
- ❖ After allotment, the candidate should pay the University fee and download the allotment order, submit the print out of the filled-in Online application form, allotment order, Bonds and original certificates along with (1) set of self-attested copies to the Principal of allotted college at the time of joining for final verification by the admissions committee of the allotted college. The Admission Committee is responsible for scrutiny of the original certificates submitted by the candidate. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment order for admission will be cancelled.
- ❖ **Candidates are hereby informed that if they have secured admission in Medical colleges of other states, joined the course and if they are involved in seat blocking under Management Quota in KNRUHS, the University will initiate legal action and also inform the same to National Medical Commission for further course of action.**
