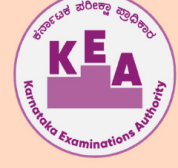

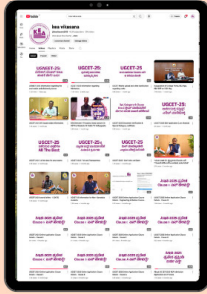

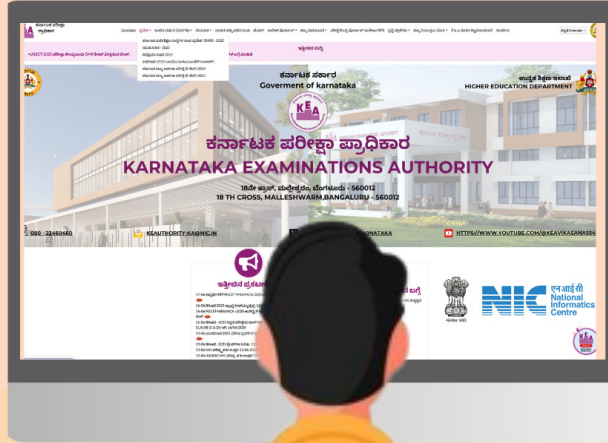

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1. PREAMBLE

- 1.1 Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA), Bangalore is designated by Government of Karnataka to conduct online counseling for admission to Post Graduate Degree / Diploma Courses in Government Medical and Dental colleges, Government Quota seats in Private and Minority Medical and Dental Colleges and Private seats in Private Medical and Dental colleges (KPCF, KRLMPCA, AMPCK & Private Universities) located in the State of Karnataka for the academic year 2026-27.
- 1.2 Admission to PG Medical and PG Dental seats shall be made in accordance with the “Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for selection and admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses Rules, 2006 (Amendments) as amended from time to time”, therefore the details and instructions contained in this Information Bulletin are subject to the said Rules and Government orders, in case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail; the decision of Government / Entrance Test Committee shall be final; and subject to
- 1.3 the guidelines / instructions of NMC / MCC / DCI / Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt / Government of India / Government of Karnataka / Director Medical Education, Karnataka / PG Entrance Test Committee and orders of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India issued from time to time on the conduct of Centralized Counseling for the seats to be notified by the Karnataka State Government, in Government, KPCF, KRLMPCA, AMPCK and Private University institutions.
- 1.4 The candidates who have scored more than or equal to the prescribed minimum score in NEET-PG-2026 / NEET MDS-2026 are only eligible to register and apply online for PG Medical and Dental courses for the year 2026-27.
- 1.5 Non-Karnataka candidates will not be eligible for reservation. Hence, in the NEET-PG-2026 / NEET MDS - 2026 examination, if they have scored the required minimum 50th percentile or above, fixed for ‘GENERAL (UR)’ category as per the qualifying criteria, then only they are eligible to register for admissions through KEA or for any other seats in the State of Karnataka. Please note that SC/ST/OBC eligibility criteria are applicable to Karnataka SC/ST/OBC candidates only.
- 1.6 Registration fee, schedule for verification of documents, original documents to be produced for verification and other details will be hosted on the KEA Website. Interested eligible candidates can register and apply online and appear for document verification as per the schedule.
- 1.7 Information Bulletin-2026 detailing admission eligibility criteria and other details are hosted on the KEA Website <https://cetonline.karnataka.gov.in/kea/pget2026> for the information of the candidates. Before registering through online for admission to PG Medical and PG Dental courses in the state of Karnataka, applicants are hereby informed to read the Information Bulletin NEET-PG-2026 and understand the eligibility conditions, educational qualification, classification of seats (different types of category of seats) and eligibility to claim such seats.
- 1.8 Mere qualifying in NEET-PG-2026 / NEET MDS-2026 does not confer any right on the candidate for admission unless the candidate fulfils eligibility conditions / submits the documents / certificates. Further, the candidates who complete the registration process including document verification are only eligible for PG Medical / Dental seats in Government / Private Colleges in Karnataka.
- 1.9 As per NMC, New Delhi letter dated 24-07-2023 (Annexure-20); all the rounds of counseling including Stray Vacancy Round will be conducted only by KEA in online mode, all the candidates who have qualified in NEET PG 2026 / NEET MDS 2026 are hereby advised to register online and complete the document verification process in KEA to become eligible for admission to PG Medical and Dental Courses in the State of Karnataka.
- 1.10 All candidates are directed to visit KEA Website frequently for updates and also check their mobile / e-mail as in case of urgency KEA may send the information / communications.
- 1.11 KEA or the Directorate of Medical Education or the Government shall not be responsible for any action / consequence/s resulting due to non-diligent follow up of notices, notifications and publications appearing on the KEA website on NEET-PG 2026 / NEET MDS 2026 by the candidates.

2 .DISCLAIMER

- 2.0 Candidates are advised to verify and confirm themselves that they are fulfilling any one of the Eligibility Clauses hosted in the KEA Website <https://cetonline.karnataka.gov.in/kea/pget2026> before applying for admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree or Diploma courses in the state of Karnataka for the year 2026. For any reason the fee paid by the candidates will not be refunded.
- 2.1 The SC / ST/OBC reservations are applicable to Karnataka SC / ST/OBC candidates only. Non-Karnataka candidates are not eligible for reservations.
- 2.2 If the information furnished by the candidates in the application form or any other document/s submitted by the candidates / parents is found to be false / incorrect / tampered / forged such candidate's seat will be cancelled at any point of time during his / her course of study and criminal proceedings as per rules will be initiated by KEA against the candidate.
- 2.3 The responsibility of KEA is limited to the conduct of centralized counseling, which includes online registration, document verification, online counseling procedure, seat allotment and issue of admission order as per NEET PG 2026 / NEET MDS 2026.
- 2.4 Candidates are advised to go through the user manual in the registration portal while filling the online registration form given at <https://cetonline.karnataka.gov.in/kea/pget2026>
- 2.5 Candidate shall ensure that all information entered during the online registration process is correct.
- 2.6 Online information provided by candidates like name of candidate, contact address details, category, PWD status, educational qualification details, date of birth etc during online submission of application form for NEET PG 2026 / NEET MDS 2026 will be treated as correct and KEA will not entertain, under any circumstances, any request for change.
- 2.7 KEA disclaims any liability that may arise to candidate(s) due to incorrect information provided by the candidate during online registration process.
- 2.8 KEA does not edit / modify / alter any information entered by the candidates at the time of online submission of application form under any circumstances. In the event of any clarification regarding the eligibility, the provisions of Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for Admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses, Rules 2006 as amended from time to time shall prevail and the decision of NMC / MCC / DCI / Government / Competent Authority / Universities / Karnataka Examinations Authority / Entrance test committee shall be final.
- 2.9 The information furnished by the candidate in the KEA PG Medical / Dental 2026 online application form with regard to Caste / Category and Annual Income and other reservations remains the same for the purpose of verification or for allotment of a seat and no change will be entertained in future for any reason.
- 2.10 The candidates deemed to have read and understand the eligibility conditions or procedures as mentioned in the PGNEET Information Bulletin issued by the Central / State counseling conducting authorities.

- b. This bulletin is in continuation of information bulletin published by the National Board of Examination. *Information in this bulletin with regard to PG Medical will come into effect only after announcement from MCC*
- c. Candidates are hereby informed to go through the Information Bulletin carefully and understand / acquaint themselves.

3.1 INTERNSHIP COMPLETION CUTOFF DATE

As per NBEMS, cutoff date for completion of internship towards determination of eligibility in NEET-MDS 2026 31-05-2026. (NEET-PG-2026 as per NMC / NBEEMS)

3.2 ADMISSION WITHDRAWAL / FORFEITURE OF FEES

- A. KEA will reserve the right to withdraw any such admission made at any point of time which is not fulfilling the eligibility criteria / regulations fixed by the Competent Authority from time to time.
- B. Karnataka Examinations Authority, the Directorate of Medical Education, the Government and the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences reserve the right to cause any verification as deemed essential at any point of time into the originality and authenticity of any of the certificates produced by any candidate to fulfill and stake his/her claim to any of the qualifying and eligibility criteria.
- C. If on such verification it is found that the candidate has produced fake, fraudulent certificates, he/she will be liable for criminal prosecution, immediate loss of allotted seat without any notice whatsoever, forfeiture of fees paid and levy of penalty and will be liable to be debarred from all exams / counseling in future; the authorities may also recommend blacklisting of the candidate to NMC / DCI / KMC and cancellation of medical / dental council registration.

3.4 COMPULSORY RURAL SERVICE FOR ONE YEAR:

(Rural Service Bond to be submitted by all the category candidates allotted to Government / Private / Deemed colleges under Government quota or Private quota or NRI quota or Management quota)

All the candidates (other than the candidates who have undergone compulsory rural service after award of MBBS degree) who take admission to PG Medical Degree/Diploma courses in Government / Private / Deemed colleges under Government quota or Private quota or NRI quota or Management quota and successfully complete the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma shall undergo one-year compulsory service in Government hospital in urban area as per Karnataka Compulsory service training by the candidates completed medical courses (counseling, allotment, and certification) as per Karnataka Compulsory Service Training by Candidates completed Medical Courses Act, 2012 as amended and rules there under. Please note that candidates will be entitled to only temporary registration till the completion of such service.

3.4 THREE YEARS SERVICE AFTER COMPLETION

Candidates selecting Government seats {including All India quota (AIQ)} in Post Graduate Medical Courses shall furnish an undertaking that he / she shall serve the Government for a minimum period of three years after completion of the course, if Government desires:

3.5 GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Any candidate, who is already holding a PG Degree in any clinical specialty, shall not be eligible for admission to any Post Graduate Degree or Diploma Course.

3.6 FOREIGN MEDICAL GRADUATE EXAMINATION (FMGE - SCREENING TEST)

Any candidate who has obtained his / her undergraduate medical / dental qualifications from medical / dental Colleges outside India should have qualified in the **Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE - Screening Test)** which is conducted by National Board of Examinations / DCI (Document mandatorily to be produced). Further, they should have been registered with MCI / DCI and should have completed their internship or likely to complete their internship on or before date prescribed by the Competent Authority.

3.7 FOREIGN NATIONALS

Foreign national's qualification should be duly registered with appropriate registering authority in his / her own country where from he / she has obtained his / her basic medical graduate qualification, and is duly recognized by the corresponding Medical Council or concerned authority. Further, should obtain temporary registration certificate for the duration of the PG course from MCI / DCI.

The candidates are advised to strictly adhere to the above said rules. Lenience in any matter explained above will not be entertained. The Government / Department of Medical Education / KEA, shall holds all the powers to cancel the candidature of candidates who do not comply with the rules and regulations.

APPEAL

Any person aggrieved by the order or decision of the Executive Director under CET-2006 Rules may within 15 days from the date of such order or decision, appeal to the Principal Secretary, Secretary to Government (Higher Education) Department, Government of Karnataka, who after calling for records from the Executive Director and after examining the same, shall pass orders as he deems fit, which shall be final.

LEGAL JURISDICTION

Any dispute that may arise in respect of the test or the later seat selection process, admission, fees and cancellation is subject to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High court of Karnataka. The issuance of admission order by the KEA shall enable the candidate to join the concerned college, subject to the academic eligibility, etc., being approved by the concerned University as per the Regulations.

PWD Reservations:

- c. Candidate information such as name, father's name, mother's name, date of birth, NBE Score, Mobile number is fetched from NBE data.
- d. OTP will be sent to candidate's same mobile number registered with NBE. Candidate should not share the OTP with others.
- e. Candidates have to enter, Eligibility Clause Code, Reservation Category, Educational Qualification, contact details etc. has to be entered.
- f. Those who are eligible under In-service enter the same.
- g. Uploading photograph, left thumb impression & signature
- h. Registration fee has to be paid by the candidate by following the procedure mentioned therein.
- i. Print & submit application form.
- j. Candidates should Make a note of the application ID / Login ID and also save it on the note pad. The Login ID or the password created during registration should not be shared with anyone, further; NBE details should also not to be shared with others.

PG Medical and Dental seats are classified into four categories namely;

2. P- Private Seats
3. N- NRI Seats
4. Q- Others Seats

7.1.(G): GOVERNMENT SEATS,

Means and includes seats in Government colleges and Government share of seats in Private colleges.

- (i) 50% of Seats in Government colleges (Remaining 50% through All India Quota counseling by MCC)
- (ii) 33% of Seats in Private Non-Minority colleges.
- (iii) 20% of Seats in Private Minority (Religious & Linguistic) colleges
- (iv) 40% of Seats in Private University colleges

7.2 (P): PRIVATE SEATS,

Means seats in Private Colleges (KPCF, AMPCK, and KRLMPCA)

- (i) In KPCF Colleges: 42% seats reserved as private quota seats
 - **GMP seats:** For 50% of the above 42% seats. (Referred as **GMP** seats / **GMP** with Hyd-Kar seats in case of colleges located in Hyd-Kar region).
 - **OPN seats:** Remaining 50% of the above 42% seats are "OPEN" quota seats: These seats are filled based on NEET PG All India merit and only Citizens of India are eligible.
- (ii) In KRLMPCA and AMPCK Colleges: 55% of seats reserved as private quota seats.
 - 66% of the above seats will be filled by respective religious / linguistic minority candidates (MK, MA, ME, MU, MC, MM seats).
 - 34% of the above seats;
 - a. **GMP:** 50% of the above 34% seats are GMP seats.
 - b. **OPN:** 50% of the above 34% seats are reserved for All India candidates who are Citizen of India (OPN seats).
 - In case of Private University 40% of the seats reserved as private quota seats.

Note: St. John's Medical college eligibility and other details are also appended to information Bulletin under the heading "**St. John's Medical College**".

7.3 (N): NRI SEATS,

Means 15% of the total seats reserved for NRI quota in KPCF, KRLMPCA, AMPCK colleges and private university.

7.4 (Q): OTHER SEATS,

Means 10% of the total seats reserved for others in KPCF, KRLMPCA & AMPCK colleges and 5% in private university.

8 ELIGIBILITY FOR DIFFERENT TYPES OF SEAT (G, P, N, Q)

Any candidate, who is already holding a PG Degree in any clinical specialty, shall not be eligible for admission to any Post Graduate Degree or Diploma Course.

8.1 ELIGIBILITY for Government seats (G) seats:

- (a) A candidate must be a citizen of India; and
- (b) Have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in a recognized Medical /Dental institution in the state of Karnataka; or
- (c) Have studied and passed MBBS/BDS in recognized Medical / Dental institutions located in India and has studied for a minimum period of ten academic years commencing from 1st standard to 12th standard and must have appeared and passed either SSLC or 10th standard or 2nd PUC or 12th standard equivalent examination from the Karnataka State are eligible.”

In case of the candidate who has taken more than one year to pass a class or standard, the years of academic study is counted as one year only.

Note: Children for the purpose of the rule means Natural born son / daughter and not adopted son/daughter and not grandson / granddaughter.

- iii. Children of Non-resident Indian or their Wards. (As per Hon'ble High Court in WP Nos.17999-18002/2017)
- iv. Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. Dated 22-08- 2017.
- v. As per the definition defined in The Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006 read with the Karnataka Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) (Amendment) Act, 2017 and the Income Tax Act 1961 Section 115 C (e) & 6, i.e., " Non Resident Indian" means an individual resident outside India who is a citizen of India or is a Person of Indian Origin and includes Persons of Indian Origin and Overseas Citizens of India.

8.4 ELIGIBILITY for Other seats (Q):

Has studied MBBS or BDS degree in a Medical or Dental colleges affiliated to any University established by law in India recognized by Medical Council of India or Dental Council of India and Government of India. All the candidates who have qualified in NEET-PG 2026 / NEET MDS 2026 are eligible except NRI / PIO / OCI and Foreign Nationals.

- ii) Candidates study certificate for 10 years for 1st to 12th Standard including the duration of study in New Delhi.
- iii) In case of claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).
- iv) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate (**Annexure 17 and Annexure 17(A)**) (Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

8.5.8. Documents for Clause-g

- i) For serving defense personnel: Parent's home town declaration certificate as Karnataka while joining the services issued by the respective branch or integrated HQ of MoD for officers and respective Record Offices for JCOs / OR.
- ii) For ex-servicemen: Parent's home town declaration certificate while joining the service issued by the Joint Director / Deputy Director of the concerned district and countersigned by the Director, Department of Sainik Welfare and Resettlement, Bangalore.
- iii) If claiming reservation benefits: Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahsildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-1 in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A & 3B in Form-F (In case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband name & income of spouse (Ref G.O no DPAR 20 SBC 82, Dtd 28/12/1983).
- iv) If claimed "NRI Ward" - Ward Certificate (**Annexure 17 and Annexure 17(A)**) (Embassy certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate issued within last 06 months) should be enclosed separately.)

Obtain Temporary registration certificate from MCI/DCI within one month of securing admission.

Note:

1. For the purpose of verification e-document may be considered with regard to NRI ward certificate subject to submitting the original at the time of taking the admission.
2. Apart from the above documents, the other documents to be compulsorily produced by the candidates based on their eligibility.

8.5.11. Religious Minority (Muslim & Christian Minority)

- i) Religious Minority certificate issued by the concerned Tahshildar of Karnataka in the format (**Annexure 11 & 12**) along with a study certificate for having studied for a minimum period of 10 years from 1st standard to 12th Standard including either 10th or 12th Standard from the Head of educational institution located in State of Karnataka.

- ii) Religious Minority certificate issued by the concerned Tahshildar for others to claim Religious Minority Quota under Non Karnataka Religious Minority.

Linguistic Minority certificate issued by BEO/DDPI (**Annexure 09 and 10**) and a study certificate for having studied for a minimum period of 10 years from 1st standard to 12th Standard including either 10th or 12th Standard from the Head of educational institution located in State of Karnataka. (**Annexure 09 and 10**)

8.5.13. St John's Medical College, Bangalore

- i) For Roman Catholic religious Nuns with two year rural service in SJMC approved centers.
 - a) Certificate of bona-fide membership in a Religious Congregation from Superior General / Provincial Superior. (**Annexure 13**)
 - b) Certificate of two year rural service issued by Director SJMC. (**Annexure 14**)
- ii) For candidates with two year rural service in SJMC approved centers - Certificate of two year rural service issued by Director SJMC. (**Annexure 14**)
- iii) For Roman Catholic Open Merit.
 - a. Baptism Certificate from Roman Catholic Church in English language. Please provide English transcript if in any other language (attested by the Bishop). (**Annexure 15**)
 - b. Bonafide Roman Catholic Certificate from Bishop of the Diocese. (**Annexure 16**)

Note:

- i. The Karnataka Examinations Authority or the entrance test committee may from time to time specify for submission such other additional documents as deemed essential from all candidates through the application form or through a notification on their website.
- ii. The candidates claiming any of the exemption specified above shall produce such certificate as specified by the committee for claiming such exemption.
- iii. In case, if any of the documents produced in respect of the Clause claimed by the candidate is found to be false / incorrect, the seat allotted to the candidate will be cancelled at any stage and the entire fee amount paid by such candidate will be forfeited.

9. INSTRUCTIONS FOR IN-SERVICE CANDIDATES

In-service candidates may please read and understand the eligibility conditions specified by the Government / DME. "Karnataka conduct of Entrance Test for Selection and admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses (Amendments) Rules" 2006, 2024 from time to time.

Detailed guidelines, in-service eligibility conditions / procedures will be published later after receipt of the same from the Government / DME.

Note:

- The regulations as per rule 9 of the Medical Council of India Post graduate medical education regulations 2000 as amended from time to time will be applicable.
- In-service subject restrictions as notified by the appropriate authority will be applied.
- The certificates produced by any candidate under rules of eligibility and In-Service Candidates shall be verified with appropriate authorities and on such verification and on the basis of information received; Karnataka Examinations Authority may reject the application of any candidate if they found to be ineligible.

11. NOTE ON OPTION ENTRY AND ONLINE SEAT ALLOTMENT

- a. **The option entry will be only once** for all online seat allotment rounds. Candidates are required to note that there could be seat surrenders from All India Quota after the All India Quota last round or may be new approvals for additional intake and new courses approval in colleges at a later date. Candidates have to compulsorily declare the same to start option entry. Therefore, all the candidates are hereby informed to enter their priority of options irrespective of the number of seats shown against a particular course.
- b. The priority of options entered by the candidate for the first round will remain same for all the rounds of seat allotment. **Candidates will not be allowed to enter options again for any other rounds.** The priority of options entered by the candidate will be shown on the option entry module by obtaining the candidate credentials. Candidate may delete or alter the order of options based on the **CHOICE** of candidate opted after the respective round of seat allotment.
- c. Mere qualifying in **NEET-PG 2026 / NEET MDS 2026** does not confer any right on the candidate unless the candidate fulfills eligibility conditions / submission of certificates. Further, only the candidates who complete the online registration, submission of application, payment process, and complete the offline document verification (at KEA, 18th Cross, Malleswaram, Bangalore) including obtaining of the **“documents verification slip”** are only considered to enter the options to become eligible for online seat allotment for admission to PG Medical / Dental seats in Government / Private Colleges in Karnataka, as per norms.
- d. All the rounds of online seat allotment would be conducted as per the directions of Central Government / NMC / MCC / State Government / Apex bodies.

11.1 NOTE ON MOCK SEAT ALLOTMENT:

- a. **After the entry of options are completed,** based on the options entered by the candidates in the order of merit and by following the Roster System MOCK SEAT ALLOTMENT will be carried out as per the procedures explained in this Brochure. This Mock Seat Allotment is only an INDICATIVE seat status which candidate may or may not get in the real allotment. It will help the candidate to revise, update, add or delete already the entered options.
- b. Candidates are required to verify their allotted seat status on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>, if they desire they are free to change, reorder, delete and add to

their **CHOICES** of courses / colleges as per their preference. All the candidates must enter their final options before **the last date prescribed**. Candidates will not be able to change their options after the last date and time fixed to do so. Even though the candidate may not like to modify the options after the Mock Allotment, he / she may not get the same seat during the Real Allotment as other candidates may change their earlier entered options.

- c. Candidates will also be able to view the details of seat allotted as per their options priority. Candidates can also view the College-wise, Course-wise, Category-wise cut off rank of Mock Allotment. Candidates, who have not been allotted any seat in the Mock allotment, should verify the options entered by them and are advised to enter more options in which they are interested.
- d. This is only an indicative exercise; candidates need not report to the college, but should wait for the real allotment result. However, ALL CANDIDATES CAN CONTINUE TO ACCESS THEIR LOGIN ACCOUNTS TO UPDATE/ ADD/DELETE/ GIVE FRESH OPTIONS TILL THE LAST DATE AND TIME FOR OPTION ENTRY FOR REAL ALLOTMENT.

11.2 WHY DO WE CONDUCT MOCK SEAT ALLOTMENT?

- a. Based on the Mock Seat Allotment a candidate can get an indicative allotment of college / course / stream as per his / her priority of options. This gives a clear idea to the candidate to change or retain the entered options. Candidates can get to know that the other candidate with lower merit is allotted a seat which he / she was eligible but for his / her not entering that option. Therefore, candidates will be given one more chance to change the priority of options or deletion or addition or re-ordering of the options.
- b. Since candidates may change their options priority numbers or add or delete new ones after checking the mock result, the seats allotted in the mock seat allotment may or may not be available in the real seat allotment.
- c. Those eligible candidates who have not entered the options for mock seat allotment, can also enter their priority of options by registering and paying the non-refundable fee of Rs.750/-.
- d. Candidate should preserve the print out of the finally submitted options.

12. COUNSELING PROCEDURE (ALLOTMENT LOGIC)

The seat matrix issued by the Government for each discipline will be adopted for allotment seats. College wise, course wise and category wise seat matrix issued by the Government will be hosted on the Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA) Website for the information of the candidates and parents. The online allotment will be based on merit, priority of options entered by the candidates and roster prescribed by the Government.

Eligibility to participate in each round is subject to the conditions stipulated from time to time by (MCC). KEA will not be held responsible in this regard. Detailed information about entering options and mock seat allotment has been explained in the previous pages for the information of the candidates. As a continuation of that, **detailed information about 2 + 1 rounds followed by Stray Vacancy Round, stages are given below;**

That is,

1. FIRST ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT

2. SECOND ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT

3. THIRD ROUND / MOP-UP ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT

4. STRAY VACANCY ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT

Required information like rules, instructions, guidelines, procedures, schedule etc. for each round of seat allotment for various professional courses will be published on the KEA Website from time to time. Candidates should read the instructions carefully and follow them accordingly.

The seat will be allotted to the eligible candidates as per the roster system and seat matrix issued by the Government and based on the options entered by the candidates.

12.1. ITERATION PROCESS

Computer starts with allotment of seats to rank number 1 in Medical discipline. The computer first checks the availability of seats for the First option entered by the candidate with Rank no 1. Obviously the candidate will get the seat as per his options. Whereas, for the next rank holders the computer checks the availability of seats for the first option, if seat is available it will allot or if the seat is not available then the computer will search for the next option. Like that the computer will search for the availability of seats for all the options entered by the candidates. The computer will stop searching for allotment of seats once the seat is allotted then the computer will move on to next eligible candidates. Similarly, the computer will search for all the candidates based on the merit and options. Like this the computer will reach the last rank till seats are exhausted or till last rank candidate is reached. This entire process is called **iteration**.

12.2. SEAT ALLOTMENT LOGIC:

Based on the seat matrix issued by the Government, action will be taken to allot the seats to the candidates based on their eligibility and reservation criteria. The options entered by the candidate will be considered for allotment based on the basis of merit. While allotting the seats to the candidates, the computer will check the availability of seats for each option based on the priority of options. The order of allotment / reservation for each of the category is detailed below for the information of the candidates.

The allotment of seat for a particular candidate is based on his/her rank and priority option entered. In any category, the candidate option is searched in general category (GM) and allotted, if no seat is available in GM category the computer searches in Hyderabad Karnataka GM quota (GMH) and allots the seat. If seat is not available either in GM or GMH then it follows the priority order as shown below. This improves the category of seat allotted to roster. In the same manner all the categories improved as per roster for candidates claiming reservation.

12.3 FIRST ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT.

- 12.3.1** Seat Matrix and the fee structure issued by the Government for Post Graduate Medical and Dental courses will be displayed on the KEA Website for the information of the candidates.
- 12.3.2** Candidates are advised to verify the fee structure, seat type, college location, and other relevant details of each course before entering their options.
- 12.3.3** Online option entry portal will be enabled and the candidates can exercise their priority of OPTIONS as per the schedule.
- 12.3.4** The priority of options entered by the candidate for the first round will remain same for the online seat allotment. **Candidates will not be allowed to enter OPTIONS again for second round seat allotment.** The priority of options entered by the candidate will be shown on the option entry module by obtaining the candidate credentials. Candidate may delete or alter the order of options based on the **CHOICE** of candidate opted after the respective round of seat allotment.
- 12.3.5** Academic Eligibility / admissions to Colleges/ Seat Allotments made shall be subject to rules /conditions specified from time to time / approval by NMC, Government, Concerned University, Apex Bodies, etc.
- 12.3.6** KEA will reserves the right to withdraw any such admission made at any point of time which is not fulfilling the eligibility criteria / regulations fixed by the Competent Authority from time to time.
- 12.3.7** The First Round final seat allotment list will be hosted on the Website. Candidate should login and select any one of the 4 CHOICES. If a candidate fails to exercise any one of the four choices or fails to follow any prescribed procedures, then the seat allotted to such candidate stands cancelled automatically without any further notice and such candidate shall not be allowed to participate in further rounds.

The choices are: -

CHOICE-1

“Completely satisfied (100%) with the first round allotted seat and candidate is willing to report to the allotted college, not interested to participate in any of the subsequent round seat allotment for any discipline”.

Such candidates should pay the prescribed fees and submit the original documents, obtain the admission order and report to the college on or before last date as specified

in the admission order. He/she should login to his / her Option Entry Log-In-Id and report to KEA that he / she has joined. If a candidate fails to report back to KEA that he / she has joined, then their seat will be cancelled even though he / she might have physically joined.

Implication: Not eligible to participate in the subsequent rounds.

Important: Before opting for this choice candidate is advised to be sure as he / she cannot come back to Option Entry Process for NEET-PG 2026 / NEET MDS 2026 admissions.

Further any candidate who has paid the fees and obtained the Admission Order and fails to report to the College on or before the last date and time specified by KEA in the admission Order, for such candidates no extension of time will be given and the allotment made in his / her favor shall be treated as cancelled and he / she has no claim further on such allotment and he /she will not be considered for allotment of seats in the subsequent round. Such seats shall revert back to the pool and fee paid by them will be forfeited.

The candidates who exercise Choice 1 should follow the guidelines detailed below:

- Pay the fees by following procedures prescribed. (Read the instructions hosted in the KEA Website with regard to payment by NRI Sponsorer)
- After ascertaining the payment, submit the original documents to KEA.
- Collect the Admission Order from KEA and report to the college on or before the last date mentioned in the Admission Order.
- After reporting to the college, candidate has to update the joining status details on the KEA Web Portal that he / she has reported to the college.
- Candidate has to inform the college authority to log onto College Portal to enter his / her reported details.

Note:

The Choice 1 candidate who fails to produce any one of the original document or all the documents or who fails to pay the fees, for such candidates the seat allotted to him / her in the first round stands cancelled automatically and also such candidate will not be considered for further round of seat allotment.

CHOICE-2

“Candidate is satisfied with the allotted seat but wishes to participate in the next round for upgradation with HIGHER ORDER OPTIONS”. Candidates should pay the prescribed fees and wait for the schedule to submit the original documents to become eligible for allotment in the second round. Admission order will not be given to Choice-2 candidates.

Implication: Choice-2 candidates are participating in the second round by holding the first round allotted seat for higher order options. In the second round, if higher option seat is allotted then earlier allotted seat gets cancelled automatically OR if higher option seat is not allotted then earlier allotted seat shall remain in candidates favour. There is no CHOICE between the earlier allotted and newly allotted seats. Candidate should compulsorily get admitted to the college confirmed.

NOTE:

Please note that there will not be any CHOICE available to select after announcement of SECOND ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT. Taking admission is compulsory.

Instructions to candidates who have exercised Choice-2 in the first round.

1. Candidate has to pay the fees for the seat allotted to him / her in the first round.
2. Candidate has to wait for the schedule to submit the original documents to KEA to become eligible for the second round. Schedule for submission original documents will be notified on the KEA Website. (Choice-2 printout, Fee paid receipt, Verification Slip, all original documents including Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7 and one set of photocopies of all the documents)

Additional Important Instructions for First Round Choice 2 Candidates

- (a) All the higher order options will be displayed on the option entry screen.
- (b) The seat allotted to the candidate in the first round will be considered as last option in the second round.
- (c) Candidates can alter, modify, delete or re-order the higher order options.
- (d) Higher order options means, presume that the candidate has entered 76 options, and if the seat is allotted for his / her priority number 45 in the first round, then the priority number 1 to 44 are the higher order options.
- (e) If any seat is upgraded & allotted to him / her in the second round, then his / her First Round seat gets added to the seat matrix immediately and is offered to the next eligible candidates in the order of options and priority of options. If any of the Higher Order Options is not allotted, then the seat allotted to him / her in the first round will remain with the candidate.

- (f) While modifying the order of options or deleting the options candidates are advised to give only such options that are better than his / her allotted seat. If the modified option gets allotted he / she lose his / her old seat. If none of the seats are available then the candidate's earlier seat is retained.
- (g) For Choice 2 candidates the seat allotted in the First Round will be considered as last option. The Choice 2 candidates should be very careful while submitting the options. One should understand that the seat allotted in the First Round will become the last option, it means all the higher options saved by the candidates will be treated as options for seat allotment.
- (h) All the higher order options will be displayed for entry of options, if any candidate is intending to retain the same seat which is allotted in the First Round, then he / she has to delete all such options which are displayed on the option entry portal, then the seat allotted in the First Round will be retained in this round also.

CHOICE-3:

The candidate is not satisfied with the present allotment and wishes to participate in the next round of counseling with all the already entered options except the allotted option by surrendering the allotted seat. Previously allotted seat is forfeited and will be considered for allotment in the second round. Choice-3 candidates should wait for the schedule to submit the original documents to become eligible for second round of seat allotment. If original documents are not submitted such candidates are not eligible for second round of seat allotment.

Implication: Eligible to participate in the second round without holding the first round seat by depositing the original documents and no claim on previously allotted seat therefore Choice-3 candidates need not to pay the fees for the seat allotted in the first round.

NOTE:

There will not be any CHOICE to select after the second round seat allotment. If any seat is allotted in the second round, candidate has to compulsorily pay the fees, download the admission order and report to the college on or before the last date mentioned in the Admission Order.

Additional Instructions to candidates who have exercised Choice-3 in first round.

1. Submit the original documents to become eligible for the second round. Schedule for submission of original documents will be notified on the KEA Website. (Choice-3 printout, Verification Slip, all original documents including Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7 and one set of photocopies of all the documents)
2. Choice-3 candidates are participating in this round without holding any seat allotted to them in the first round, if any seat is allotted to them in this round then such seat will be confirmed in their favour or if no seat is allotted to them then they will not be having any seat in their favour.

3. All the already entered options except the allotted option will be displayed on the option entry screen.
4. Candidates can alter, modify, delete or re-order the already entered options.
5. While modifying the order of options or deleting the options, candidates are advised to give only such options that are better than his / her allotted seat and for those options candidate is willing to join the college / course in case the seat is allotted.

CHOICE-4:

Not satisfied with KEA allotted seat and candidate has got seat elsewhere, so candidate is quitting and not to be considered for allotment of seats in any of the further rounds.

Implication: Not eligible to participate in the subsequent round and no hold on the allotted seat and seat allotted earlier will get cancelled.

CHOICE-2 / CHOICE-3 selected candidates and seat NOT allotted candidates.

Submission of original documents to attend 2nd Round of seat allotment is mandatory to all the candidates who were allotted seat in the first round and opted CHOICE-2 or CHOICE-3 and also to those candidates who have not been allotted a seat during first round to become eligible for second round of online seat allotment. Schedule for submission of original documents will be notified on the KEA Website. (Verification Slip, all original documents including Annexure-1, Annexure-2, Annexure-7 and one set of photocopies of all the documents)

12.4 SECOND ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT:

12.4.1 The following types of seats are made available for second round seat allotment.

- a. Unfilled seats of First Round
- b. Choice 3 seats of First Round
- c. Choice 4 seats of First Round.
- d. Exercised Choice 1 in First Round but failed to make payment or not joined the college
- e. Exercised Choice 2 in First Round but failed to make payment
- f. Cancelled / Surrendered seats
- g. Allotted seats in First Round but failed to exercise their Choice within the last date
- h. Newly added seats if any. (All India Quota)
- i. Consequential Vacancies
- j. **Virtual Vacancies:**
 - i. The seat held by CHOICE-2 of first round candidate will be displayed as virtual vacancy.

- ii. If any Choice-2 candidate of first round upgraded in the second round, vacates the first round seat.
- iii. That vacated seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate in this second round provided such options are available in the candidate option entry list. Hence, all the second round eligible candidates are advised to retain such options if they are interested.

12.4.2 Types of candidates allowed for Second Round.

- a. First Round CHOICE-2 candidates paid the fees and deposited the original documents.
- b. First Round CHOICE-3 candidates and deposited the original documents.
- c. Not allotted any seat in the First Round and deposited the original documents.
- d. If the candidate who has been allotted a seat in Second Round of All India Quota and Deemed University and has not joined the allotted college in the Round 2 of All India counseling, and exits with forfeiture clause, he/she shall be allowed to participate in the second round of state counseling subject to deposition of original documents at KEA.

12.4.3 The following types of candidates are NOT eligible to participate in the Second Round.

- a. Candidates failed to enter options for first round.
- b. Candidates failed to exercise any CHOICE after allotment of seats in the First Round.
- c. First round CHOICE-2 candidates failed to pay or not deposited the original documents.
- d. First round CHOICE-3 candidates failed to deposit the original documents.
- e. Candidates who have not allotted any seat in the first round but failed to deposit the original documents.
- f. Choice 1 or Choice 2 and cancelled / surrendered the seats.

12.4.4 SECOND ROUND OPTION ENTRY – INSTRUCTIONS.

- I. Seats available for the second round seat allotment will be published in the KEA Website.
- II. Candidates are advised to keep checking the website for updates on seat availability, because such seats which may get cancelled / forfeited / newly added seats will be published frequently.
- III. Option entry portal will be enabled as per the schedule. Eligible candidates can access to the option entry portal and after confirming the fee structure carefully reorder the options in the order of priority. As instructed earlier **adding of new option is not permitted.**
- IV. Further, as the consequential vacancies which may arise during the seat allotment or the seat may get cancelled after publication of seat matrix or the seat which may gets added to the seat matrix will also be considered for allotment. Hence candidates are advised to retain all such options they are interested to select irrespective of the seats shown in the seat matrix or not.

- V. If candidate decides that unwanted options are there in their option entry list, he / she can delete it in consultation with their parents.
- VI. Consequential vacancies that arise during the second round seat allotment after the candidate merit / turn cannot be claimed.

12.4.5 POST ALLOTMENT PROCEDURE: IMPLICATION: - CHOICES BEFORE A CANDIDATE.

- a. There will NOT be any CHOICES to exercise to the candidates.
- b. Fee paid by first round CHOICE-2 candidates will be adjusted.
- c. Candidates who have allotted seat to any college / course are required to pay the prescribed fees (if not paid) and should compulsorily report to the colleges on or before the last date mentioned in the admission order.

12.5 PROVISION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 3RD ROUND OF COUNSELING

As per the recent orders of the Hon'ble High Courts, candidate who gets admitted to seat allotted in the second round shall also be eligible to participate in the third round of counseling. The counseling conditions and guidelines for admission to PG Medical / Dental courses for the academic year 2026 have been revised and published as below:

- 1. Candidates who have been allotted seats in the second round must compulsorily take admission in the college by paying the prescribed fee. (Clinical / Pre and Para Clinical)
- 2. Candidates who have been admitted in the college will be allowed to participate in the seats available in the third round (Up-gradation).
- 3. If any candidate fails to report to the college after allotment of seats in the Second Round, legal action will be initiated against such candidate in accordance with law.

NOTE: If the candidate does not get any seat in this round then the seat allotted to him / her in the earlier round if any stands confirmed.

- All candidates who have been allotted afresh in this round should compulsorily join the colleges after making payment and collecting admission order at KEA and report to KEA portal for confirmation otherwise seat gets cancelled.
- If any candidate gets a better option seat in this round, the earlier allotted seat will be added to seat matrix pool of the same category immediately and the same seat will be made available for the next rank number candidate.
- The candidate shall be disqualified from further seat allotment process and shall be liable for criminal prosecution if any one of the original certificate is not produced during verification or found to be false/concocted/ color Xerox etc.

12.6 APPEAL TO CANDIDATE

Candidates may have options of selecting the seats in other boards / colleges / states outside KEA also. Such candidates may please note that, such of those who have got the Allotment Order from KEA and do not join the allotted college or leave the college after joining would be tantamount to seat blocking and will result in loss of subsidized Government Quota / Private Seats and unlawful gain to the Private Managements. There are other equally eligible meritorious candidates in the merit queue. KEA requests such candidates to surrender their allotted seat to KEA only and such seat will be offered to other equally eligible meritorious candidates in the Second Round.

The candidates who have,

- (a) exercised Choice-1 in the first round, submitted the original documents, paid the fees, collected the Admission Order and reported to the college;
- or
- (b) exercised Choice-2 in the first round submitted the original documents and paid the fees, may have the chance of joining to the college or courses from other boards later on, are hereby informed to surrender their seat on or before the last date fixed for entry of options for the second round.

12.7 THIRD ROUND (MOP-UP)

If any seats remain vacant after the second round, 3rd Round (Mop-up) seat allotment will be conducted for all categories of seats.

ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 3RD ROUND (MOP-UP ROUND)

- 12.7.1 Candidates who have NOT been allotted any seat in KEA Second Round are eligible to participate in the Mop-up round if they are interested; and
- 12.7.2 Candidates who have joined the colleges allotted in KEA seat allotment can participate for up-gradation(as per recent Hon'ble High Court orders)

NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 3RD ROUND (MOP-UP ROUND)

- 12.7.3 Seat allotted, but failed to exercise any Choice in the first round or failed to pay the fees or failed to report to colleges are **not** eligible to participate in the 3rd round seat allotment.
- 12.7.4 Candidates who have joined the College after allotment of seats in first round or second round or Third round All India Counseling including Counseling for Deemed Universities or any other boards are not eligible to participate. (as per MCC bulletin - Subject to conditions if any, stipulated by GoI).

OPTION ENTRY for 3rd Round (Mop-up)

- 12.7.5 All the eligible candidates who are holding the verification slip and who deposit the original documents are only eligible to enter the options.
- 12.7.6 All the eligible candidates have to enter the options afresh for Mop-up round. The options entered if any, in the previous rounds will not be considered.
- 12.7.7 Since seats will be allotted based on the candidates' merit and the options entered by them, candidates are advised to select only those options for which they are genuinely interested in joining, after confirming the applicable fees. Candidates may enter their preferred options even if seats are not currently displayed for those options in the seat matrix.
- 12.7.8 During the third round of seat allotment only the colleges / course in which the candidate wants to join should be entered, because the seat allotment is done on the basis of merit and considering the options entered by the candidates, the allotted seat cannot be denied. Therefore, candidates should carefully submit their options in the order of priority.
- 12.7.9 As the seats which may get cancelled /forfeited/newly added will also be published from time to time, candidates are advised to keep checking the KEA Website for updates on the availability of seats.
- 12.7.10 Further, the seats will be considered for allotment as a result of any CONSEQUENTIAL VACANCY that may arise during the seat allotment. Therefore, candidates are advised to retain all the options they are interested in choosing irrespective of the seats shown in the seat matrix.
- 12.7.11 **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:** Candidates who are participating in this round mean they are looking for up-gradation of a seat than the allotted seat in the earlier round. If the candidate does not get any seat in this round then the seat allotted to him / her in the earlier round if any, stands confirmed.
- i. Candidates are advised to carefully retain all the options they wish to select, even if the seats are not currently shown in the seat matrix. This is because consequential vacancies may arise during the allotment process, and candidates may have an opportunity to secure a better seat if they have already included those options.
 - ii. Candidates shall not claim ignorance regarding the allotment of seats or reject the seats allotted to them, as seat allotment is made strictly based on the options exercised by the candidates and their order of merit.
 - iii. For any reason candidates will not be allowed to continue in their earlier allotted colleges. As already informed the earlier allotted seat will not be in their favour and therefore such candidates should invariably report to the allotted colleges.
 - iv. If the candidate gets a seat in the colleges entered by him / her in this round, the seat opted by him / her in this round will be confirmed and the seat held by him / her in the earlier round will get cancelled automatically.
 - v. Please note that if any seat gets allotted in this round as per merit and options entered by the candidate, **there is no chance of getting back the earlier allotted seat.**

12.7.12 PROCEDURE TO BE COMPLETED AFTER THE 3RD-ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT:

- I. There will not be any **CHOICE** to exercise to the candidates.
- II. Candidates who have allotted seat in any college – course are required to pay the prescribed fees (if not paid) and should compulsorily report to the colleges on or before the last date mentioned in the admission order and should update the details through their log-In-Id to KEA or they lose their allotted seats.
- III. If any candidate fails to report to the college after allotment of seats in the 3rd Round / Casual Vacancy, legal action will be initiated against such candidate in accordance with law.

12.8 STRAY VACANCY ROUND

Only those candidates who have not been allotted any PG Medical / PG Dental seat in any round by KEA are eligible for the Stray Vacancy round. Those who have reported to college after allotment from MCC / Deemed University / or any Institution / Boards in the three rounds of seat allotment are not eligible to participate in the Stray Vacancy round and candidates who have been allotted seats in the Stray Vacancy round by MCC are also not eligible.

12.9 IMPORTANT and APPLICABLE TO ALL THE ROUNDS OF SEAT ALLOTMENT

Candidates are advised to visit KEA Website for seats availability / vacant seats for allotment before participating as well as to know about the fee structure in different colleges / category of seats. Candidates are also advised to exercise options after knowing /confirming the fee structure, and after discussion with their parents.

The candidates who allotted seat either in first round or in the second round or in the 3rd round (Mop-up) or in the Stray Vacancy Round should compulsorily report to the selected college as the seat allotment is based on the priority of options entered by the candidates. Mere not reporting to the selected college will not be presumed by the candidates that they have surrendered the seat to KEA and it is tantamount of blocking of seat and it attracts the penalty. Further, Government may initiate legal action against such candidates for blocking the seats. Hence please note the following;

1. Candidates should not claim any ignorance on allotment of seats and they should not reject the allotted seats. Since the seat is allotted to candidates based on the options entered by them and order of merit.
2. Penalty will be applicable as per rules to the candidates who wish the surrender the seat after the announcement of results, then only the original documents will be returned.
3. Hence, the candidates are advised to enter the options carefully in the order of preference and they are interested to join.
4. Original documents will be returned to the seat not allotted candidates by KEA based on their request and only the candidate has to be present to collect the original documents by producing the original verification slip and ID card.

The SC, ST candidates are exempted from paying tuition fees, as prescribed in Vide GO No. ಹಿಂವಕ 178 ಬಿಎಂಎಸ್ 2015 ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು ದಿನಾಂಕ 06-08-2014, if their annual income is Rupees 2.50 lakhs, Please read the relevant Government orders for details.

The other backward class candidates have to pay the fees to KEA and they can apply for re-imbursement from the Backward Class Department as per Government Order No. ಕೆಇ 357 ಬಿಎಂಎಸ್ 2012 ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು ದಿನಾಂಕ 22-11-2012 after admission to the concerned colleges. Please read the relevant Government orders for details.

All In-service candidates have to pay the full fees and get reimbursement from their respective department as per deputation rules.

The students under NRI seats & other seats shall furnish bank guarantees for the balance course period at the time of admission or at such period of time granted by the college. Non furnishing of Bank guarantee within the stipulated period would result in cancellation of admission or suspension of classes till the furnishing of the bank guarantee in favor of the colleges.

14 ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

The candidates allotted a seat shall get themselves admitted to the colleges by furnishing relevant undertakings within the due date notified in the seat allotment letter/admission order provided by KEA, failing which their allotted seat shall automatically stand cancelled. However, the admission shall be provisional and subject to the approval of the Government/Apex bodies/concerned Universities.

15 FORFEITURE OF SEATS SELECTED DURING COUNSELING:

- (1) A candidate cancelling a seat in the first round after admission, one day before the second round of counseling as notified shall pay a processing fee of Rs 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only).
- (2) Every candidate including in-service candidate shall pay a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees one lakh fifty thousand only) for Medical or Dental Degree and Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand only) for Medical or Dental Diploma courses if he / she is allotted any clinical seat in the second-round allotment and fails to join the course before the last date of joining of the second round of counseling as notified.
- (3) Further, they shall be ineligible for further rounds of counseling or admissions for that academic year.

Provided that in case of cancellation after the last date of joining for second round and one day before the mop-up round a penalty of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven lakhs only) for Medical or Dental Clinical degree and Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs only) for Medical or Dental Clinical Diploma courses shall be collected.

- (4) Any cancellation or surrender of seats after the mop up round shall be made in person only to the Director, Directorate of Medical Education, Karnataka with a penalty of Rs 18,00,000/- (Rupees eighteen lakhs only) in case of Medical Clinical Degree or Diploma Courses and Rs 6,00,000/- (Rupees six lakhs only) in case of Dental Degree or Diploma Courses and forfeiture of fees paid before the last date of admission as notified. Further, they will be ineligible for further rounds of admission including names list admission.

Provided that,-

- (a) A candidate who has opted Pre-Clinical seats like Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry including Forensic Medicine in the event of cancellation shall pay a penalty of Rs. 1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakh only) and the fees paid shall be forfeited;
- (b) A candidate who has opted Para Clinical Seats like Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology and Community Medicine, in the event of cancellation, shall pay a penalty of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs only) for post graduate degree courses and Rs. 75,000/- (Rupees Seventy thousand only) for post graduate Diploma courses and the tuition fees paid shall be forfeited.

Provided further that, a non-in-service / regular candidate, cancel / surrender Medical / Dental Postgraduate degree or diploma seat after the last date admissions, he / she is not eligible to take management quota seat or any other quota Medical or Dental PG Degree or Diploma seat for a period of three years; and

Provided further that, in case a non-in-service / regular and in-service candidate cancel / surrender the seat before or after the last date of admission / counseling, he / she is not permitted / eligible for rejoining the cancelled / surrendered seat. OR fails to join the course after allotment, the candidate is not eligible to take management quota seat or any other Medical or Dental PG degree or Diploma seat for a period of three years and he shall be liable for disciplinary action.

- (5) A candidate at the time of admission shall furnish a bond in the form specified by the Government binding himself to pay a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs only) for Medical or Dental degree and Rs. 4,00,000/- (Rupees four lakhs only) for Medical or Dental Diploma courses as a penalty in the event of his leaving the course before its completion after the last date of admission for that academic year as notified by Medical Council of India/Dental Council of India.

Provided that,-

- a. A candidate who has opted Pre-Clinical seats like Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry including Forensic Medicine in the event of leaving the course shall pay a penalty of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) and the fees paid shall be forfeited.
 - b. A candidate who has opted Para Clinical Seats like Pharmacology, Pathology, Microbiology and Community Medicine, in the event of leaving the course shall pay a penalty of Rs. 1,00,000/- for post graduate degree courses and Rs 75,000/- (Seventy five thousand only) for post graduate Diploma courses and the tuition fees paid shall be forfeited.
- (6) In addition to the prescribed penalty under sub-rule (4), all candidates (including in-service candidates) shall pay the entire course fee and stipend to the respective Medical/Dental colleges in the event he leaving the course before its completion.

Provided further that, in case of an in-service candidate, in the event he / she leaves the course before its completion or the competent authority concludes that the in service candidate has not shown sufficient progress in the studies or has failed to complete the course in proper time or fails to resume duty even after the expiry of the termination of the period of deputation or at any time within a period of ten years after completion of the higher studies, it shall be lawful to the Government to make recovery of the amount (including pay and allowances, stipend, DA, tuition fee etc, along with penalty and applicable interest) spent on higher studies or specialized training from the salary of the candidate.

(7) All Candidates selecting Government seats {including All India quota (AIQ) in Post Graduate Medical Courses shall furnish an undertaking that he / she shall serve the Government for a minimum period of three years after completion of the course, if Government desires:

Provided that, in-service candidates at the time of admission shall furnish a bond in the form specified by the Government that they shall be rendering service in the Government for a minimum period of ten years.

(8) In case of candidate selecting Government seats, the candidate shall serve the Government for a period as specified in sub-rule (6) failing to comply, with the conditions given as per undertaking, then he / she shall be liable to pay a penalty of Rs. 50,00,000/- (Rupees fifty lakhs only) in case of Post Graduate Medical degree and Rs. 25,00,000/- (Rupees twenty five lakhs only) in case of Post Graduate Medical Diploma to the Government.

(9) Any cancellation or surrender shall be done at the Directorate of Medical Education after the last date of admission for that academic year.

NOTE: The candidates are advised to strictly adhere to the above said rules. Lenience in any matter explained above will not be entertained. The Government/Department of Medical Education / KEA hold all the powers to cancel the candidature of candidates who do not comply with the rules and regulations.

Admission to PG Medical and PG Dental seats shall be made in accordance with the Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for selection and admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma courses Rules, 2006 (Amendments) as amended from time to time and therefore the details and instructions contained in this Information Bulletin are subject to the said Rules and Government orders. In case of any discrepancy, the Rules shall prevail.
