NOTIFICATION FOR ADMISSION INTO MDS COURSES UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27 IN THE STATE OF TELANGANA

Online application forms invited from NEET MDS 2026 qualified candidates from Indian Nationals / OCI / PIO / NRIs for admission into the MDS courses under Management Quota for the academic year 2026-27 into Dental Colleges affiliated to Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences in the State of Telangana.

Notification is issued for online registration for web-based counseling to determine Merit position for admission into **Management Quota seats** only. Provisional Merit list will be notified after scrutiny of all certificates uploaded at the time of online registration. Total number of seats available under Management Quota for the academic year 2026-27 will be notified on website before exercising web options for counseling.

The tuition fee for the academic year 2026–27 shall be as per the Orders to be issued by the Government of Telangana.

Cut-off score in NEET MDS 2026 Exam for MDS courses:

Candidates should have secured the following revised cutoff score or above in NEET-MDS-2026

General Category	50 th percentile	308
General PWD	45 th percentile	289
SC/ST/OBC (Including PWD of SC/ST/OBC)	40 th percentile	271

Schedule for registration of online application and uploading of scanned certificates

Candidates can register online and upload scanned certificates on Website <https://pyttsmds.tsche.in> from **06.00 AM on 09-09-2026 up to 06.00 PM on 13-09-2026.**

NOTE: *LOWER PERCENTAGE / PERCENTILE OF MARKS FOR SC/ST/BC/OBC /PWD IS ONLY FOR ELIGIBILITY PURPOSE AND WILL NOT BE APPLICABLE FOR RESERVATIONS AS THERE ARE NO CATEGORY RESERVATIONS UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA.

Final Merit position of the applied candidates will be prepared based on NEET - MDS- 2026 Score and other eligibility criteria notified hereunder after verification of uploaded certificates.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Candidate should have qualified in NEET MDS 2026 by securing marks of cut- off score or above as displayed above.
- Candidate should have passed BDS Degree examination from an Institution recognized by the Dental Council of India.
- Candidates who have completed their BDS course from an institution outside the country shall submit permanent registration certificate compulsorily.
- Candidates should have registered with National Dental Commission/Dental Council of India/Telangana State Dental Council.

NOTE: The candidates should have completed internship by **31.05.2026** and shall submit Internship Completion Certificate.

- The NEET-MDS-2026 qualified and eligible candidates as per concerned regulations who desire to take admission into MDS Courses shall apply online and upload all original certificates for determining the Merit position for Telangana State Management quota seats using NEET MDS 2026 ranks in the Website <https://pvttsmds.tsche.in> from **06.00 AM on 09.09.2026 up to 06.00 PM on 13.09.2026**. The online application can be filled through any computer with Internet connection.
- **Registration and Processing Fee for MDS Degree courses:** The Registration and Verification fee of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** (Bank transaction charges extra) shall be paid online through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking.**

**** Registration and Processing Fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted to a further date.**

**** Candidates are advised to check their eligibility to apply for determining the Merit position for eligibility by using NEET-MDS-2026 score by reading Prospectus / Regulations carefully.**

Candidates who completed BDS from other States must pay equivalency fee along with the **Registration and Processing Fee**. The fee for BDS Degree from other state or other country is **Rs. 5,000/- & Rs. 7,000/-** respectively.

- The candidates are advised to download and read the Management Quota Prospectus of the course and Instructions for filling Online Application available in the website before filling the online Application.

Procedure for filling online application, scanning/uploading of original certificates and online payment for registration:

- i. The Registration Fee, Processing Fee & Equivalence Fee (for candidates studied BDS outside the State or Country) can be paid through Debit card / Credit card or Net Banking
- ii. **The Registration Fee, Processing Fee & Equivalence Fee paid by the applicants is not refundable under any circumstances.**
- iii. Read the Notification, Prospectus / Regulations carefully.
- iv. The following documents are required for Uploading:
 - (a) Latest passport size photo.
 - (b) Admit card and Score Card NEET-MDS-2026
 - (c) Original/Provisional BDS Degree Certificate
 - (d) Aadhaar Card
 - (e) Study Certificate(s) 1st to final BDS.
 - (f) Latest Category certificate in case of BC/SC/ST candidates issued by Competent Authority if applicable (for NEET-MDS-2026 Cut-off score under category for eligibility). ***THERE ARE NO CATEGORY RESERVATIONS UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA***
 - (g) Internship completion certificate
 - (h) Permanent Dental Council Registration Certificate.
 - (i) Permanent Dental Registration Certificate is mandatory if the candidate obtained Dental Degree Certificate from outside the country.
 - (j) Candidates claiming NRI quota (MQ2) Should submit the following documents from a Blood relative such as Father/Mother/Brother/Sister/Uncle/Aunt only and should submit a declaration to that effect.

1. NRI Sponsorship certificate (DECLARATION Form)
 2. NRI status certificate of the financial supporter issued by Embassy of respective country under their seal.
 3. Copy of NRI Bank account pass book of the financial supporter.
 4. Copy of Pass port of NRI financial supporter
- (l) Sponsorship Certificate from College for Institutional Quota (MQ3)
- (m) Documents required for eligibility in Army college of dental sciences (ACDS)
(If applicable)
1. Copy of Ex-servicemen Identity card, discharge book, PPO, Part II order and ECHS card of the candidate along with certificate as per ACDS Prospectus duly signed by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer.
 2. Copy of Serving certificate, Dependency certificate.

v. Visit website through Computer with Internet connection to fill the application form

- vi.** Fill in all the details in the online application form and upload all the documents which are mandatory

Procedure for submission of filled-in online Application form for MDS courses: -

The candidate should submit the print-out of the filled-in online application form and original certificates along with (1) set of self-attested copies to the Principal of allotted college at the time of admission for final verification. In case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment order will be cancelled.

MANAGEMENT QUOTA SEATS:

- MDS seats available under Management Quota in Dental Colleges including Army Dental College will be displayed separately on KNRUHS website before Online Counseling.
- Final seat matrix for Management Quota sub-category - MQ.-1, MQ.2, MQ-3 will be displayed on KNRUHS website <http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in/> before online counseling.
- MDS seats in Army Dental College are reserved for wards of Army Personnel Only.
- As per G.O.Ms. No. 200, HM&FW(C1) Dept., dated. 03.11.2025, 15% of seats under MQ – 1 are open to candidates from all over the country and the remaining 85% shall be reserved for local candidates of Telangana.
- The criteria for local candidature is determined as per G.O.Ms.No. 62, HM&FW(C1) Dept., dated. 27.07.2024.

NOTE:

- i) On-online application form without uploading mandatory Certificates, Passport size photo, without signature at declaration area, incomplete applications will be automatically rejected and will not be considered for determining the Merit position using NEET-MDS-2026 score.
- ii) The mere fact that the Merit position issued to the candidate does not imply that the candidature is accepted by the University and it does not mean that the entries made by the candidate in the online application are accepted as true and correct.
- iii) Candidates may please note that the University will take up the online verification of certificates with regard to eligibility conditions i.e., Educational qualifications, validity of registration with NDC/DCI/ State Dental Council, Internship certificate, category status as per uploaded relevant certificates. If the information furnished by the candidate in the application is incorrect, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled and further action that deems fit will be taken.
- iv) Eligibility of candidate for admission into MDS courses for the academic year 2026-27 will be examined by the University only after scrutiny of application along with all copies of required certificates and provisional merit list will be notified.
- v) Registration along with uploading of scanned original certificates will be done only once irrespective of the number of times of exercising web options / number of counsellings. No separate notification will be given for verification of original certificates. Therefore, the candidates should register and upload all the mandatory certificates without fail.
- vi) Scrutiny of uploaded original certificates shall be done by the University and concerned departmental officials. After scrutiny of application and certificates, Provisional final merit list will be released. Candidates are advised to refer to KNRUHS website for further details regarding schedule of exercising web options.
- vii) Admissions will be in accordance with the orders issued from time to time by State Government with regard to process of admissions to MDS Courses and relevant Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble High court orders.
- viii) The procedure for preparation of seat matrix and selection into MDS courses in the Management Quota and seat allocation will be done as the procedure given in G.O.Ms.No.40, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dated: 09-05-2017, G.O.Ms.No. 200, HM&FW(C1) Dept., dated: 03.11.2025 and subsequent amendments.

- ix) The notification is for determining the State Merit position using NEET-MDS-2026 Rank only. The dates for exercising web options for admission into MDS courses and procedure will be notified separately on University website. Candidates are advised to check the University web-site for notifications, schedules and other details from time to time.
- x) An in-eligible candidate obtaining Merit position does not make the candidate eligible for admission.
- xi) Admissions will be considered only for candidates, who have secured marks above cutoff score in NEET- MDS-2026 exam and based on the state merit order as the case may be.
