

Dr. NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES::AP::VIJAYAWADA – 8

Notification for exercising web options for Phase-2 of web based counseling for admission into MBBS Course under Competent Authority Quota Seats for the academic year 2026-27.

In continuation of earlier notifications dated 05-08-2026, 18-08-2026 and 29.08.2026, the University hereby notify the Phase-2 of web counselling for the MBBS seats available under Competent Authority Quota seats (i.e., Unfilled, Not Joined and vacancies arose due to availing Free Exit facility after Phase-1) of Dr.NTR UHS, Vijayawada in Government, Private Un-aided Non-Minority & Minority Medical colleges (under Dr. NTR UHS) and MBBS Seats in Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women (under SVIMS), Tirupati for the academic year 2026-27 in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

All the eligible candidates whose names are found in the final merit list on 29-08-2026 and addendum on 01-0--2026 & 13-09-2026 displayed on the University website can exercise web options for admission into MBBS course for the colleges in the order of priority irrespective of vacancies as per the following schedule:

The seats reserved under special categories i.e., **NCC and Sports & Games** will be filled after receipt of Final prioritized merit list from the competent authorities i.e. NCC and SAAP which will be displayed on the website.

1. The candidates who were allotted seat in Phase-1 counseling and joined at the allotted college are eligible to exercise web options to slide/upgrade to better college according to their merit. The candidates are advised to exercise web options for only those colleges they consider better than the currently admitted college irrespective of vacancies. The present reported college will be the last option by default in green colour.
2. The candidates who were allotted in Phase-1 counseling and have not reported at the allotted college are eligible to exercise web options in the Phase-2 counseling for all other colleges, except the college which he/she has not joined.
3. Candidates who have reported to the college allotted to them in Phase-I but have not exercised fresh web options for the present phase shall not be considered for further sliding/upgradation in this phase. However, such candidates shall be considered for default sliding, if applicable, limited to a change in seat category, if any, within the same college to which they have already reported.
4. The candidates who were not allotted any seat OR who have not exercised web-options in Phase-1 counseling are also eligible to exercise web options in Phase-2 counseling. There is no limit on the number of web-options. The candidates are advised to exercise the options for all colleges in the order of priority & eligibility.

5. The candidates who availed Free Exit facility after Phase-I Counselling are not eligible to exercise web options for this phase and for further phases of counselling.
6. Competent Authority Quota seats in Minority Medical Colleges will be allotted to Muslim Minority Candidates only. Muslim Minority Candidates are also eligible for Competent Authority Quota seats in other Medical Colleges.
7. A mere exercising prioritised web option under this notification does not confer any automatic right to secure admission into MBBS Course.

Candidates while giving options should note that:

1. On upgradation in this counseling as per the web options, the allotted seat of Phase-1 where the candidate joined and continuing the course **(virtual vacancy)** will be added to the seat matrix and allotted simultaneously during this counseling.
2. Candidates getting upgraded in Phase-II shall not have any claim on Phase-I joined seat. The reported seat in first counseling will be cancelled automatically on upgradation in this counseling as per the web options. Therefore, all the candidates are informed to exercise web options in this phase for the colleges they are really interested to join in the order of priority irrespective of available vacancies.

The seat allocation will be done as per the procedure given in G.O.P.No.646, Education (w) Department, dated 10.07.1979 and its subsequent amendments.

University Fee: Rs.12,600/-. The selected candidates have to pay University fee through payment Gateway by using Online payment method (Debit Card / Credit Card / Net Banking) for downloading the allotment order. The candidates who downloaded the allotment order in Phase-1 by paying the university fee need not pay again, but have to download the fresh allotment order, if college/seat category is changed.

Tuition Fee: Interim fee structure as fixed by the Govt. of AP tentatively for the academic year 2026-27 as notified in the regulations.

Candidates selected for Sri Padmavathi Medical College for Women, Tirupati have to visit SVIMS website <http://svimspts.ap.nic.in> for tuition fee and other fee details to be paid at College. The said college is not under the control of this University.

The details of vacant seats (unfilled after Phase-1, not joined, free exit) are displayed in the University website. If any additional seats/college(s) permitted before the Phase-2 counseling will be added and filled in counseling.

Instructions to the Candidates:

1.	The candidates can exercise web options through https://apuhs-ugadmissions.aptonline.in/MBBS/Home/StudentLogin
2.	Candidates can exercise options for MBBS course in all the colleges in the order of priority in which they are really interested to join <u>irrespective of Vacancies displayed</u> , so as to give chance to next meritorious candidates as per the priority. There is no limit to the number of options.
3.	Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the web. Onetime Password will be sent to the registered mobile and mail at the time of entering and submitting web options.
4.	Candidates are advised to go through the User Manual for exercising web options available in the University website.
5.	Candidates are advised to complete the Web Options process well within the notified schedule to avoid last minute delay for any reasons.
6.	The web options once submitted are final. No request for change of options or order of college priorities will be entertained after closure of above said web options schedule. The same options will be considered for allotment of respective special category seats also.
7.	Candidates are instructed to take the printout of the saved options.
8.	It is the responsibility of the candidates that their individual login details, email ID, OTPs should not share with any other person. The candidate is totally responsible for the misuse of the same and also for web options exercised from his/her login.
9.	The web options for the colleges in the order of Priorities have to be exercised before each phase of counselling as per the schedule notified by the University. Hence, candidates are informed to regularly watch the University website for updates/ counselling notifications.
10.	Candidates will receive the message to their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if seat is allotted. The candidates are instructed to visit the website: https://drntr.uhsap.in for status of allotment after closure of web options. The University is not responsible for non-receipt of messages due to network issues non-working/ non-availability of mobiles etc.
11.	Candidates who have been allotted a seat can download the provisional allotment order on payment of University Fee through payment gateway and report to the Principal of the allotted college on or before the date specified in the allotment order alongwith all original certificates. The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances. <u>However, the candidates who have already paid University fee need not pay again.</u>
12.	If a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted college of Phase-2 counselling, he/she shall not be eligible for opting the not reported college(s) in the next Phase(s) of the counselling. The Joined candidates of Phase-2 Counselling are eligible for upgradation/sliding to better college upto Phase-III (Mop Up) counseling only.
13.	Verification of all original certificates will be conducted at the college of admission and in case of any discrepancy or found ineligible, the provisional allotment will be cancelled without any notice and action will be initiated as per University regulations
14.	The Candidates who were already allotted a seat in any college of AP and joined, now slid to another college in AP should submit the Custodian Certificate of the joined college under Dr NTRUHS only at the newly allotted college for admission. The first college where the candidate initially joined will transfer the Original certificates to subsequently allotted college in AP.
