**SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO POST GRADUATE DENTAL
(MDS) COURSES, KERALA – 2026**

**FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION/
DELETION/REARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE**

The activities related to the Second phase of Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Dental Degree Courses for the year 2026 in the State have commenced. Candidates included in the state rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log on to the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and then click the link '**PG Dental 2026 - Candidate Portal**' to access their home page. Candidates can then rearrange/ delete their existing higher order options if needed, after clicking the '**Confirm**' button available therein. Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase can also re-arrange/delete their existing options. The facility for online option confirmation/deletion/re- arrangement shall be available in the above website till **23.09.2026, 02:00 PM.**

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory for Round 2

In the **Second Round Counselling**, there is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only option confirmation/deletion/rearrangement is possible for the existing options. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in Round 2. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the first round and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted options will automatically be deleted thus enabling only up gradation/retention in the

same seat. If a candidate joined in a seat in Round 1 does not give confirmation of option in the Round 2 he/she will not be considered for up gradation in Round 2, but the seat joined in Round 1 will be retained. So, if a candidate joined in Round 1 does not want up gradation in Round 2, he/she may not confirm options or delete all options registered. Those candidates who have received or not received any allotment in the first phase, and want to be considered for the second phase of allotment shall have to confirm their options online by clicking the '**Confirm**' button available in the Home page of the candidate. Those who do not Confirm their options online will not be considered for the second phase of allotment for the existing options. The Option Registration Fee of the candidate will be forfeited, if a seat is allotted in Round 2 and the candidate has not reported/ not joined/quits after joining. The rank list of **Service Quota candidates** will be published in the website on 19.09.2026. The candidates included in the Service Quota Rank List can register their options for admission to PG Dental Course 2026 immediately after the publication of Service Quota Rank List.

The allotted candidates of round 1 who have not taken admission in the respective colleges within the stipulated time and those candidates who have quit the seats after taking admission will lose their present allotment as well as all the higher order options and will not be considered for round 2 allotment procedures . The registration fee of such candidates who did not join within the stipulated time after getting the allotment and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission is considered as penalty and will not be refunded.

Fresh option registration will be available during the **third (final) round**, but with a fresh option registration fee amounting to the annual tuition fee of the seat opted, if opted only for Government seat or an amount of Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees One lakhs only) if opted also for a seat in Private Self financing Medical College. For SC/ST/OE and other candidates who are eligible for fee concession, the registration fee for Govt. / Private medical college seats will be half of the above amounts respectively. The conversion

of seats, if any, will be carried out during the final round of allotment. The registration fee paid for final round allotment of those candidates who do not join the seat allotted in the final phase allotment will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded. Candidates who do not take admission in the last phase of allotment or candidates who file/retain unnecessary options & do not take admission on allotment to the Course/College during the final phase of allotment as notified by the CEE, resulting in Government seats in government/ self financing colleges allotted by the CEE to lapse, will also be not eligible for refund of fees. They will also have to pay Liquidated damages as stipulated in Clause 19.5.

The tentative schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

18.09.2026	Website opens for Online Option Confirmation/ re-arrangement/ deletion of options
23.09.2026, 2:00 PM	Facility for Online Option Confirmation /rearrangement/ deletion of options ends
24.09.2026	Publication of Second Phase Provisional Allotment
25.09.2026	Publication of Second Phase Final Allotment
26.09.2026 to 30.09.2026, 4:00 PM	All candidates who get an allotment should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges.
30.09.2026, 5:00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the OAMS.

Candidates allotted to courses, should take admission in the college/course allotted after remitting the fee/balance fee as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

Note:

- Candidates who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sri Chithra home, Nirbhaya home, Juvenile home are exempted from

payment of fees (except Minority/NRI Seats).

- The allotment to Colleges/Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies/Affiliation from the Universities concerned.
